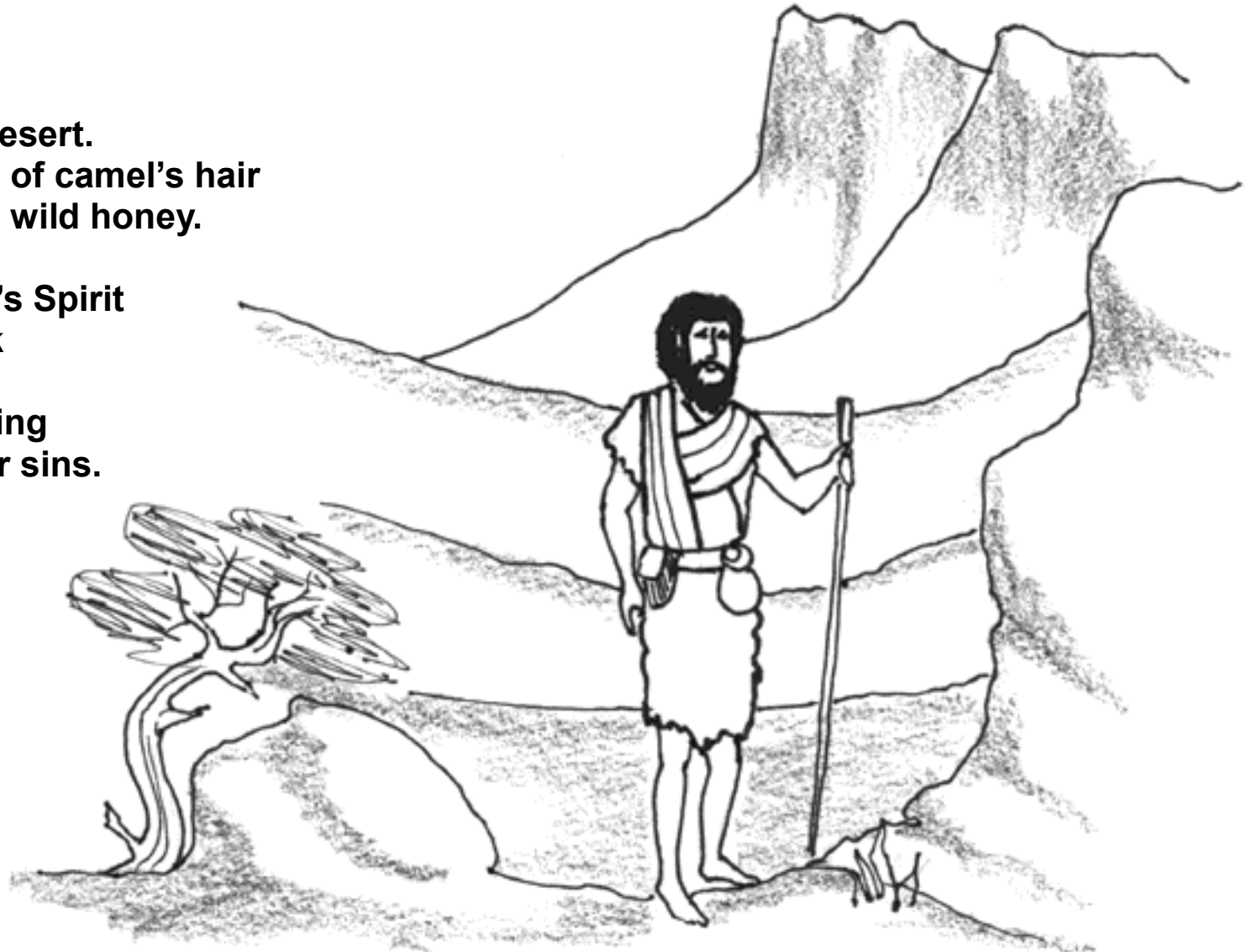

**A PROPHET FOR GOD'S PEOPLE / JOHN BAPTISES JESUS**

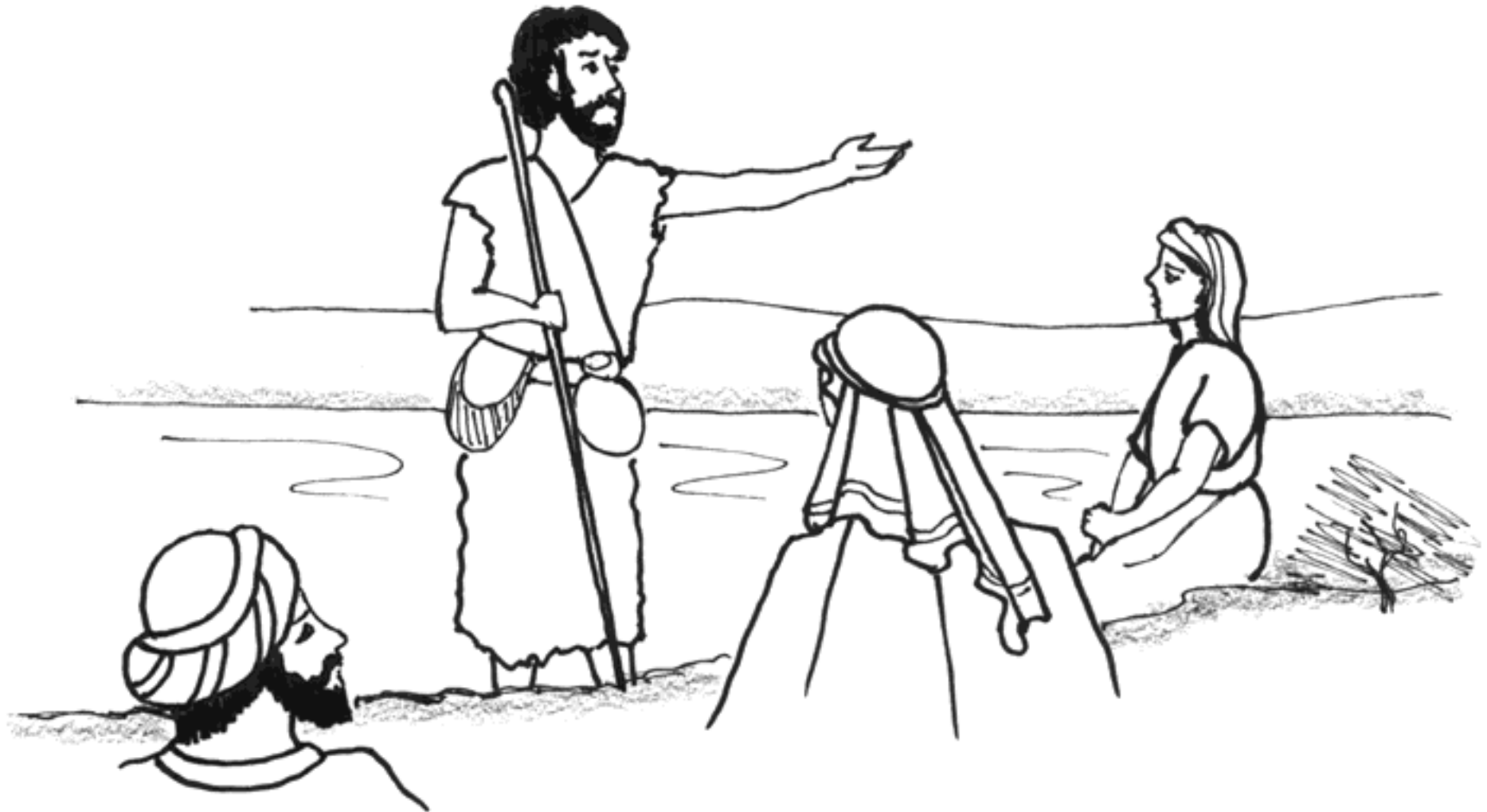

to save them from their sins.**

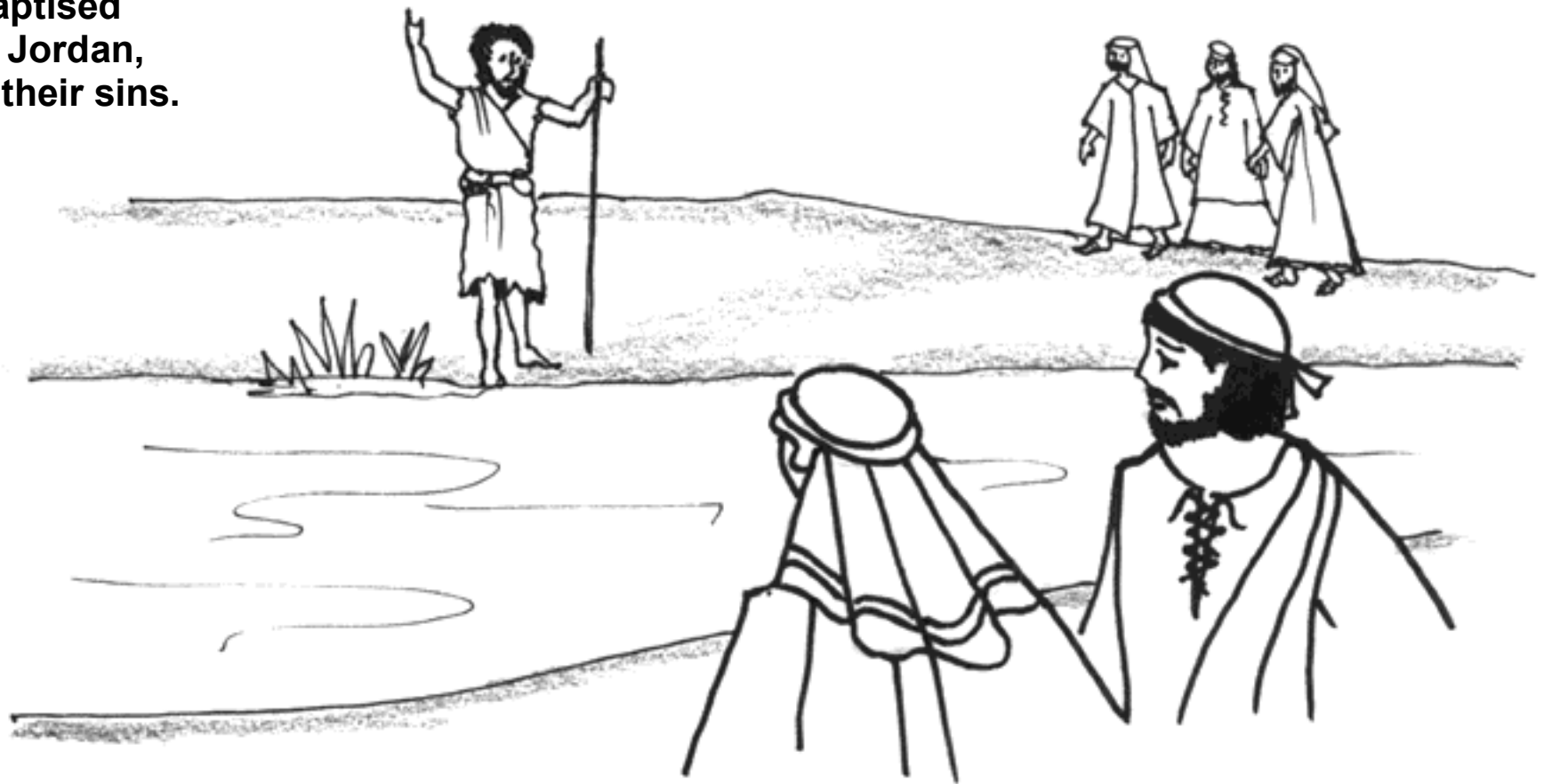


**John stood by the River Jordan saying,

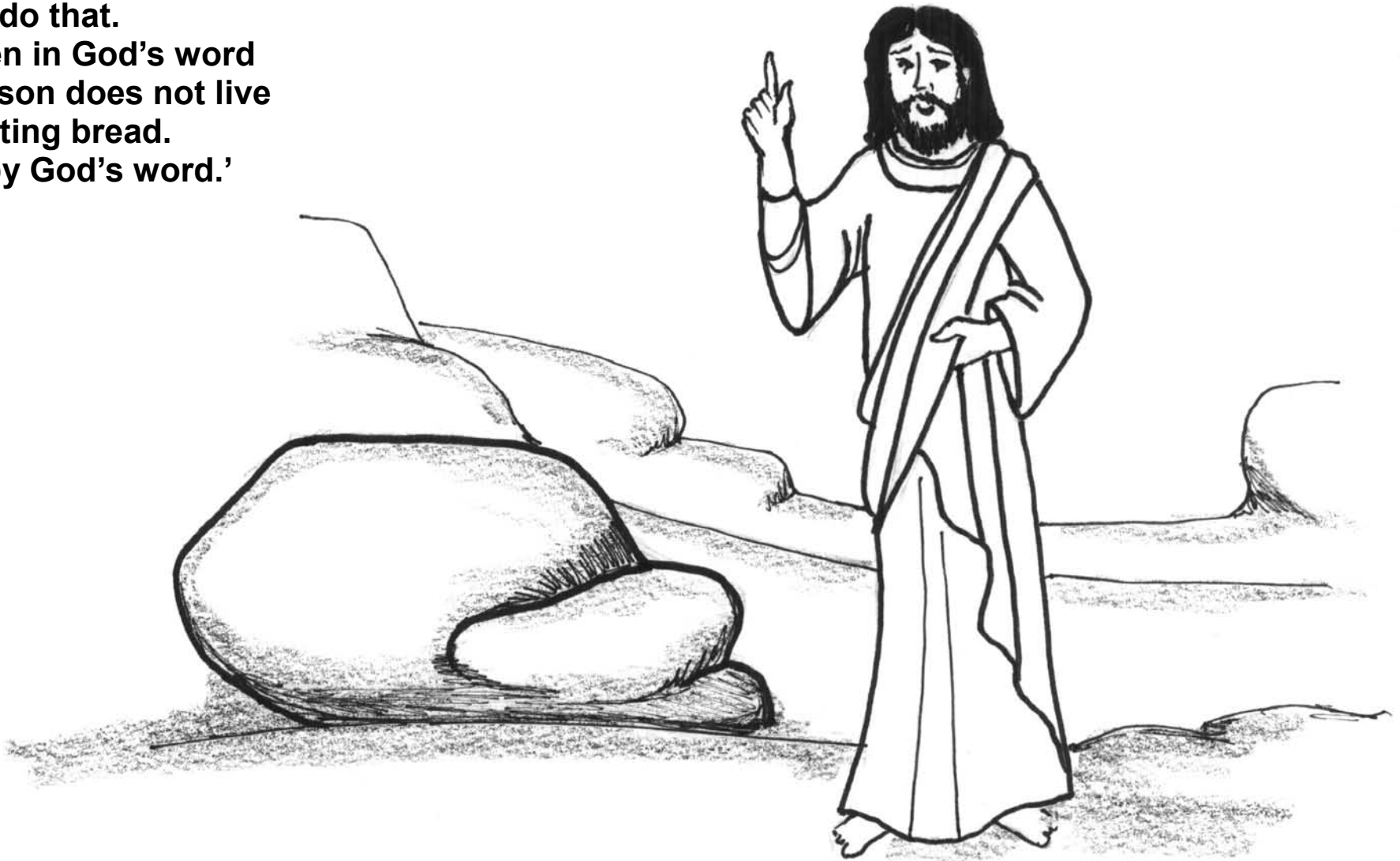
**The Spirit of God

He lives by God's word.'**



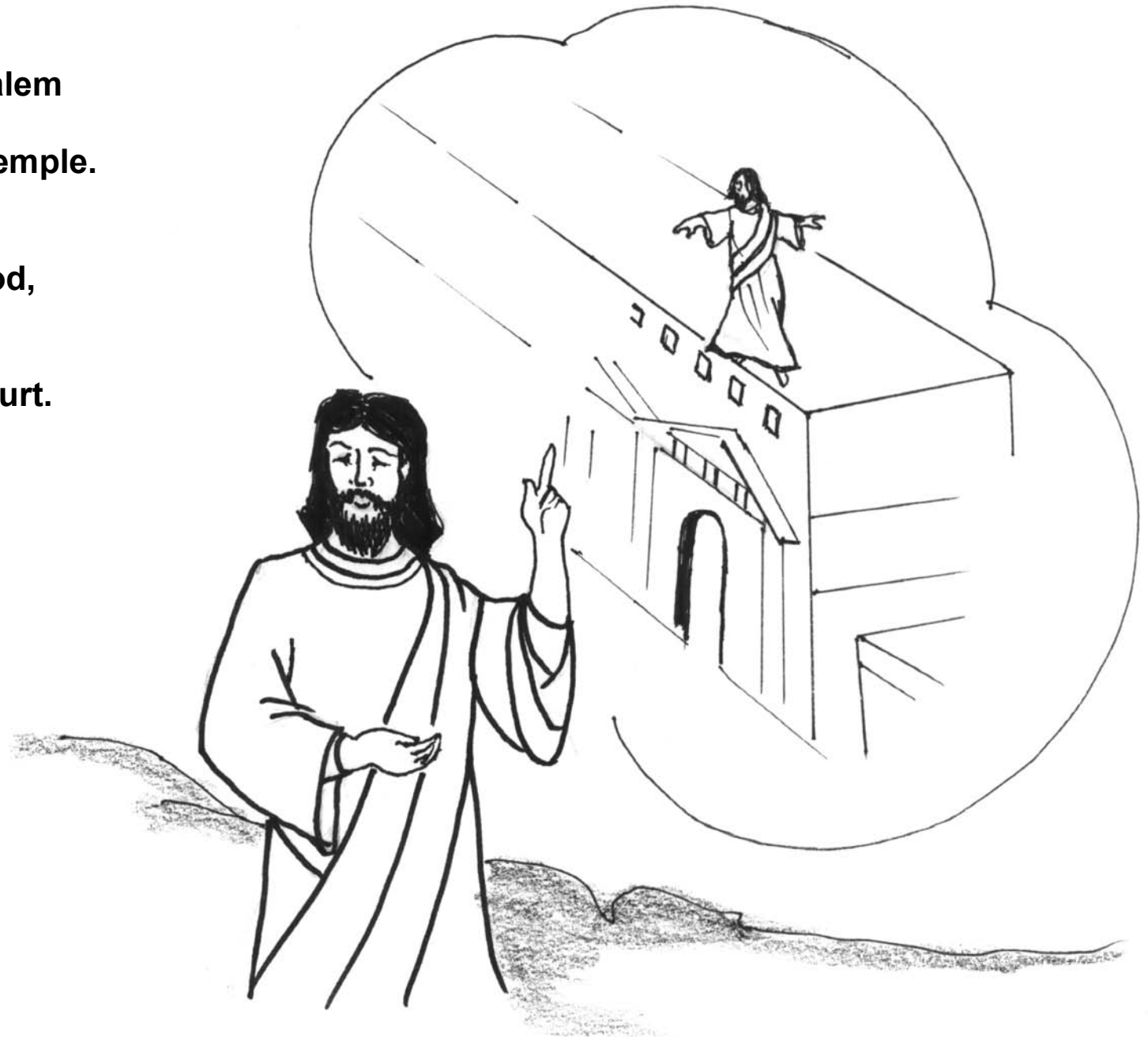
**But Satan tried again.**

jump off!'**

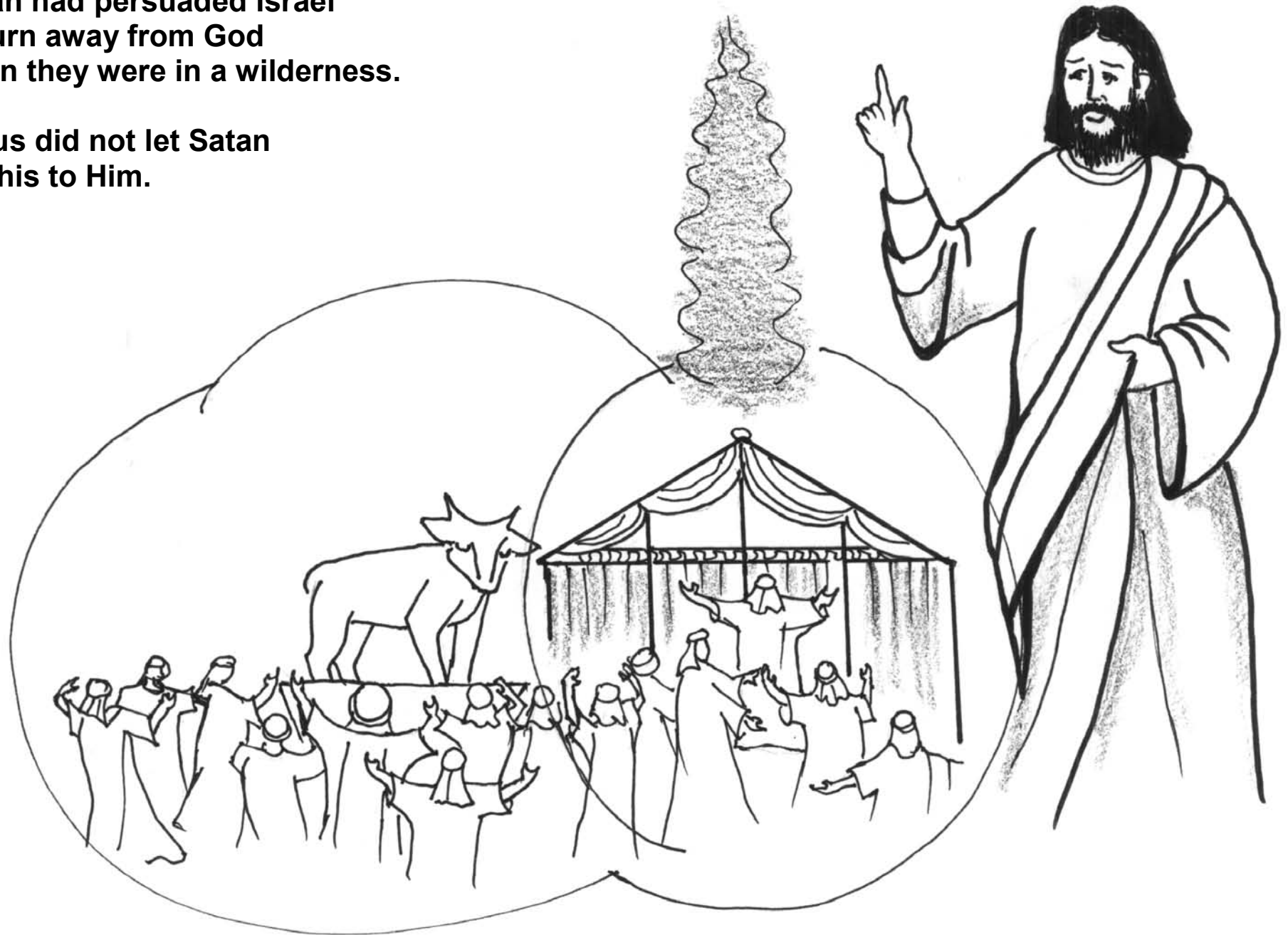
**'God won't let you get hurt.

when they were in a wilderness.**

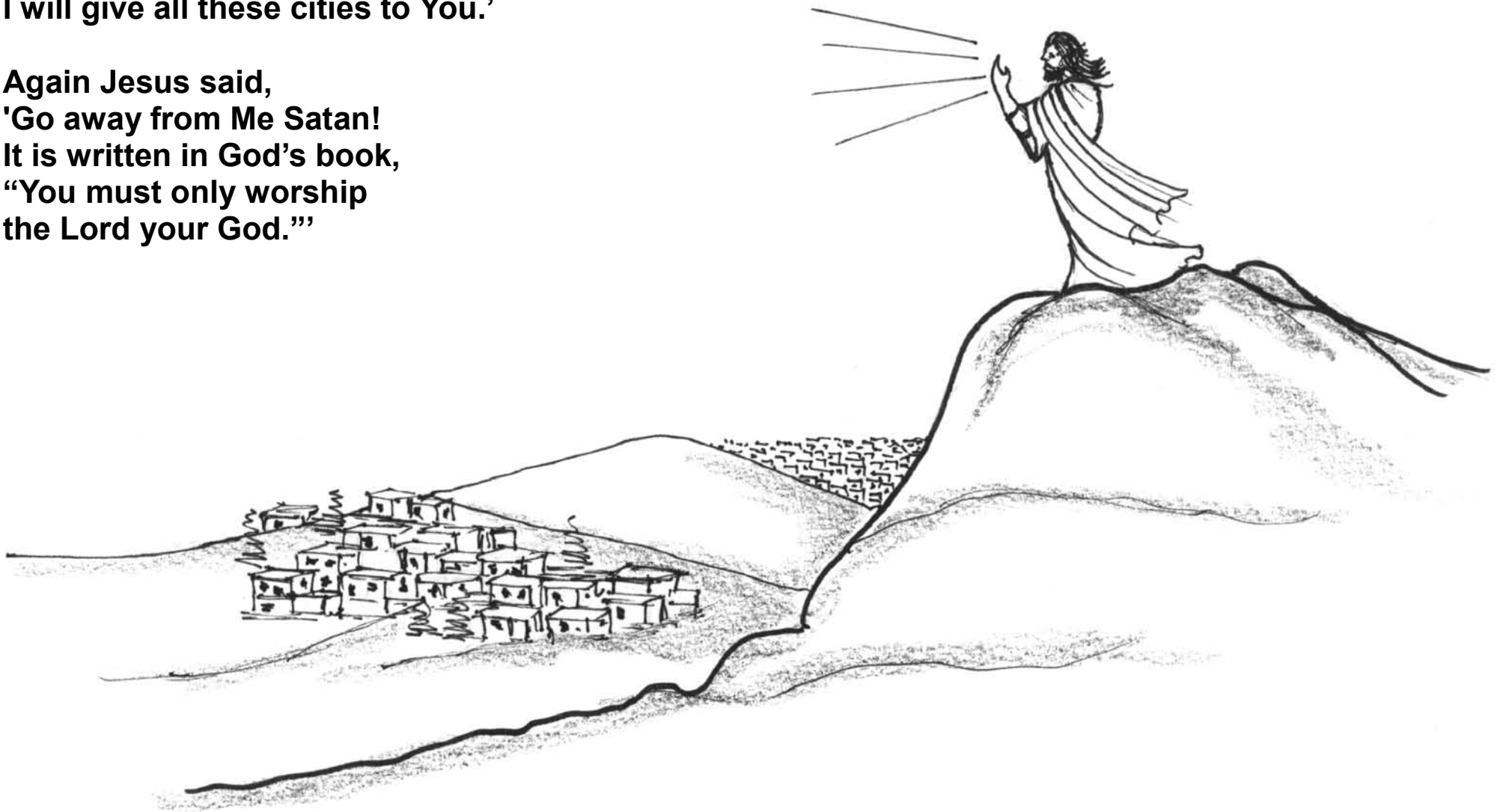
**Jesus did not let Satan

the Lord your God."'**

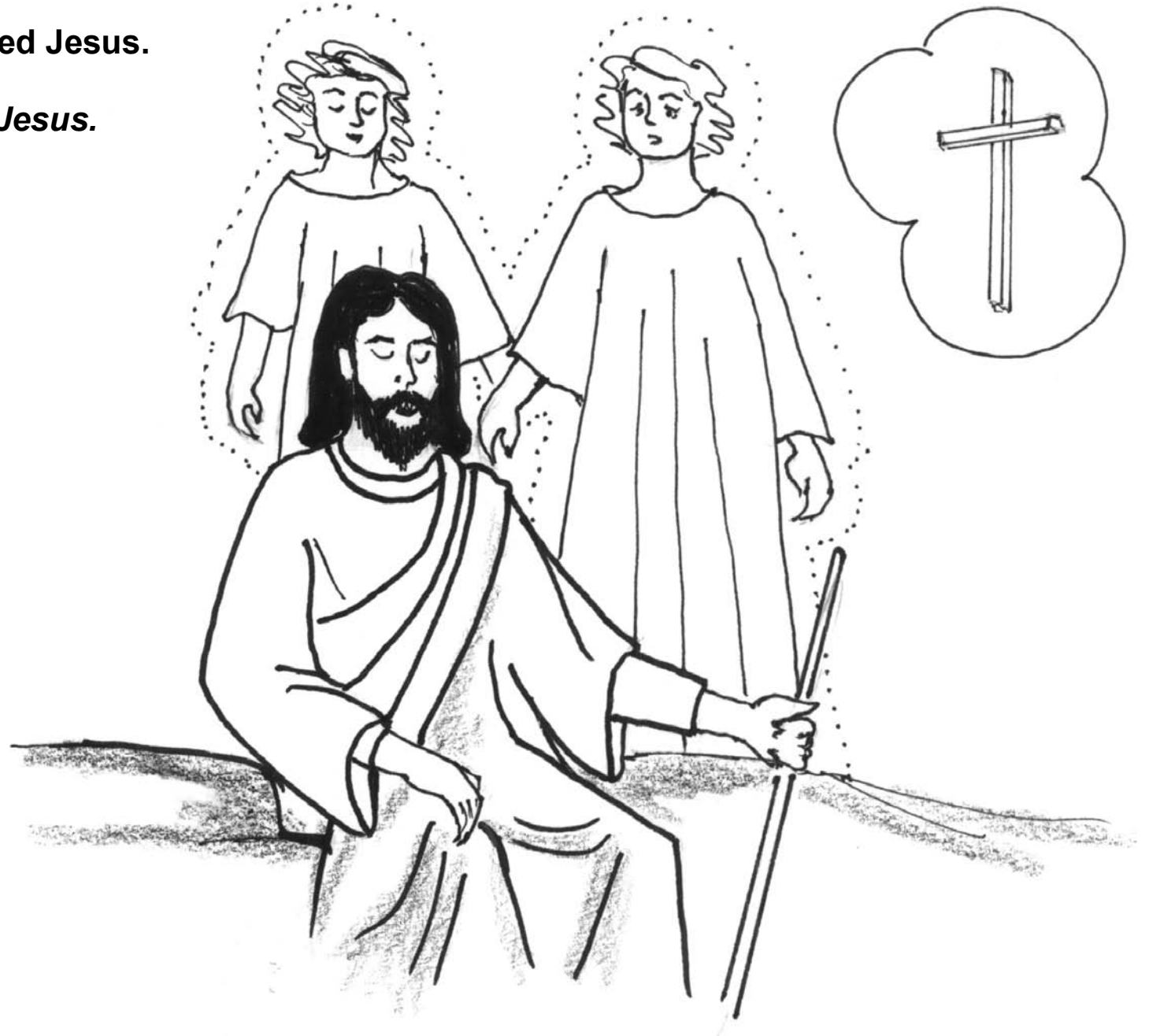


**Satan went away

you would know who He is.**

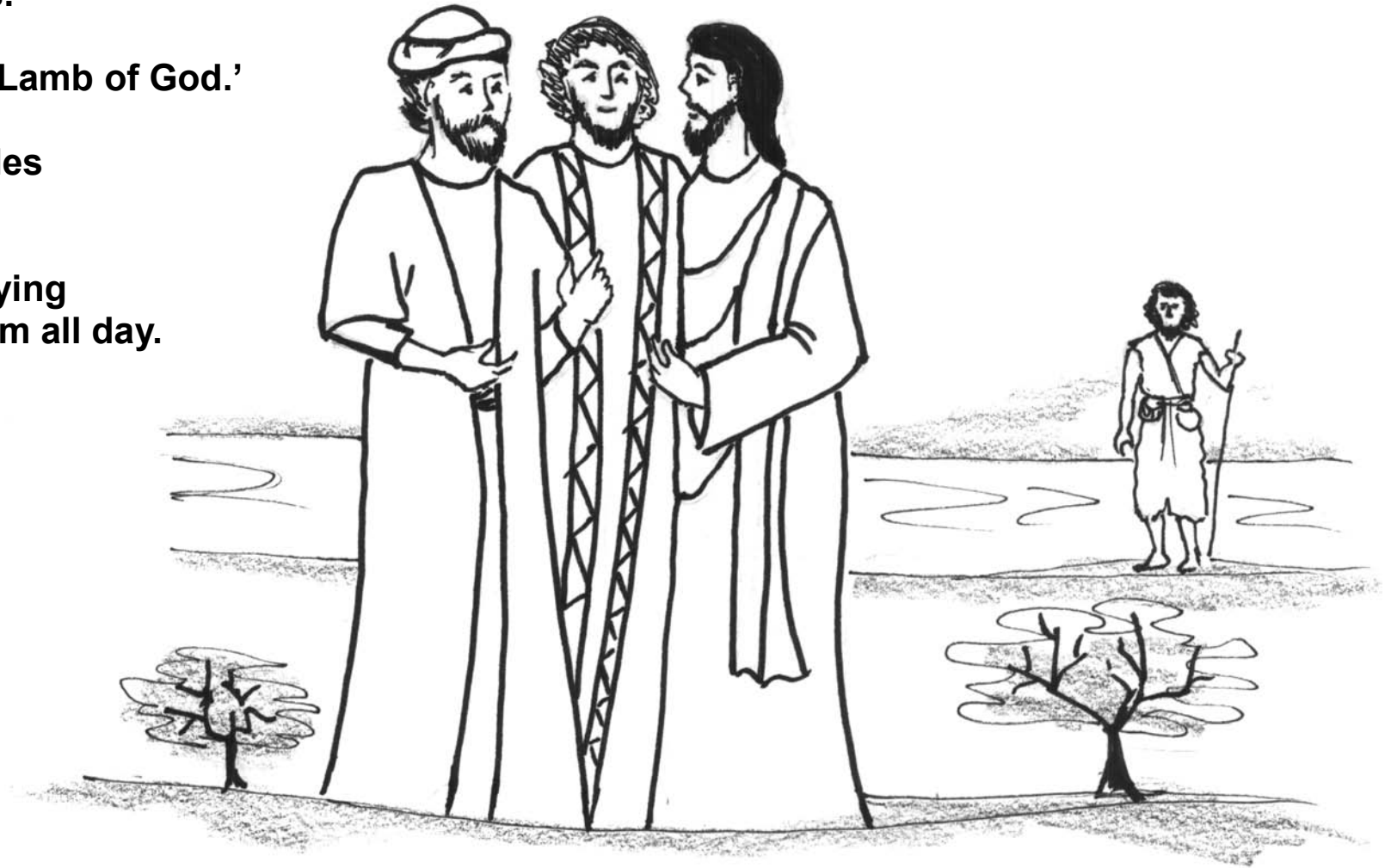
**'I know it is He,

and talked with Him all day.**



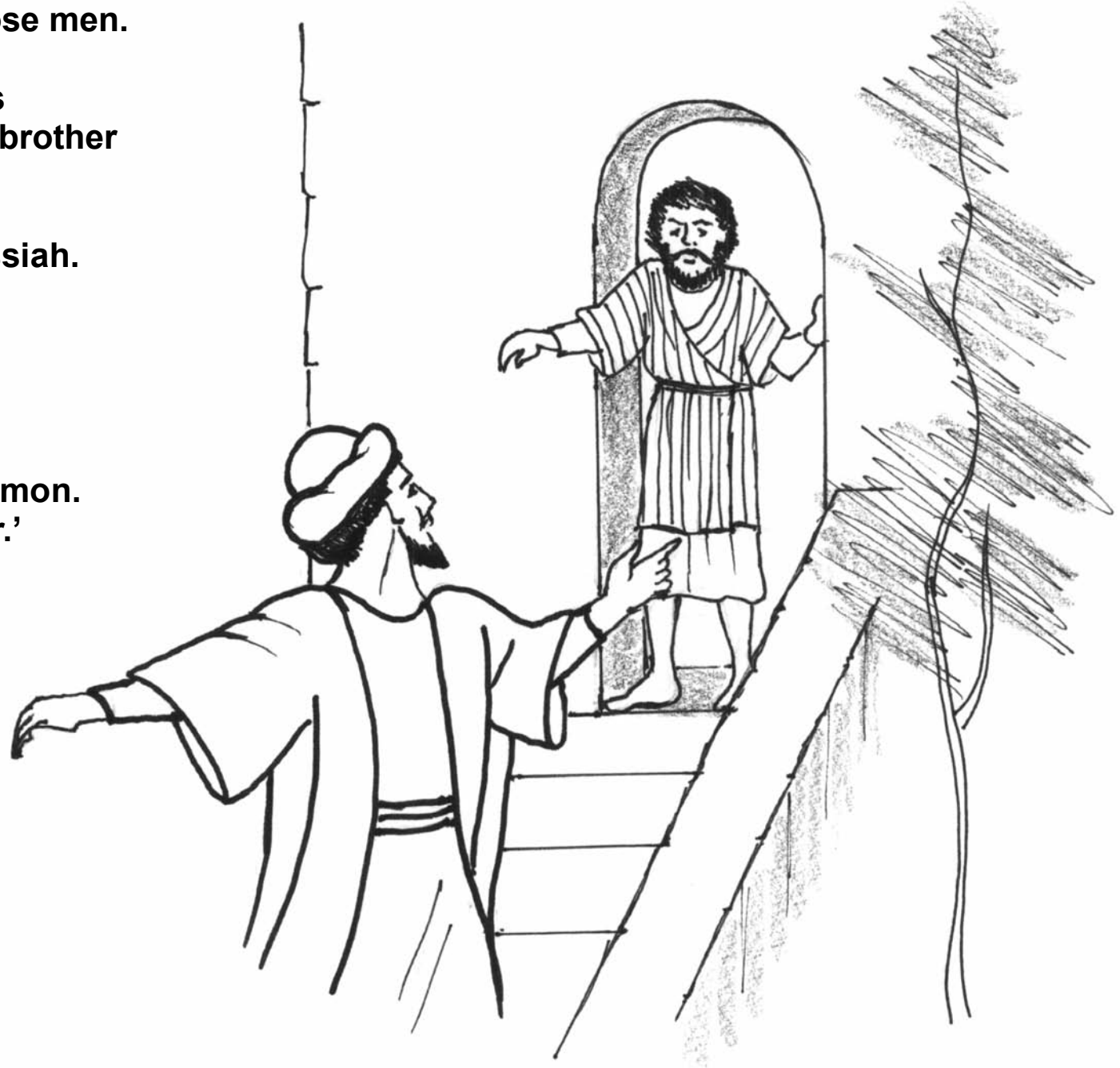
**Andrew was one of those men.**

You will be called Peter.'**

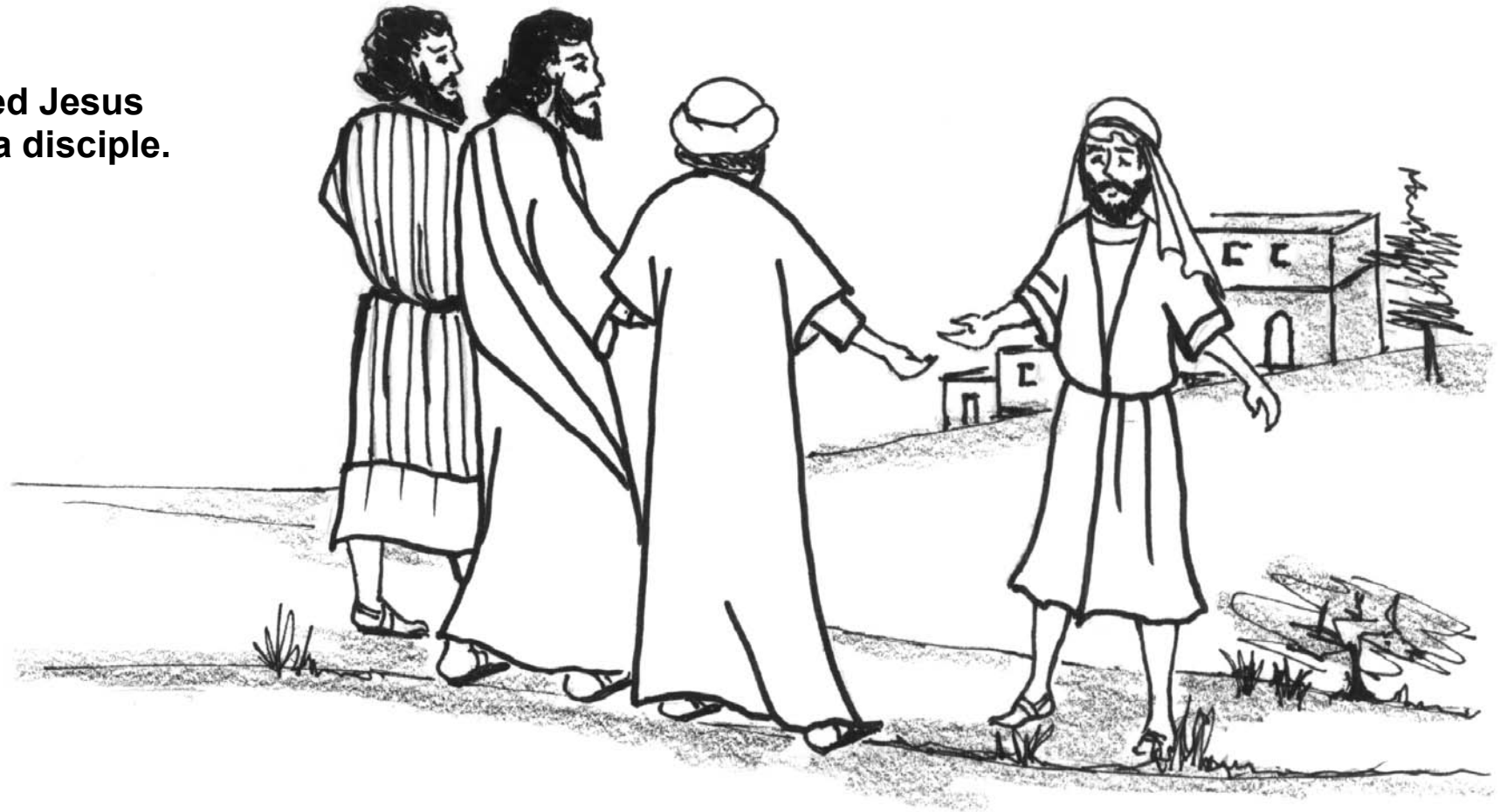


**The next day

and became a disciple.**

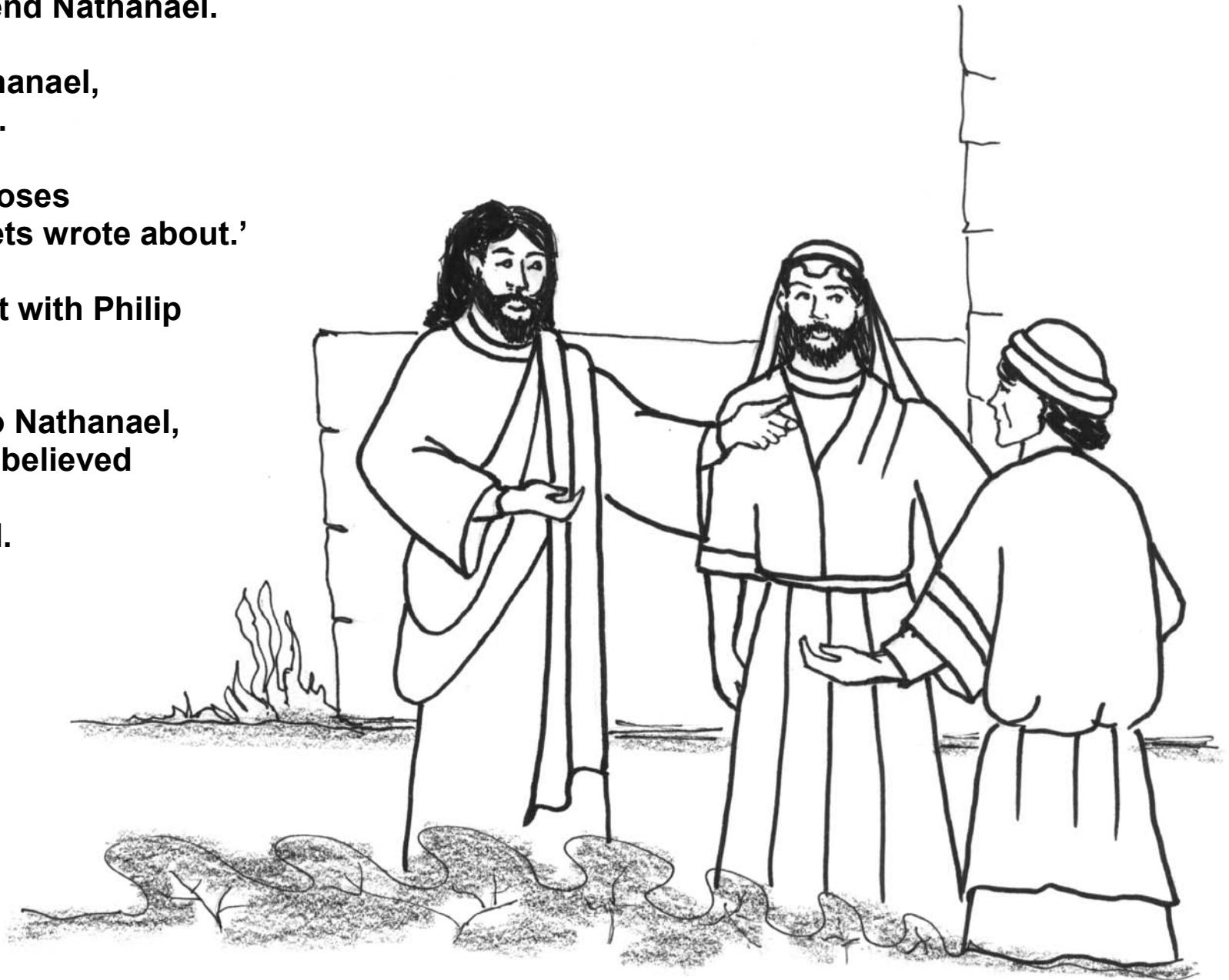


**Then Philip went

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# ***JESUS GOES TO A WEDDING***

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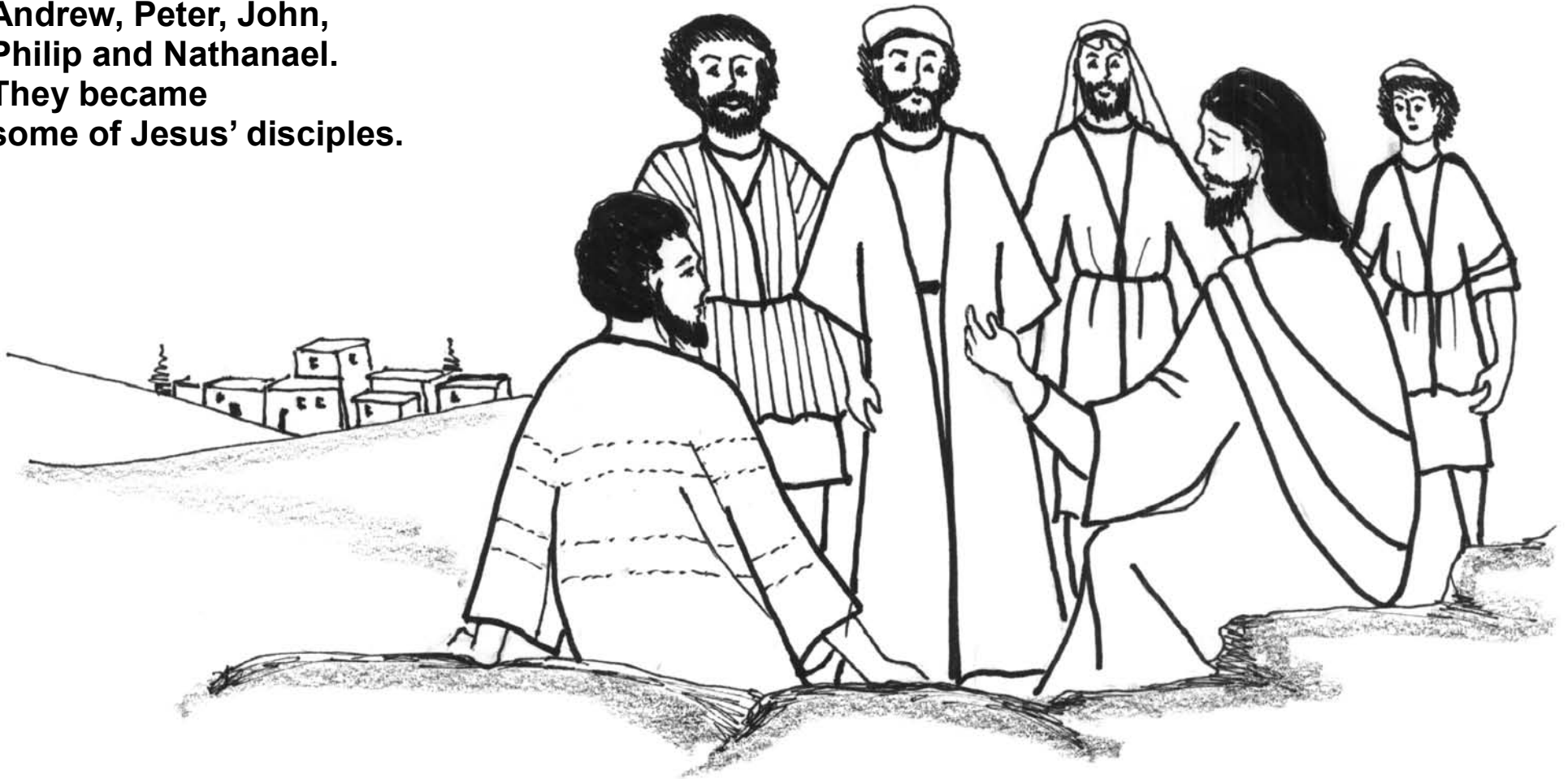
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**JOHN 2:1-11**

**What would they do?**

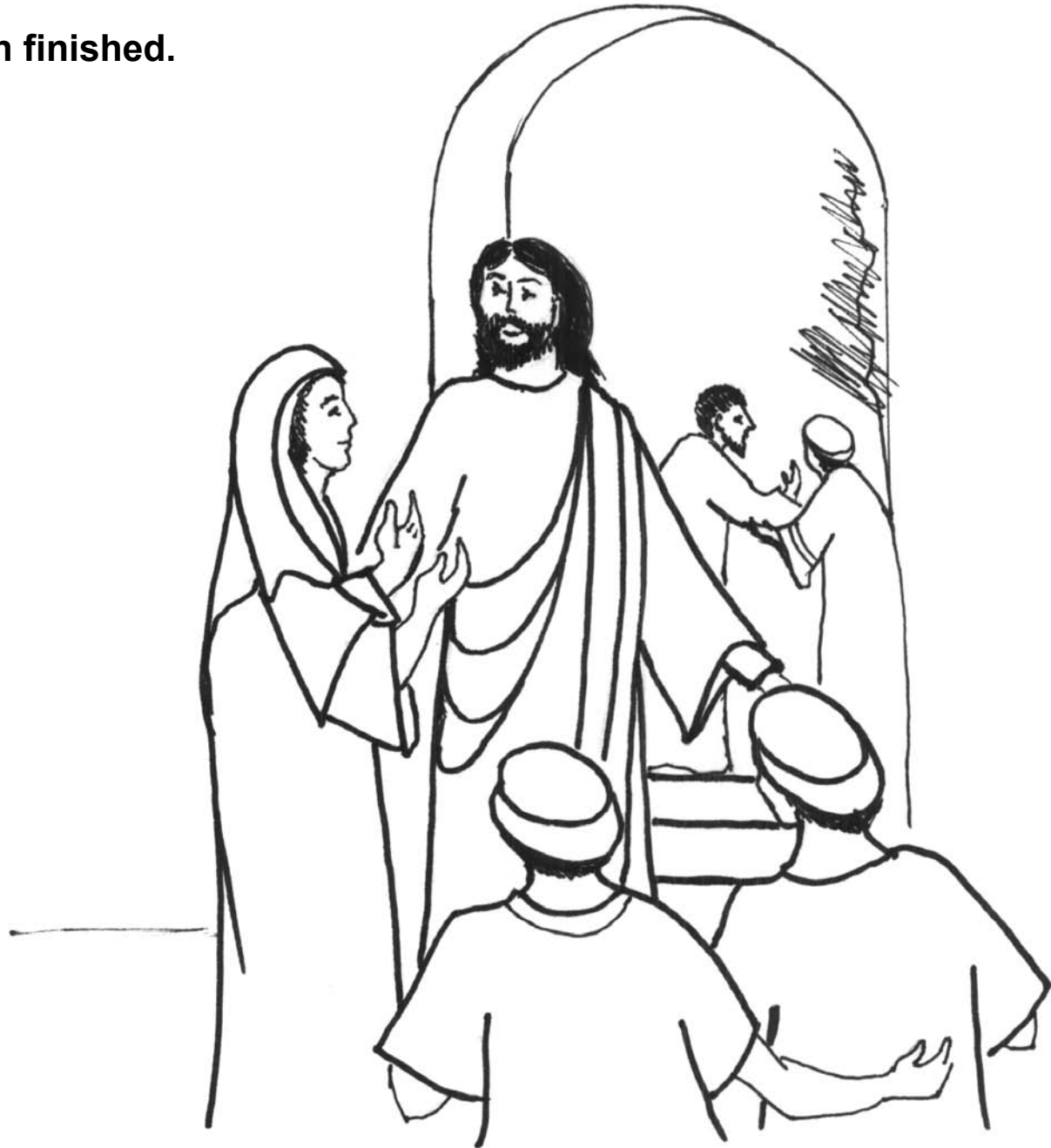


**Mary, Jesus' mother,

would do something.**

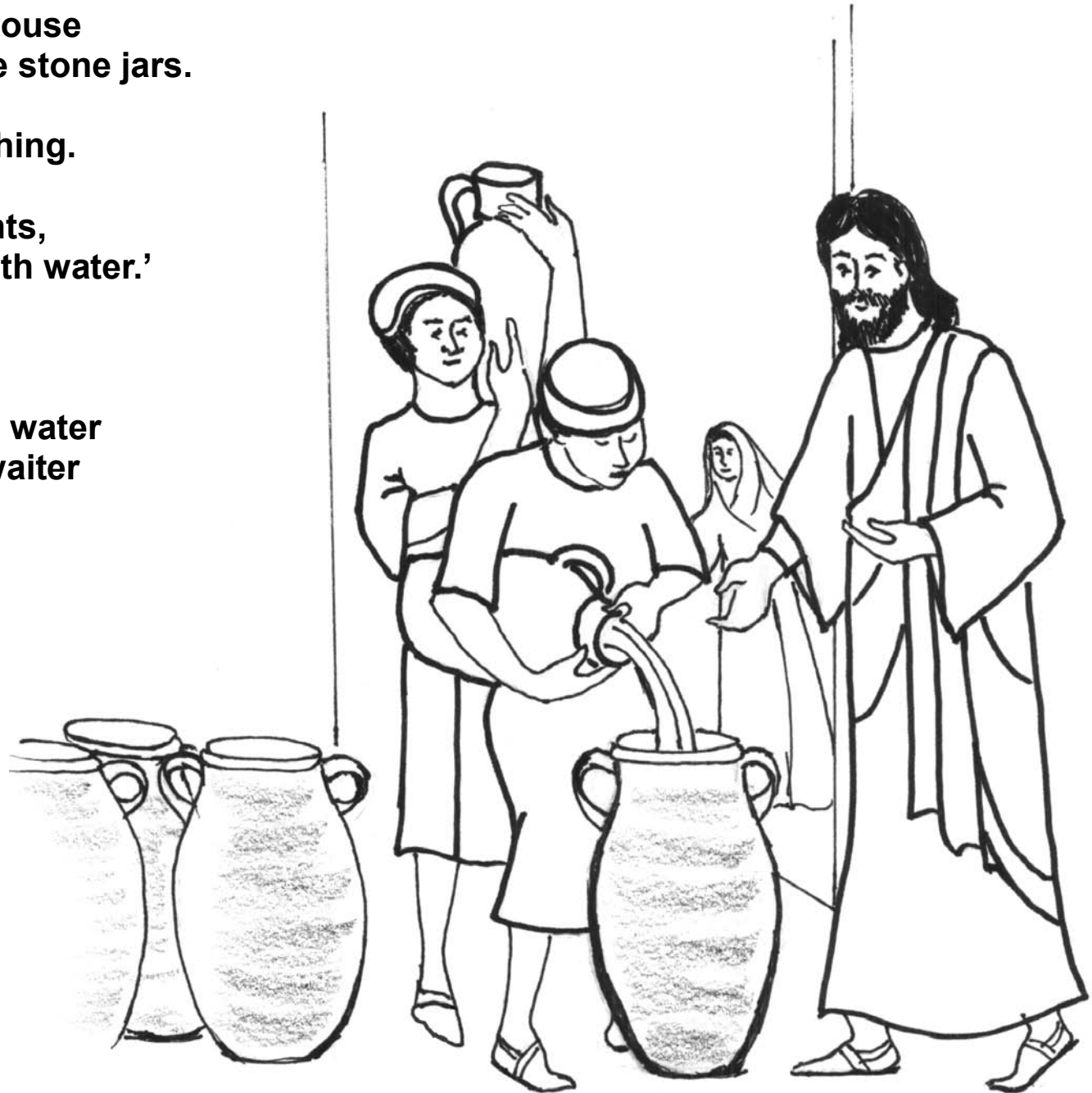
**She said to the servants,

was for ceremonial washing.**

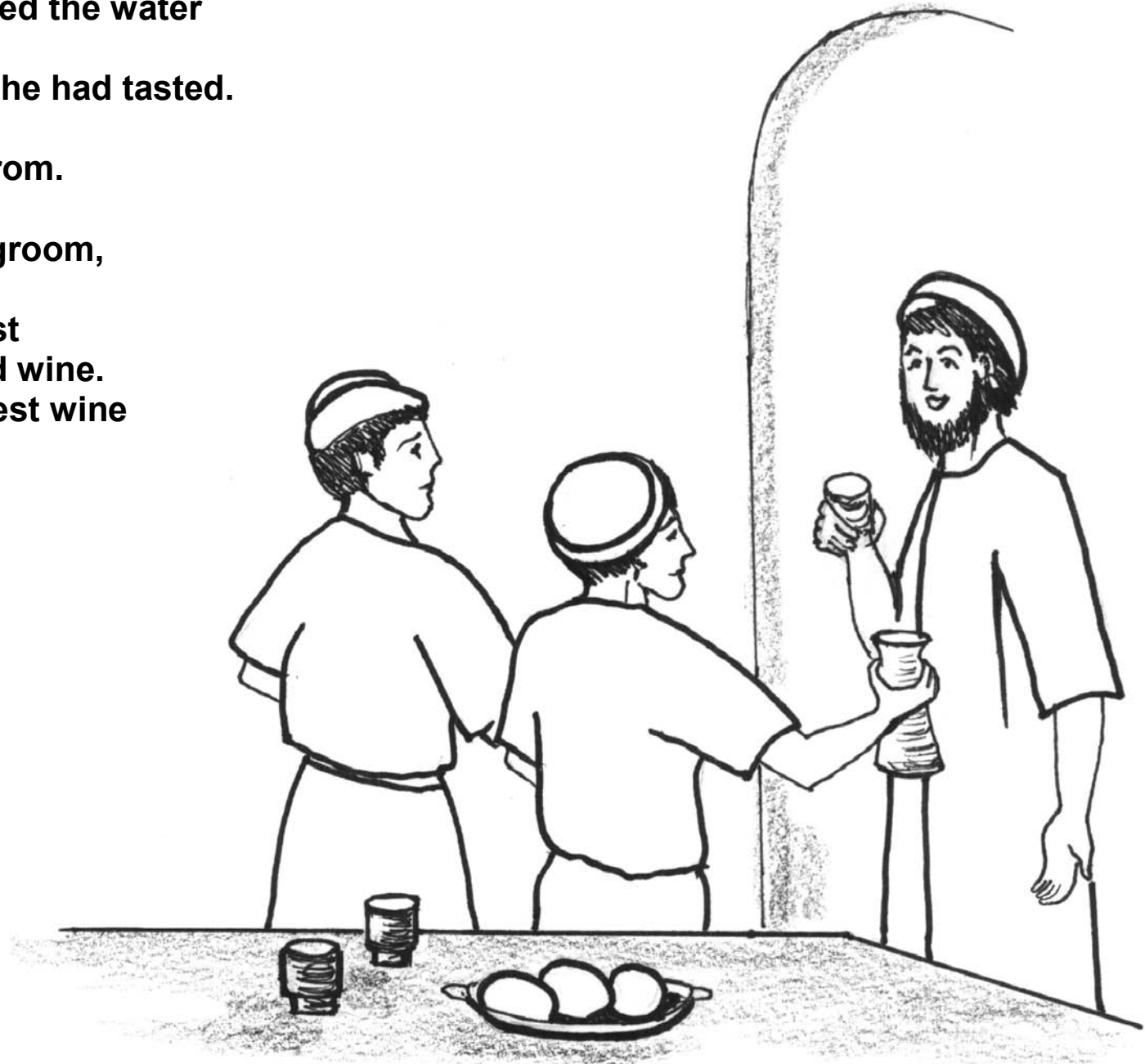
**Jesus said to the servants,

Psalm 69:9

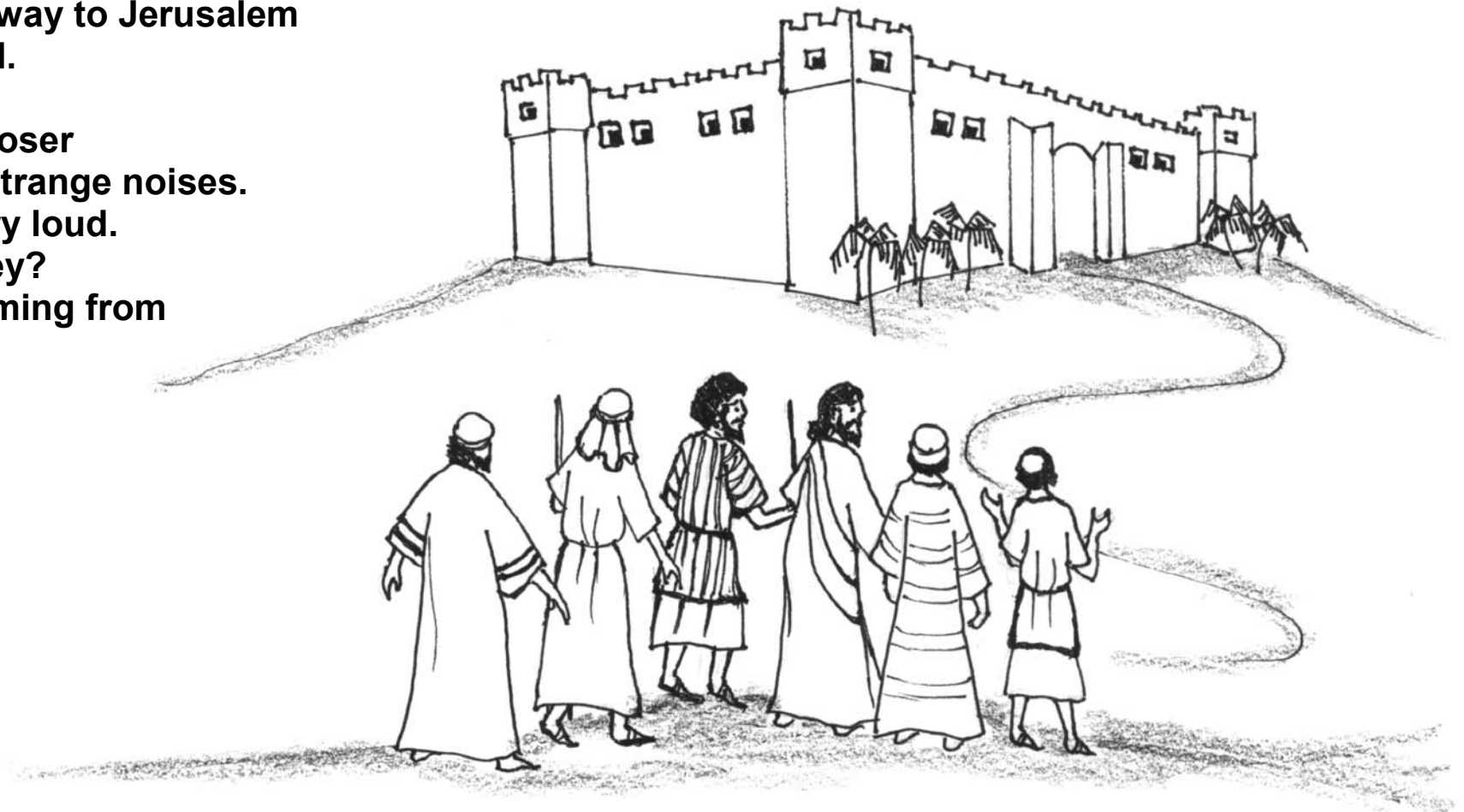
## **JESUS IN HIS FATHER'S HOUSE**

the temple!**



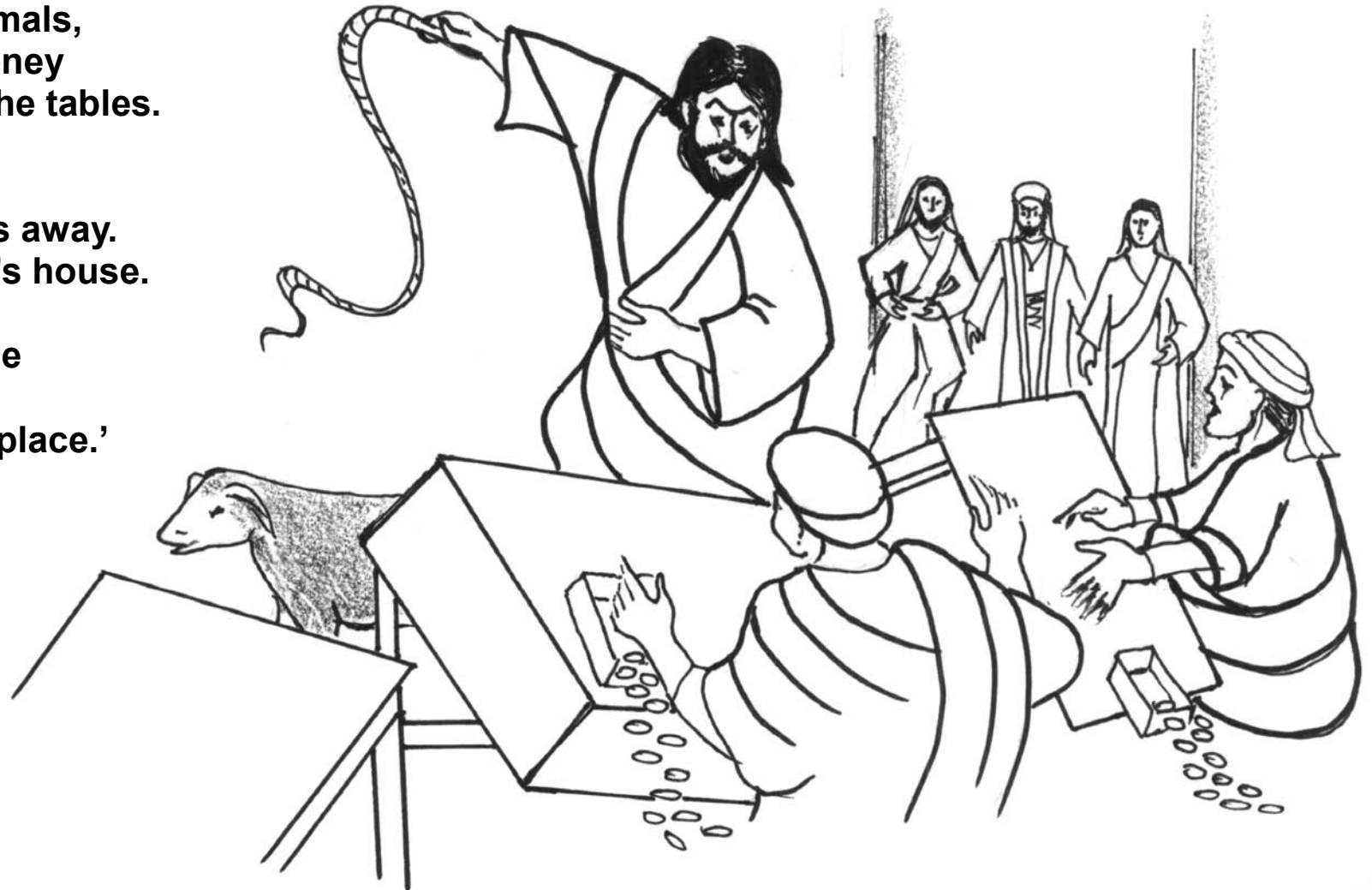
**When they got there,

and turned over the tables.**

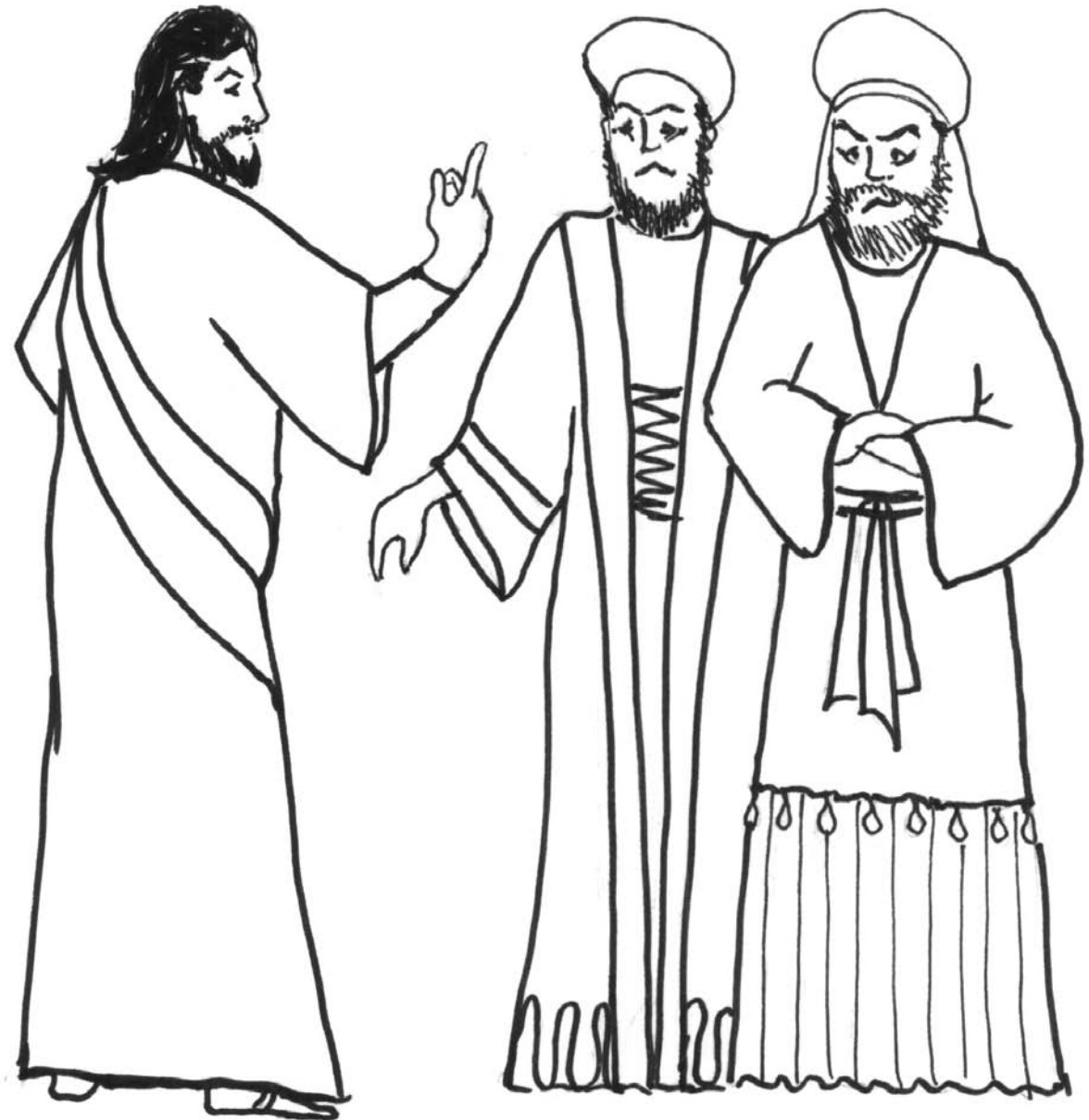
**Jesus said,

This is a place  
for people to come

right to do this.'**

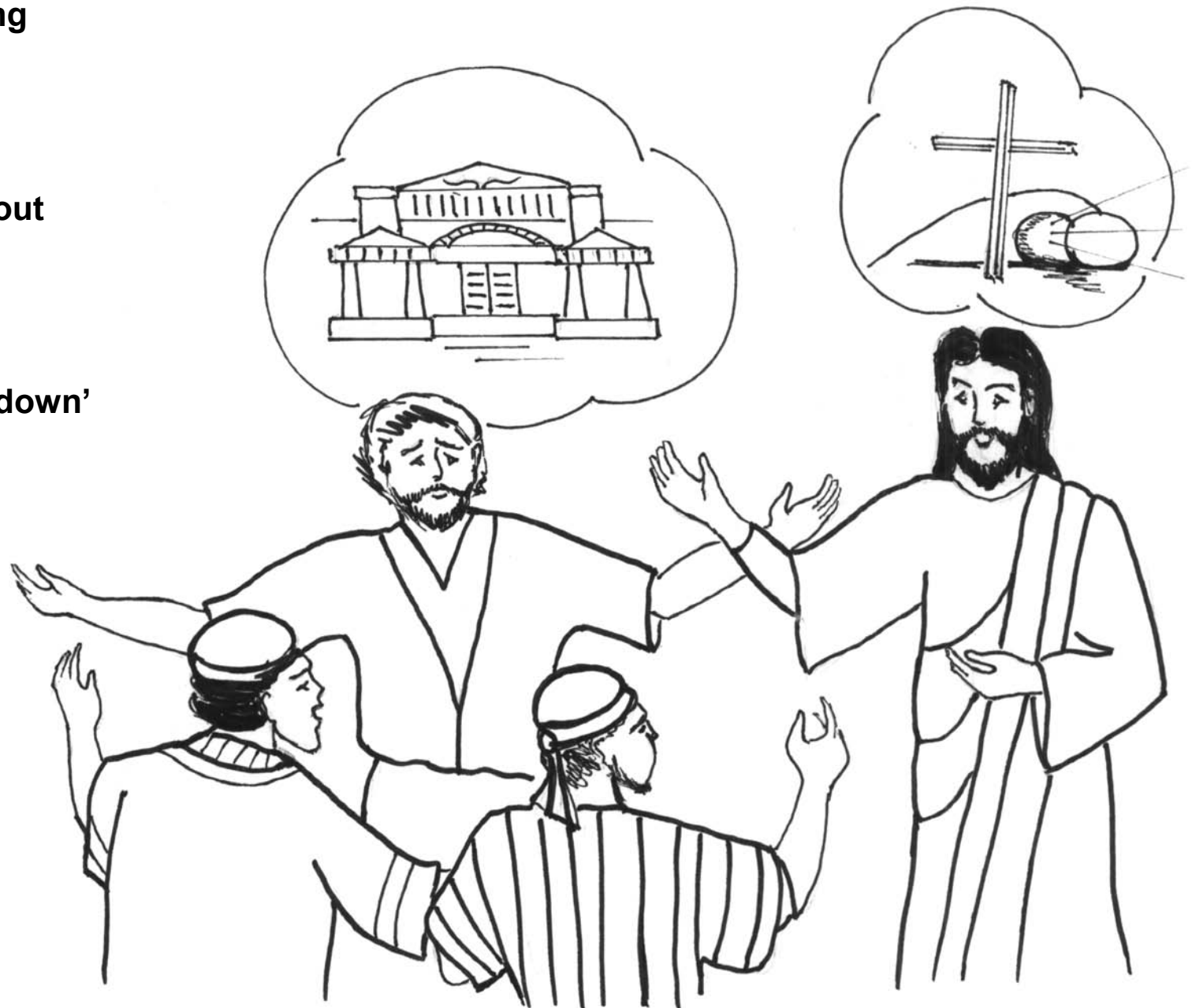
**Jesus answered them saying,

and they believed in Him.**



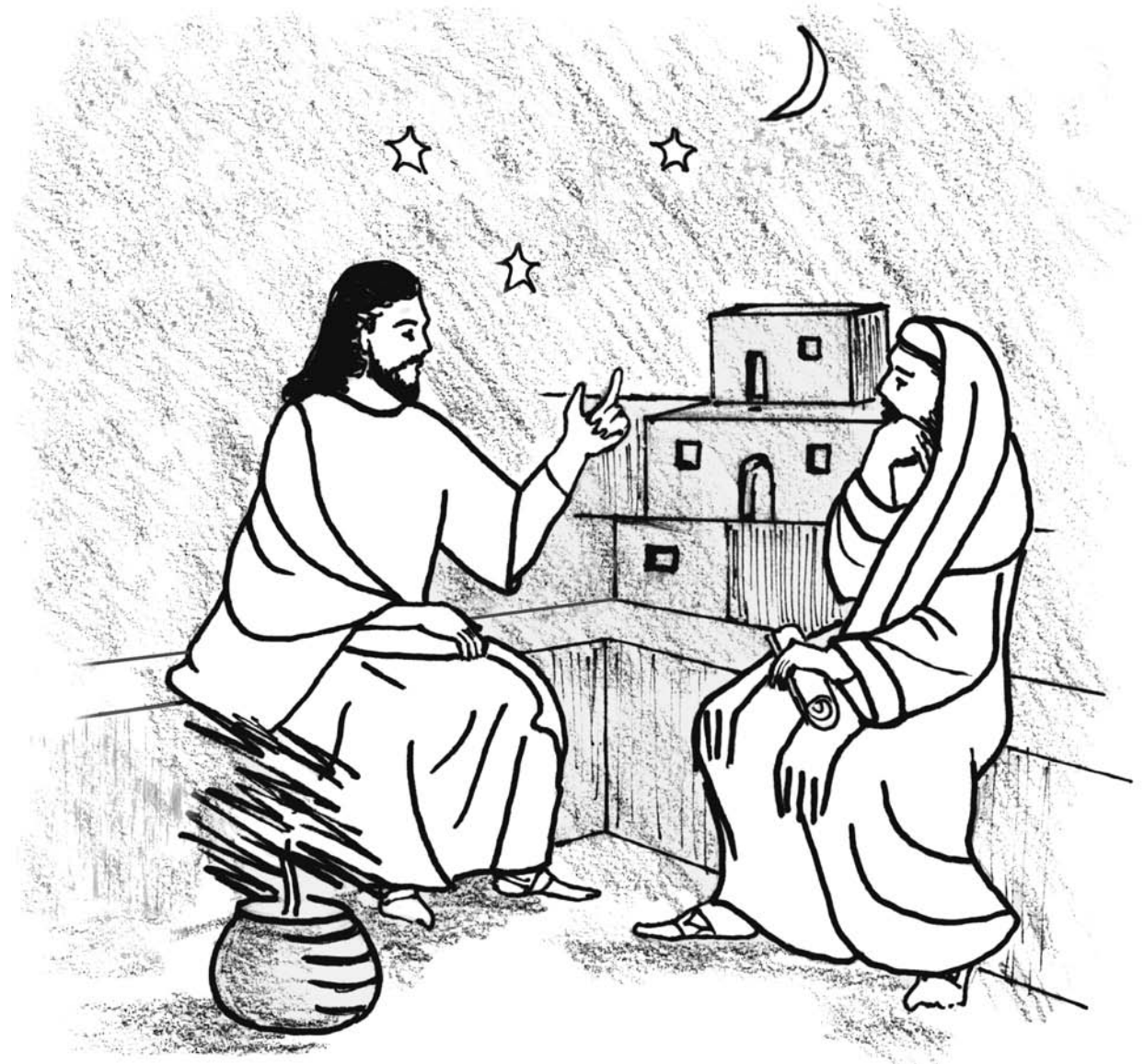
**Nicodemus, a teacher of God's law,

were saved.**

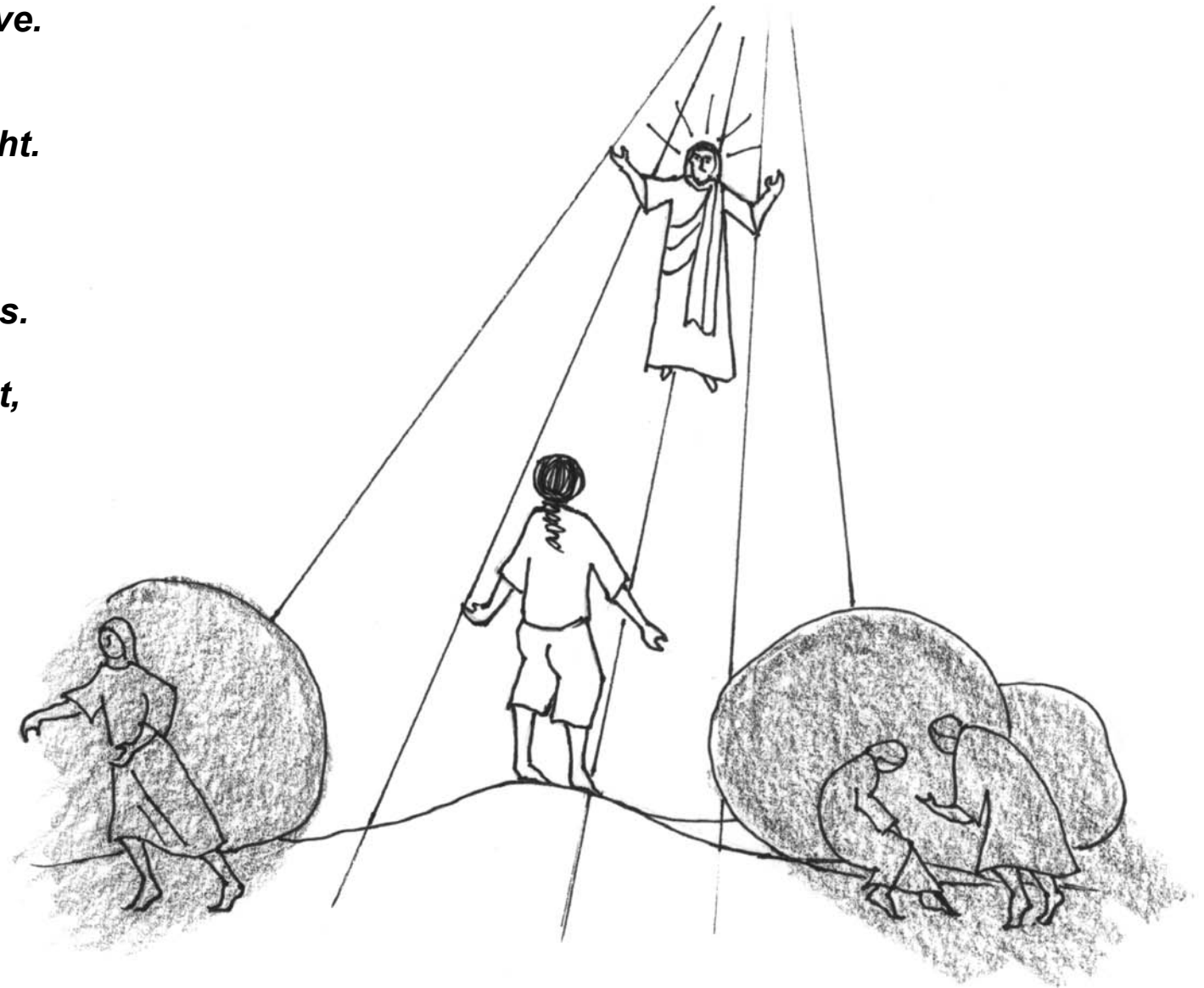
**‘I must be lifted up like that.

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# ***THE WOMAN AT THE WELL***

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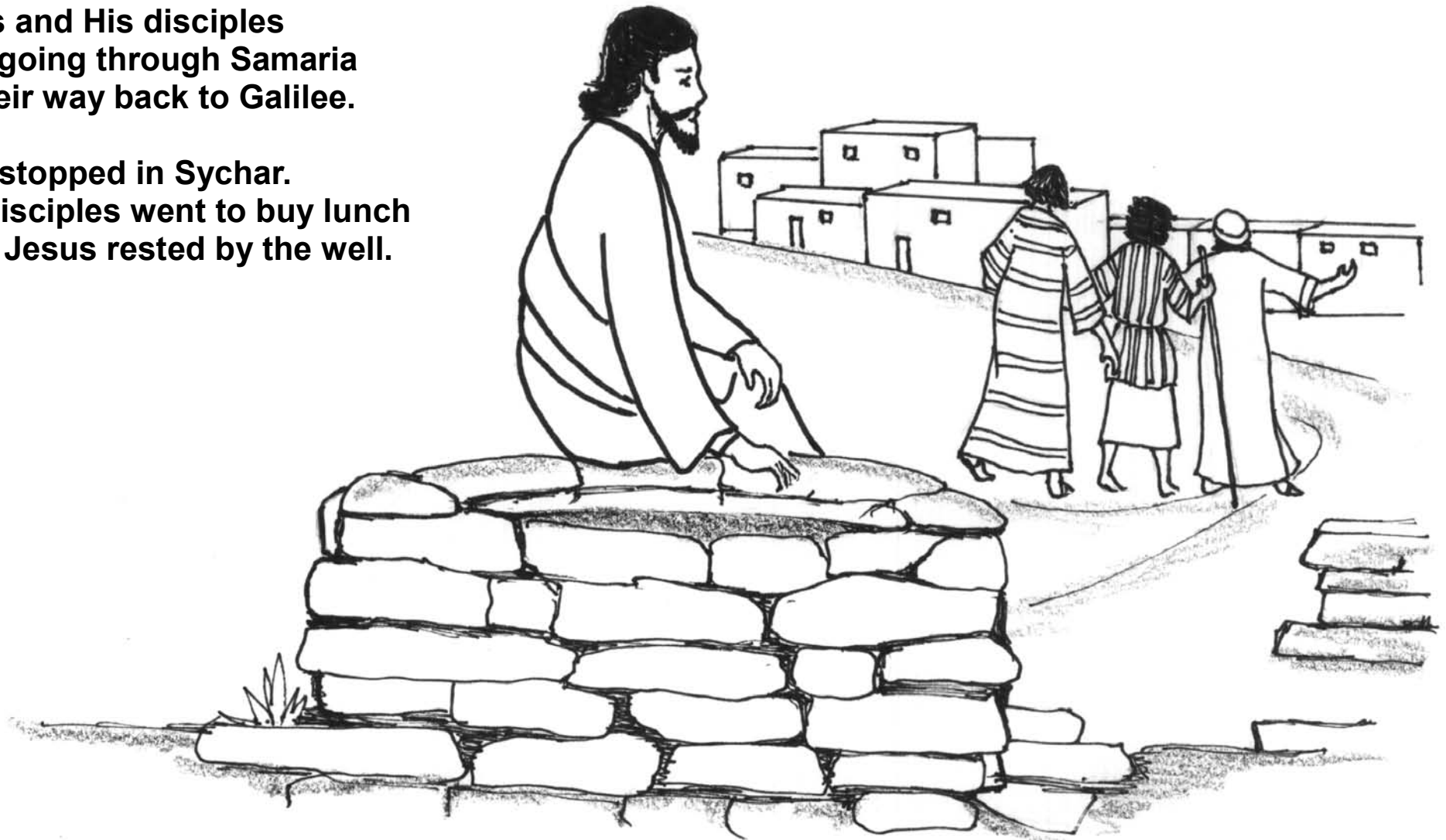
**JOHN 4:1-42**

while Jesus rested by the well.**

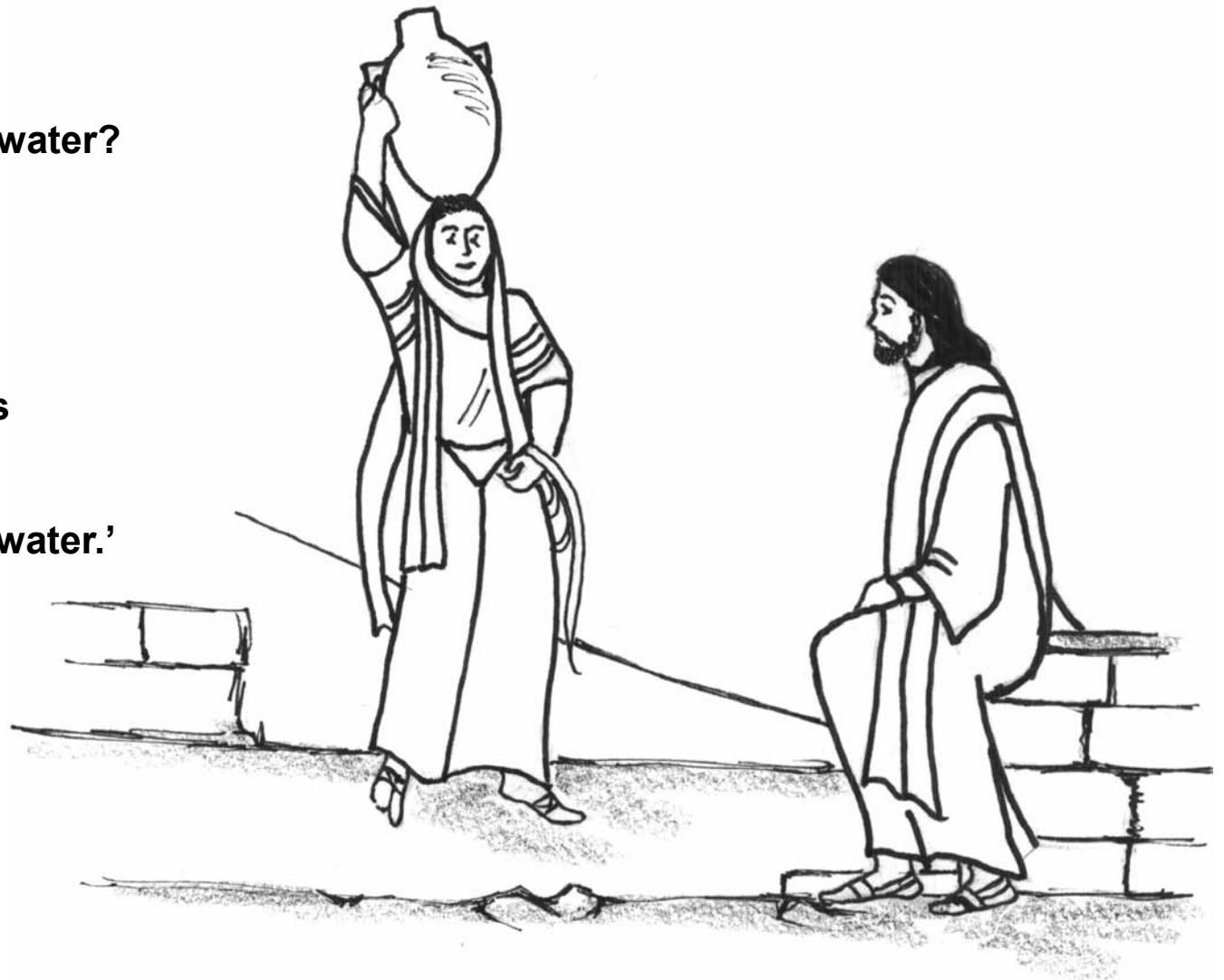


**He had not been there very long

to each other.'**

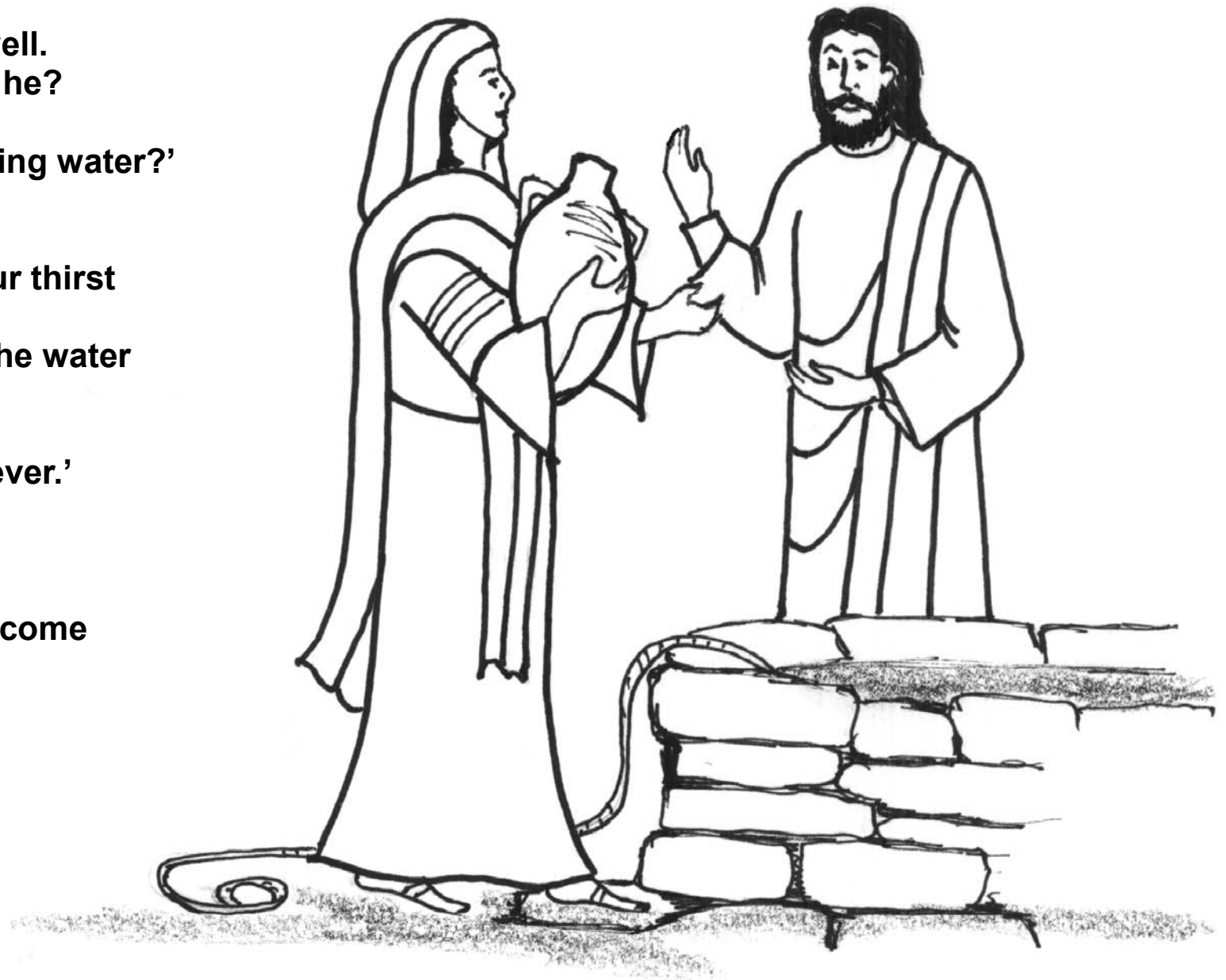
**Jesus said,

that Jesus knew her.**

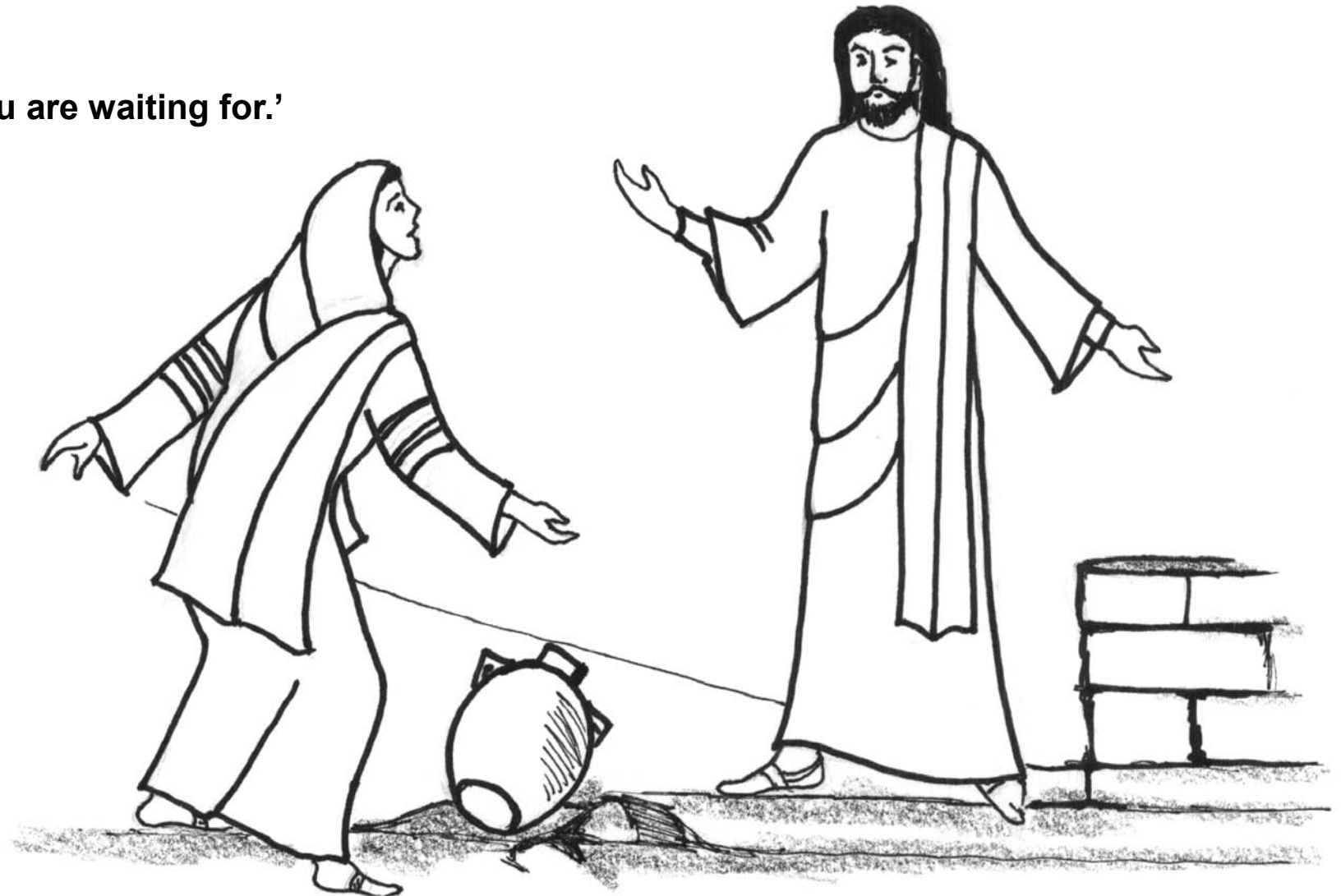
**The lady said,

in spirit and truth.’**



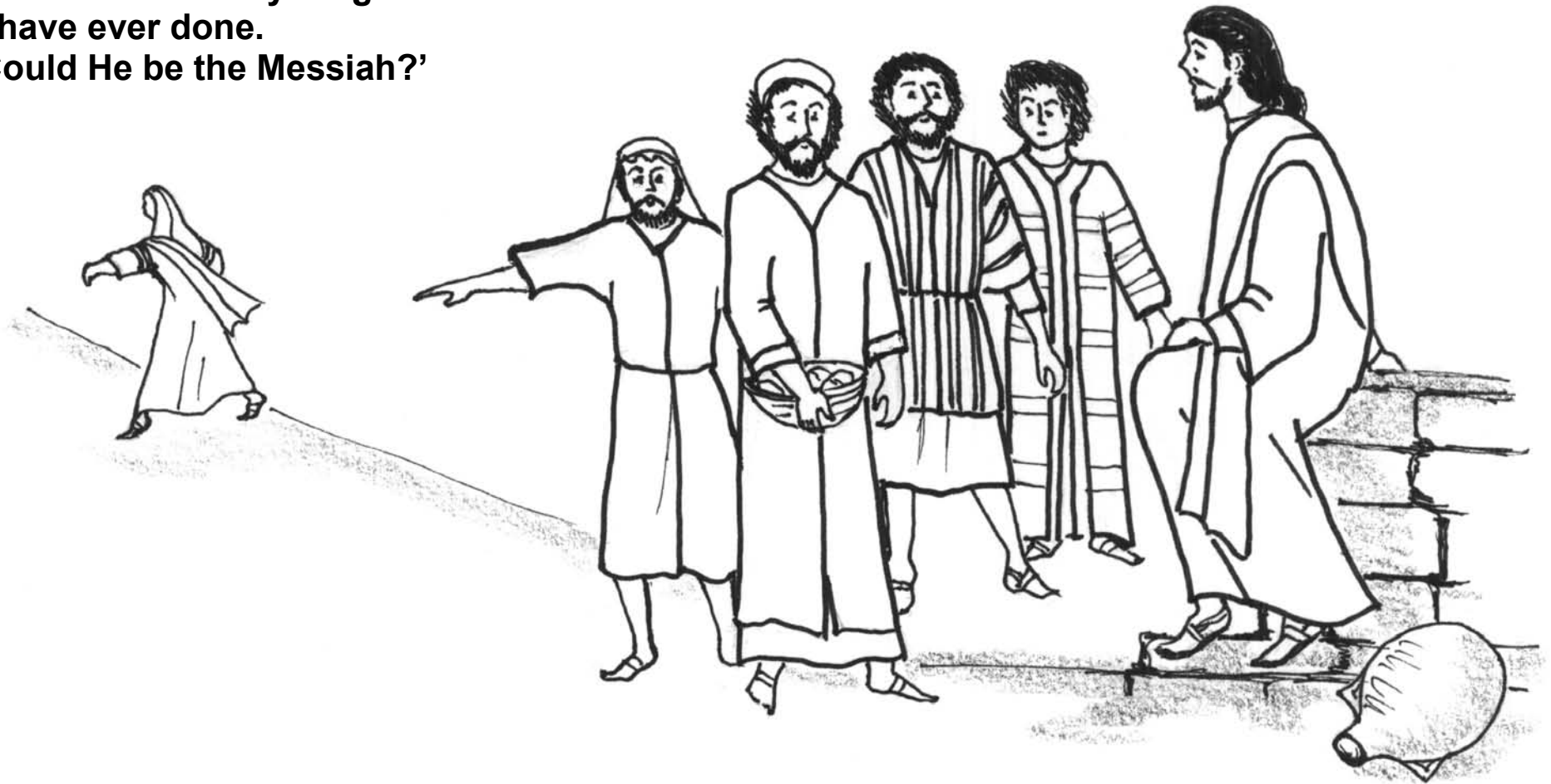
**'Sir, I know that the Messiah is coming.

and ran back to the village.**

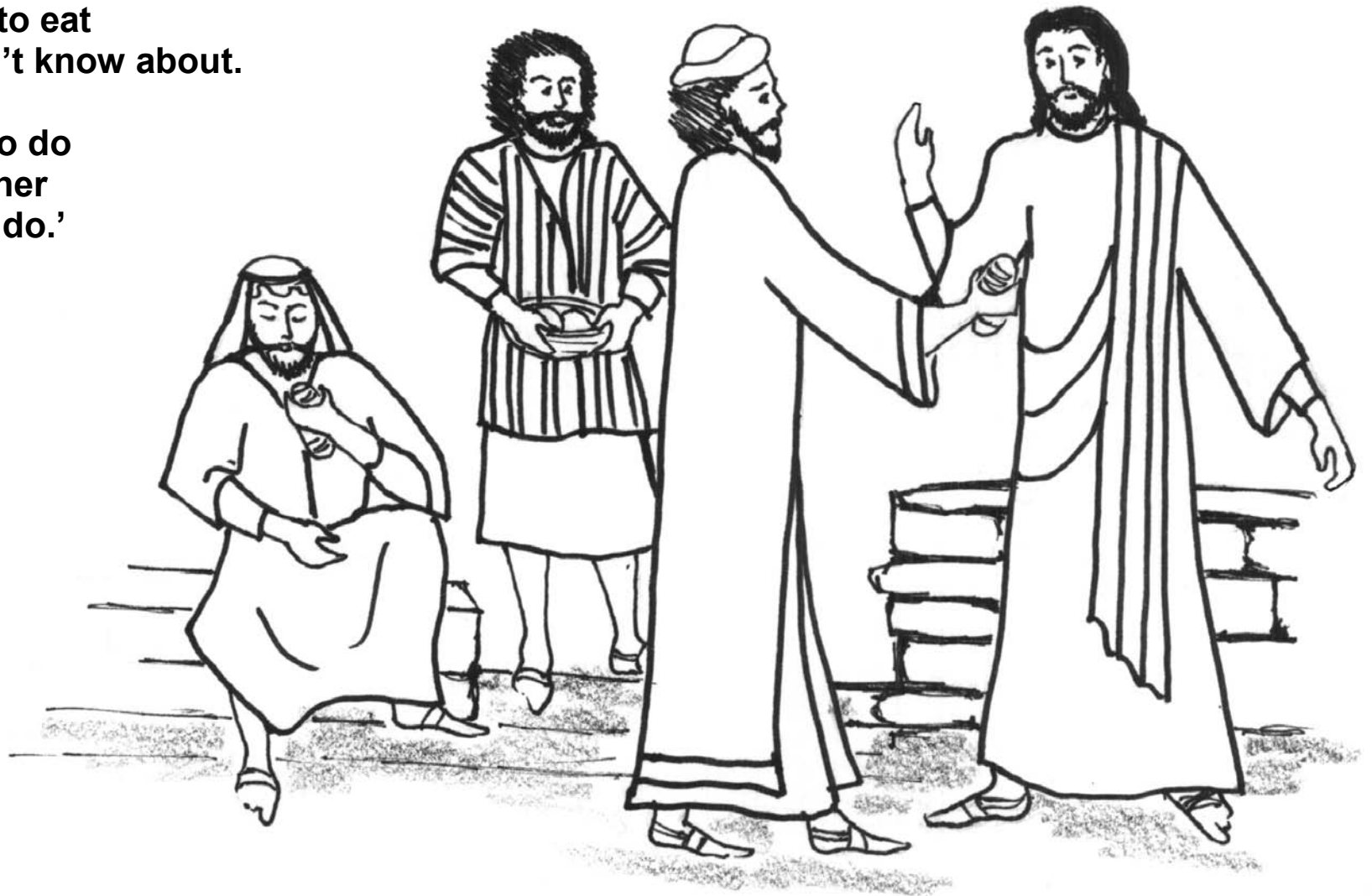
**‘Come quickly,’

that you don't know about.'**

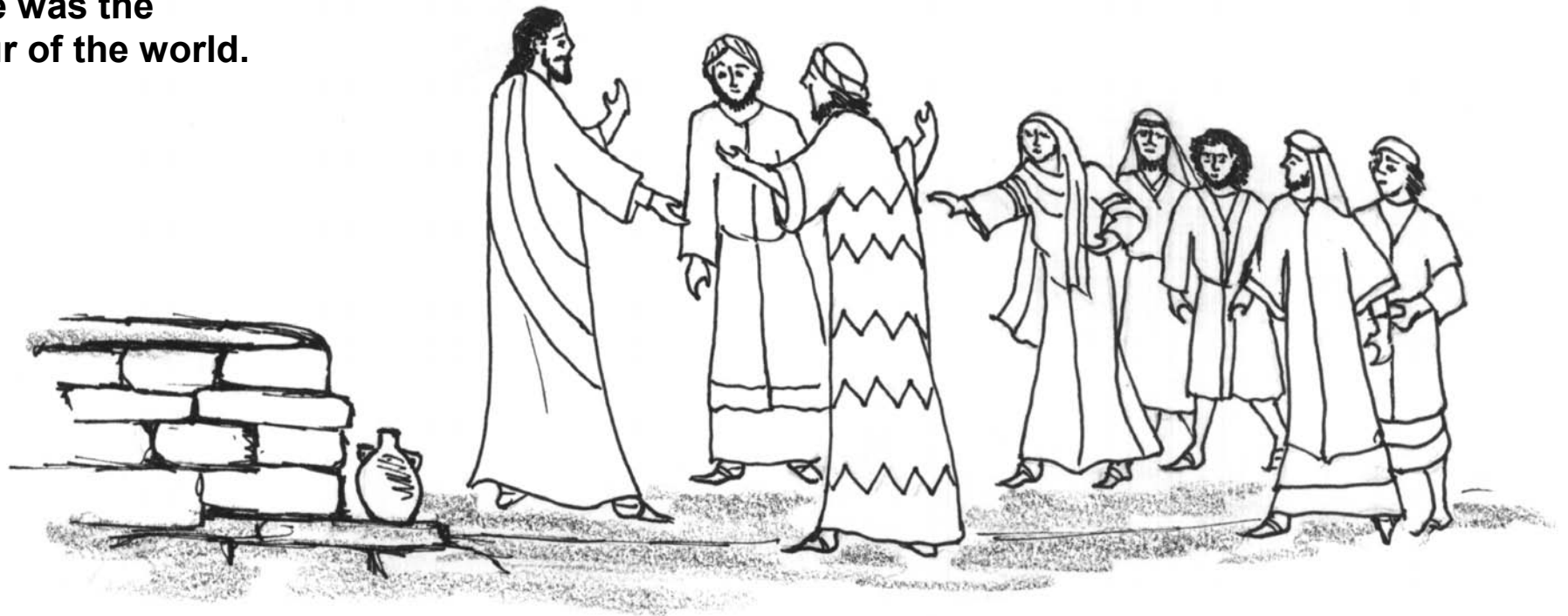
**'My food is to do

talking to a few people.**

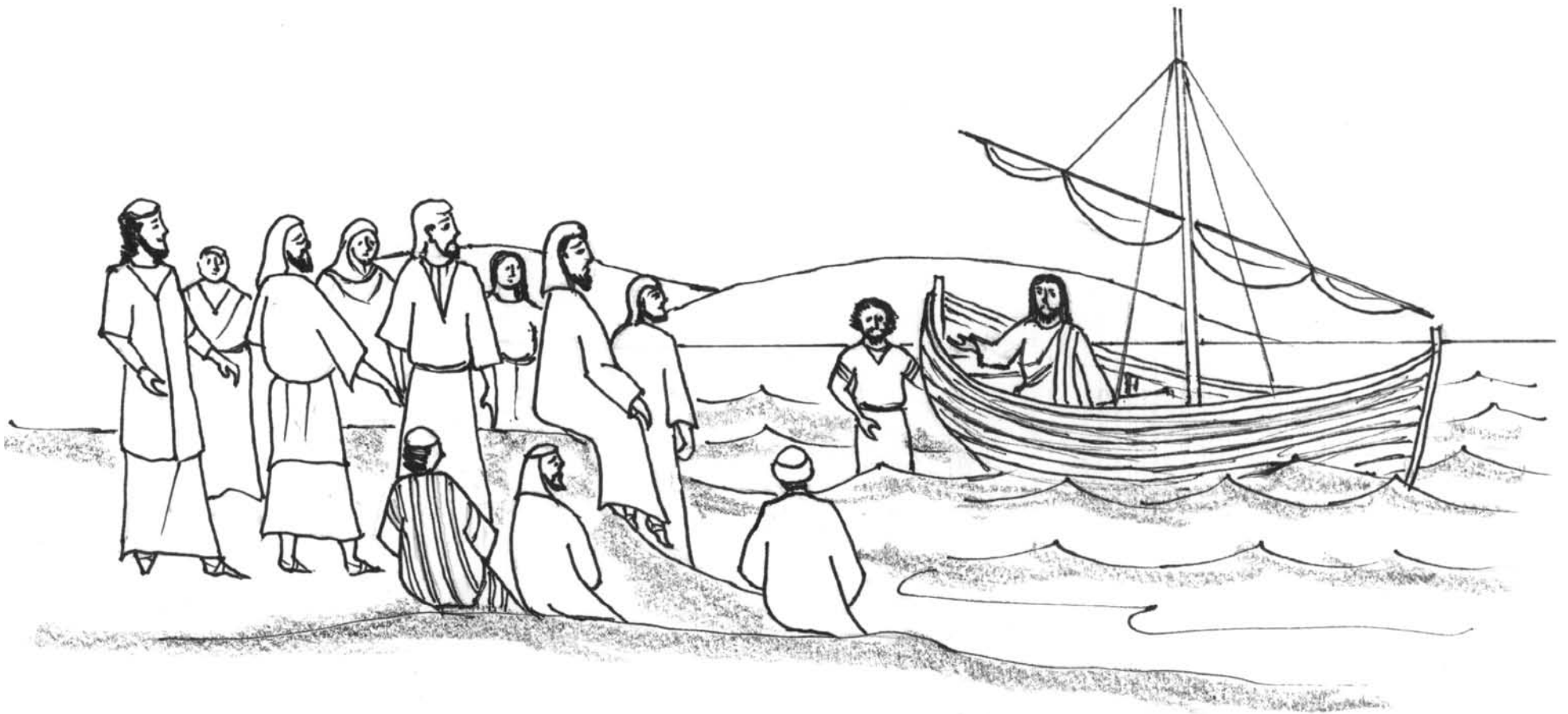
**Others joined them

**Everyone tried to get close to Him.**

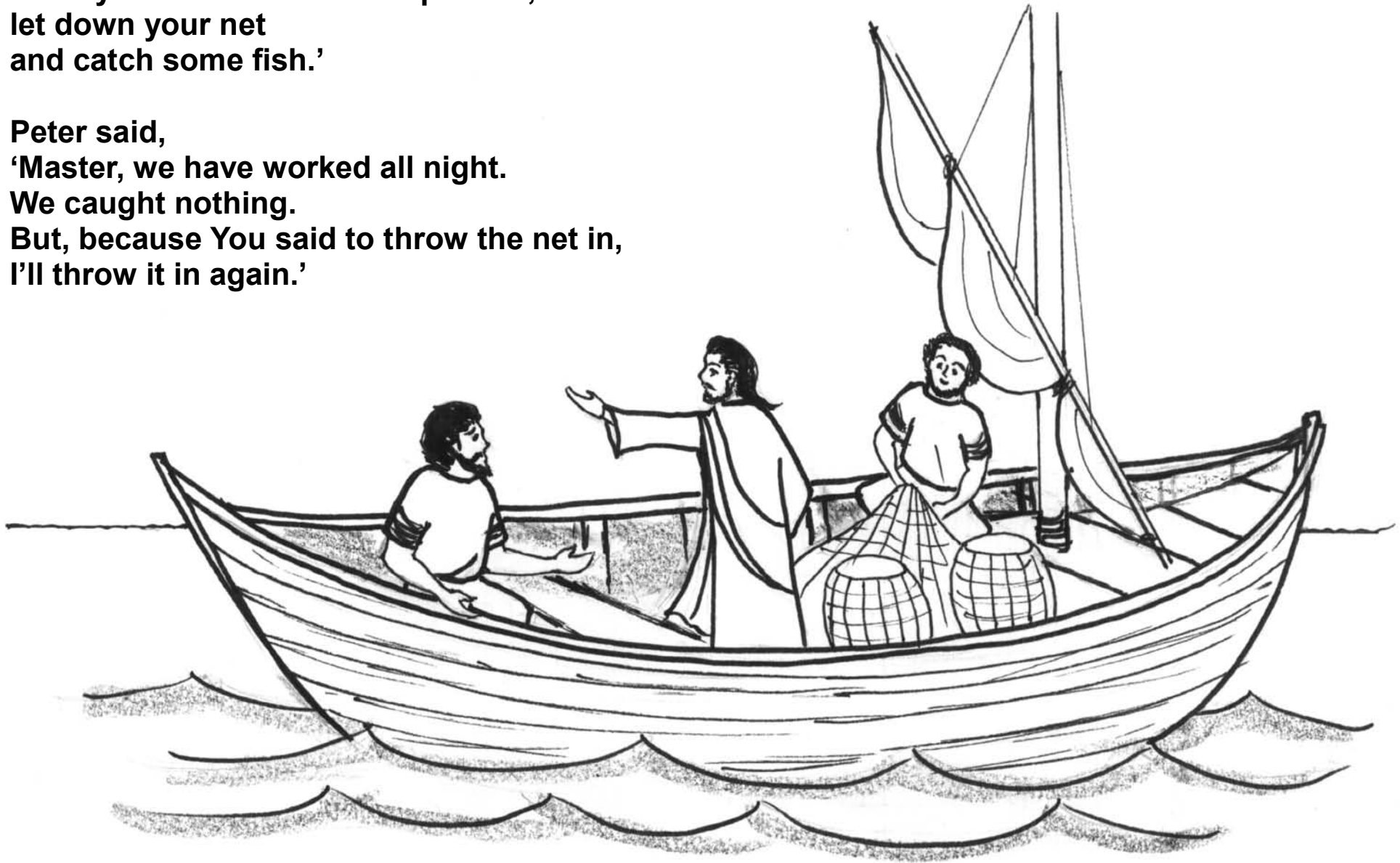
**So Jesus looked around

I'll throw it in again.'**

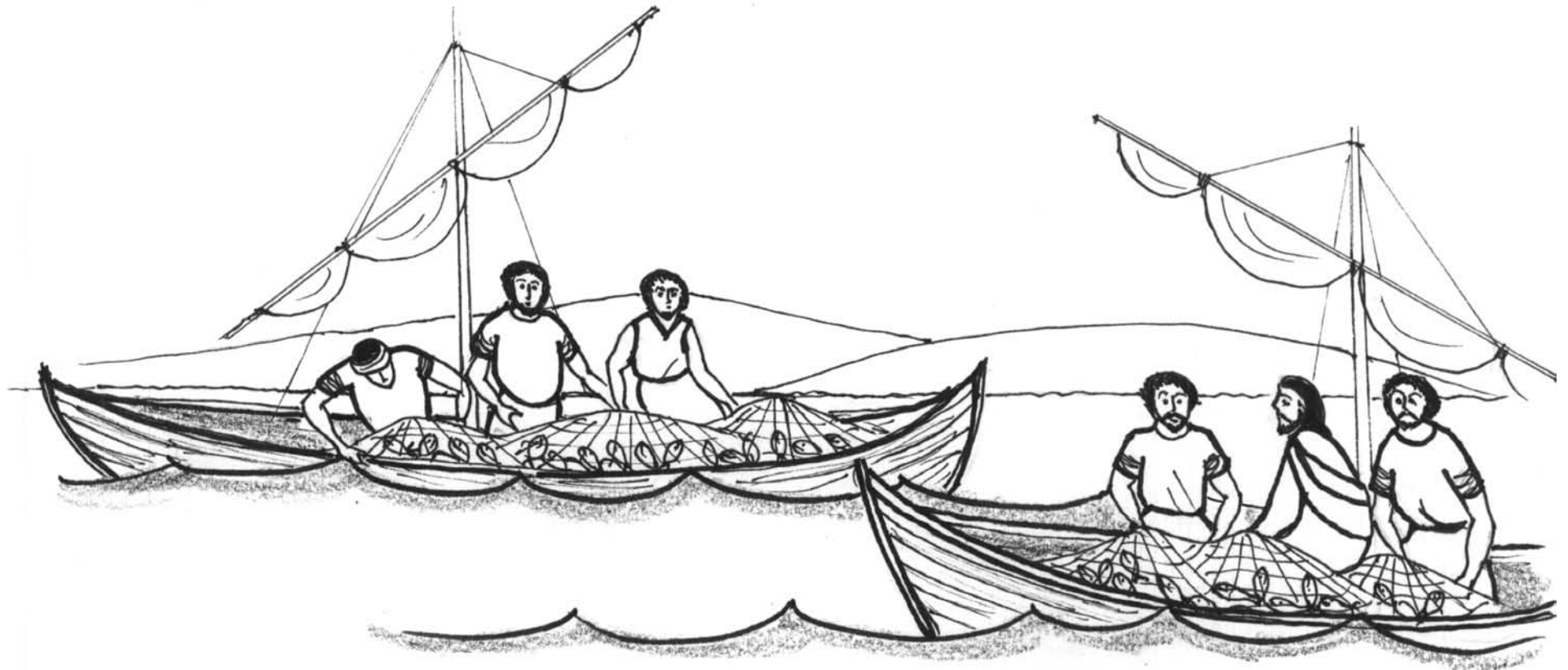


**He did what Jesus told him to do

'Come and help us.'**



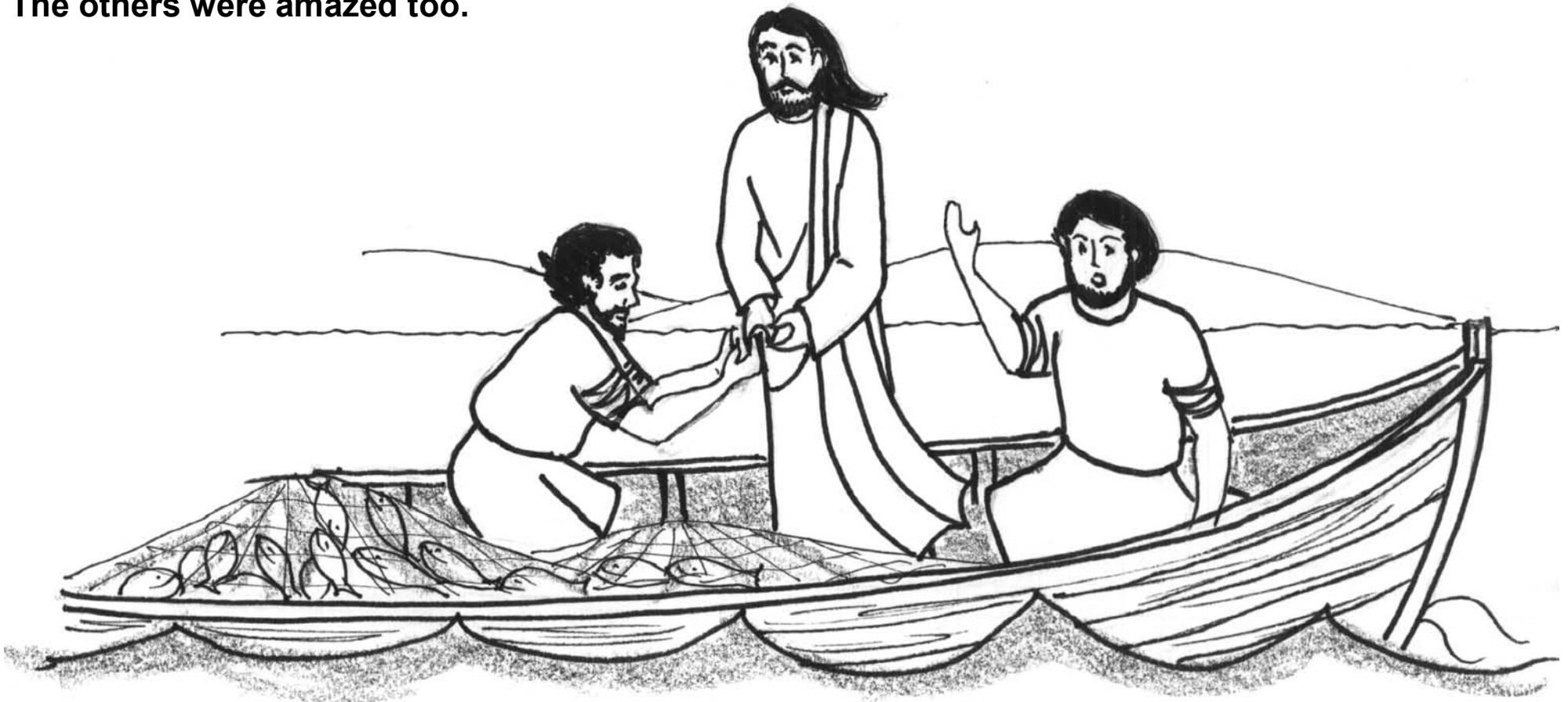
**James and John came with their boat.

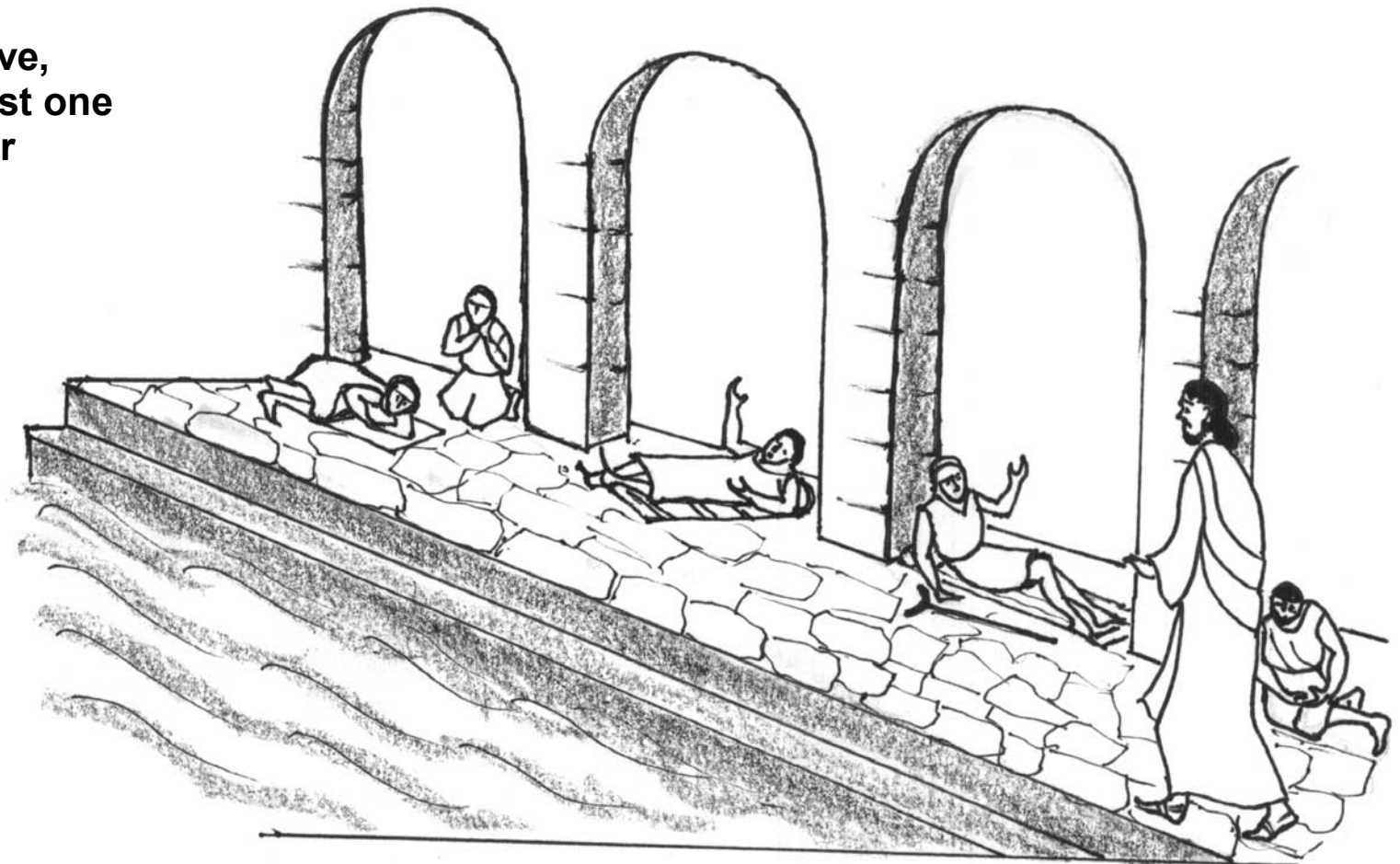
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**JOHN 5:1-24**

would be healed.**

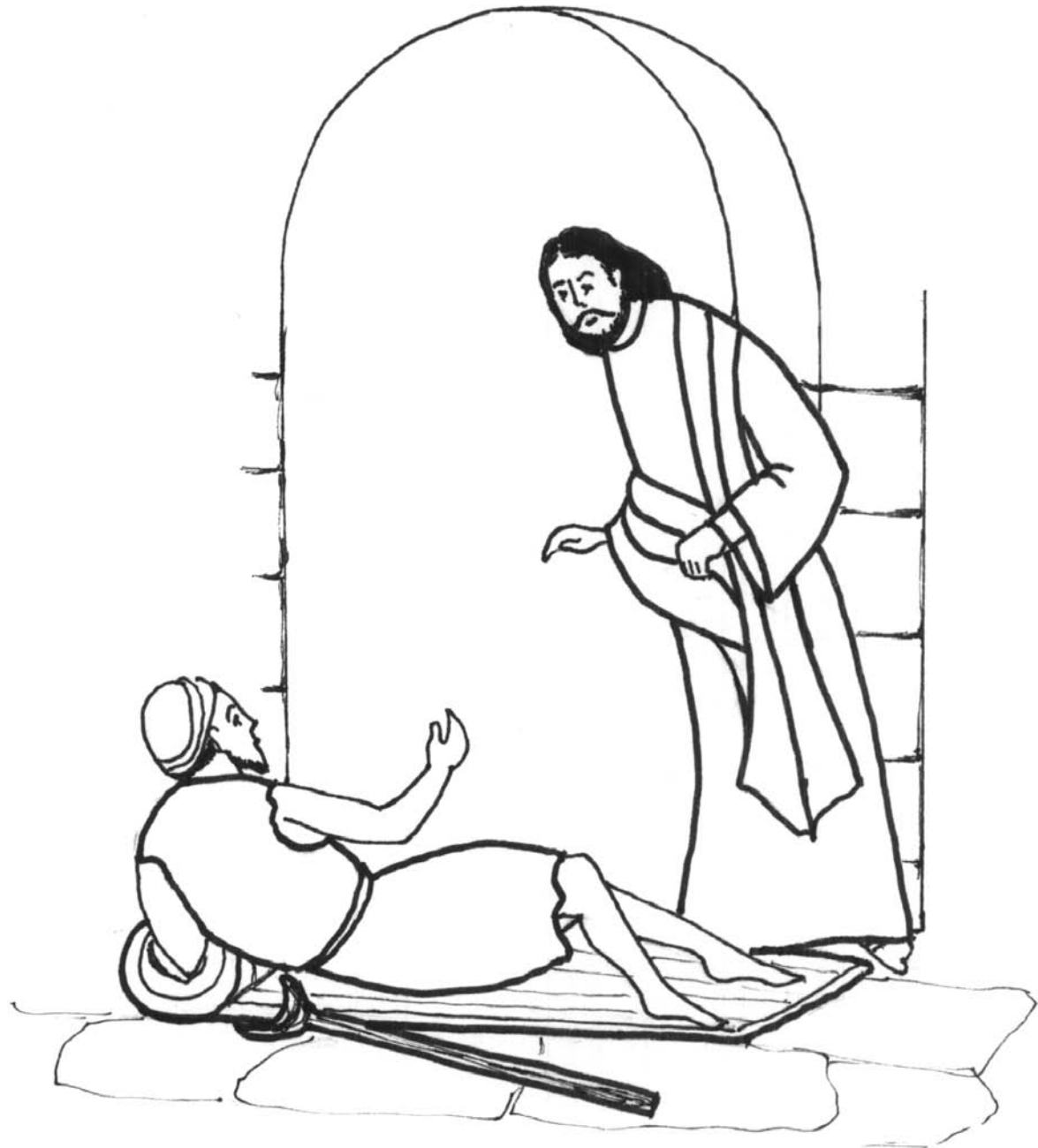


**Jesus spoke to a man

no work was to be done.**

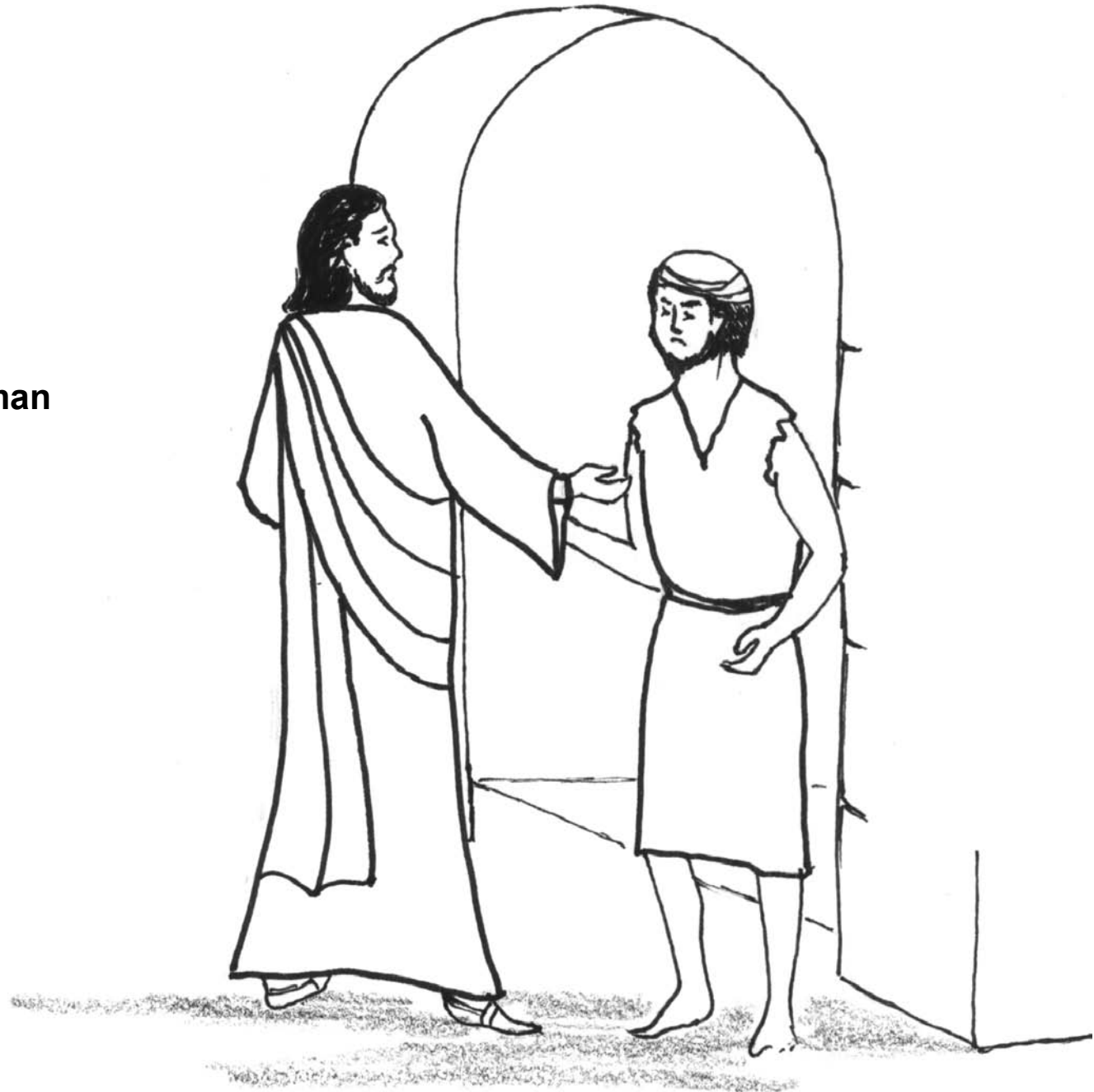
**The man walked

who healed me.**

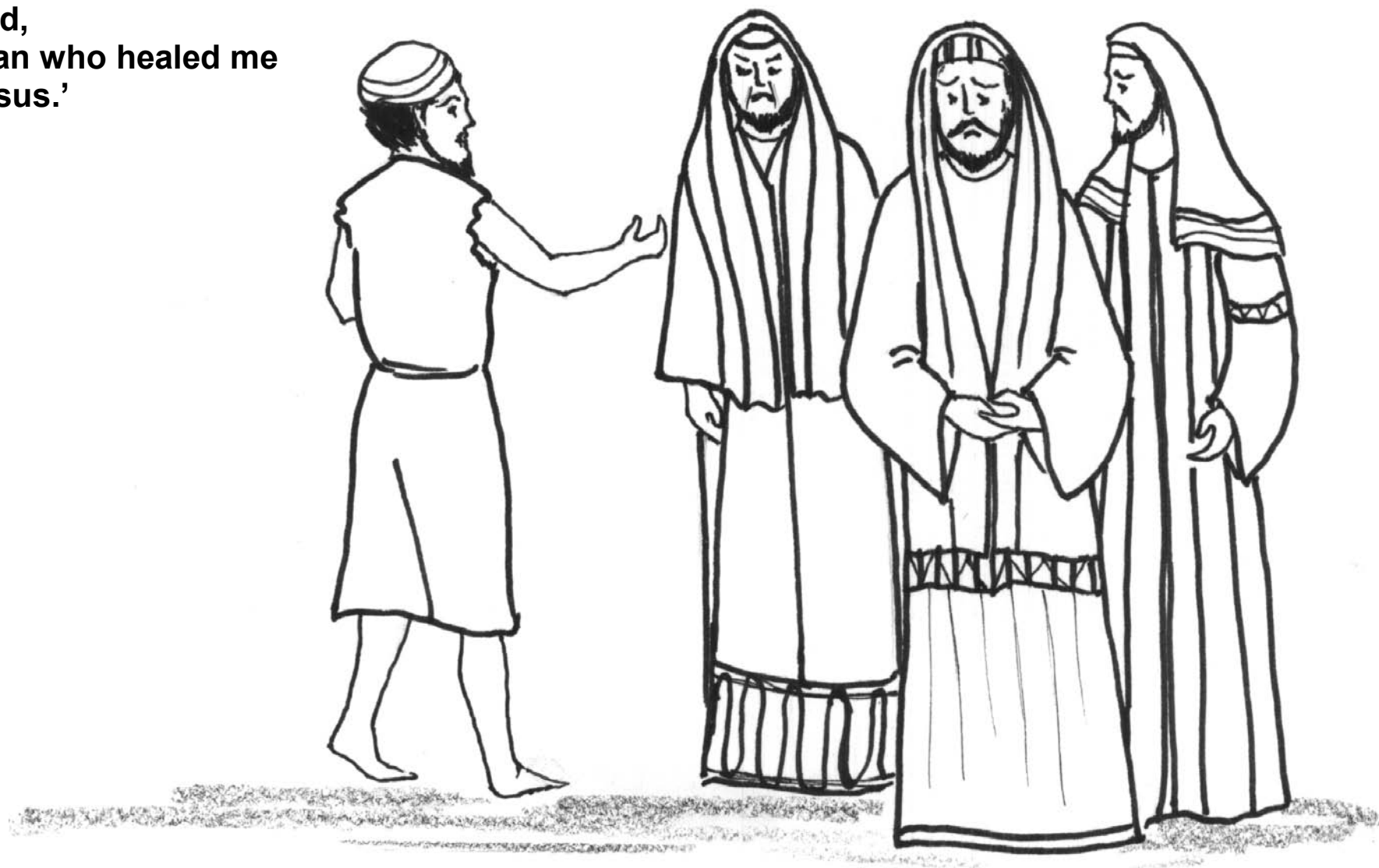


**Later, Jesus found the man

may happen to you'**



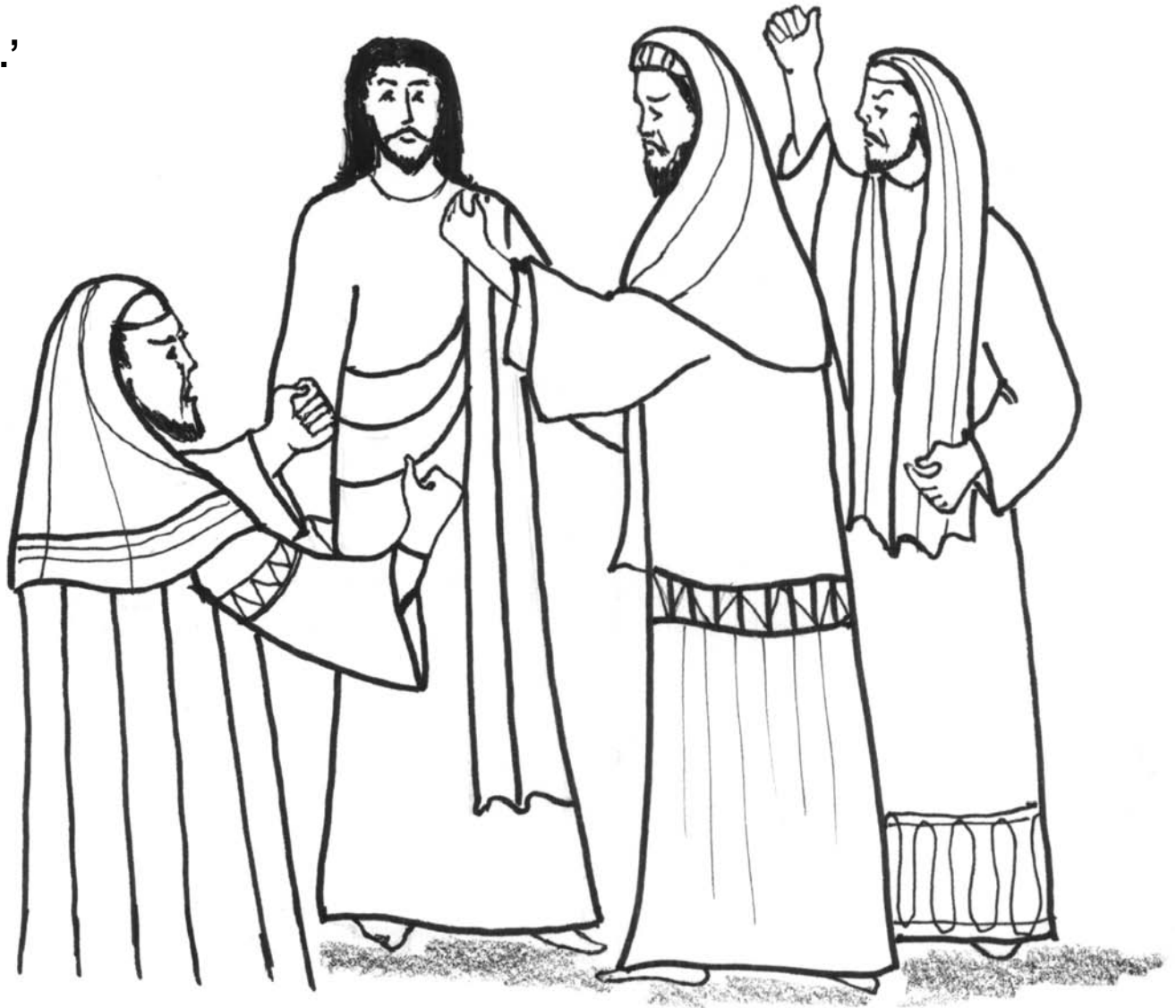
**Straight away the man went

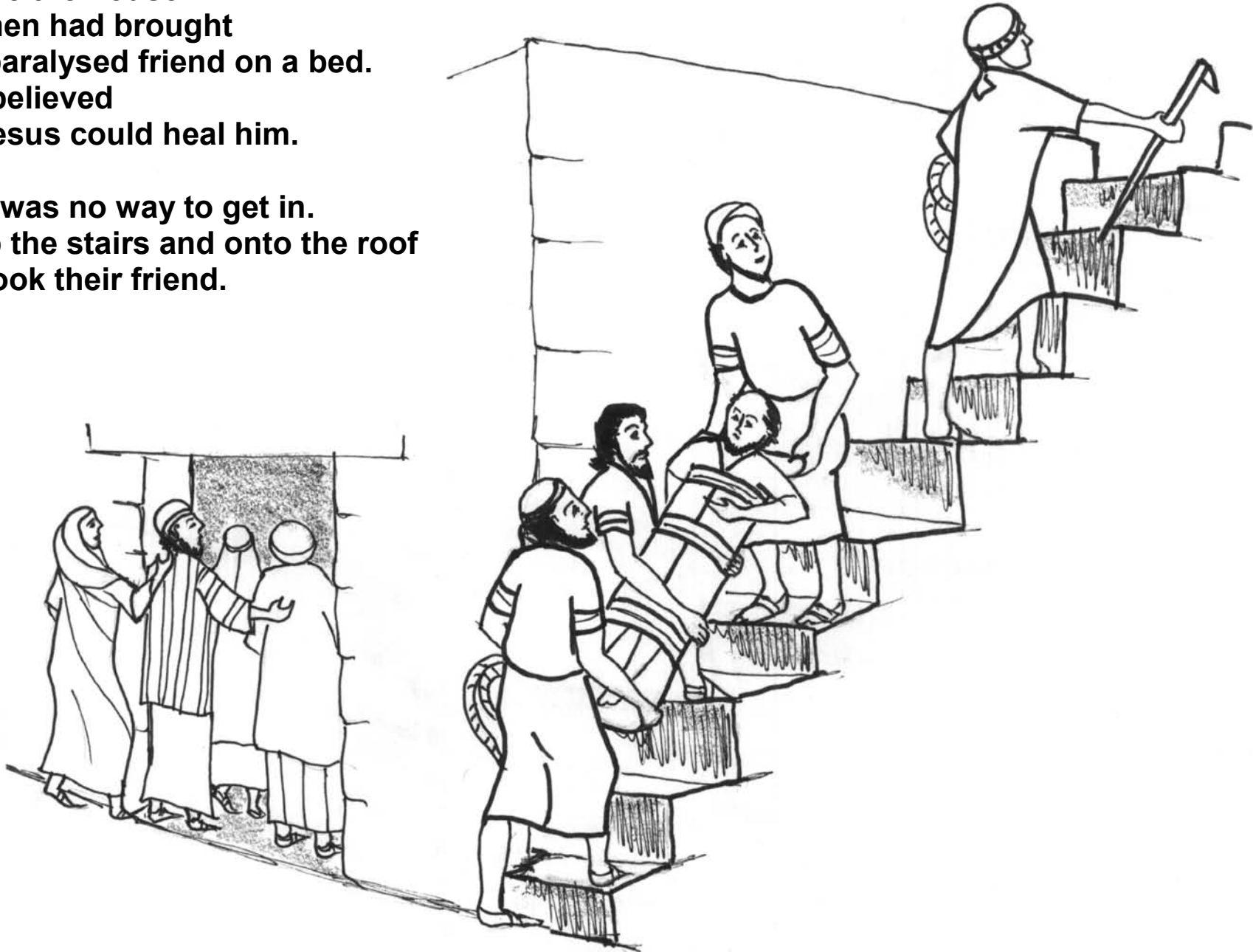
**The news was out.

that Jesus could heal him.**

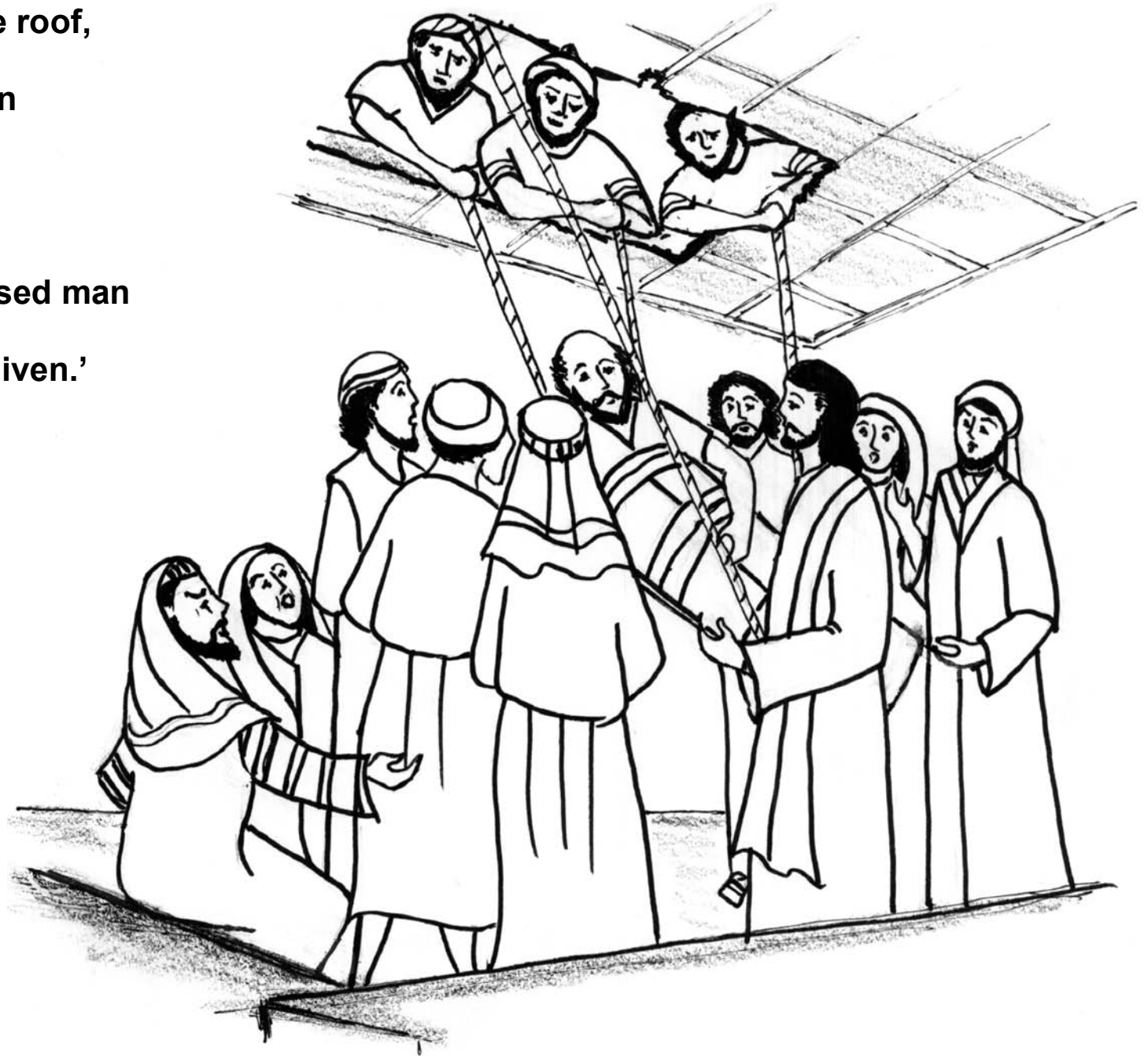
**There was no way to get in.

right in front of Jesus.**

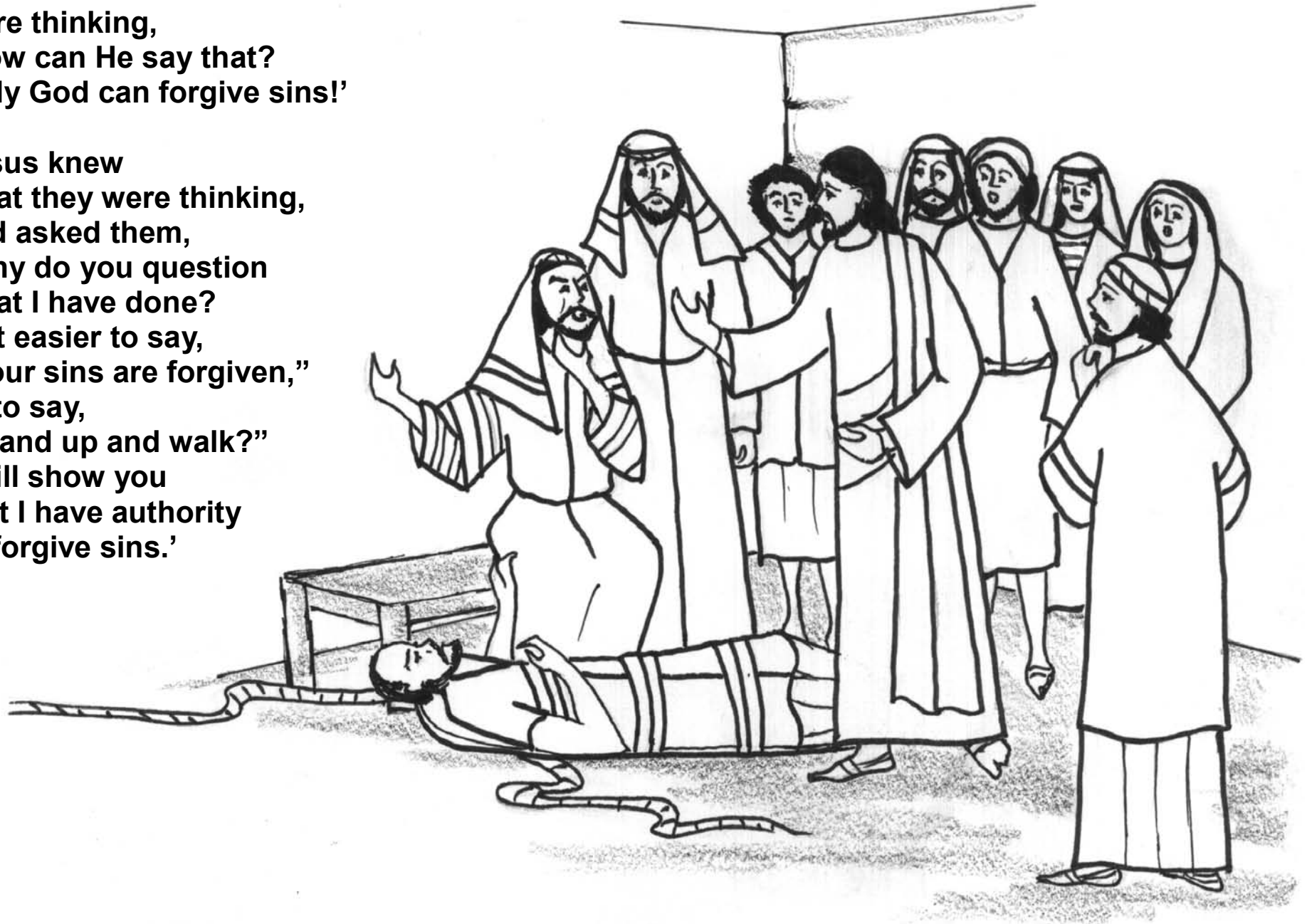
**Jesus saw their faith.**

to forgive sins.'**

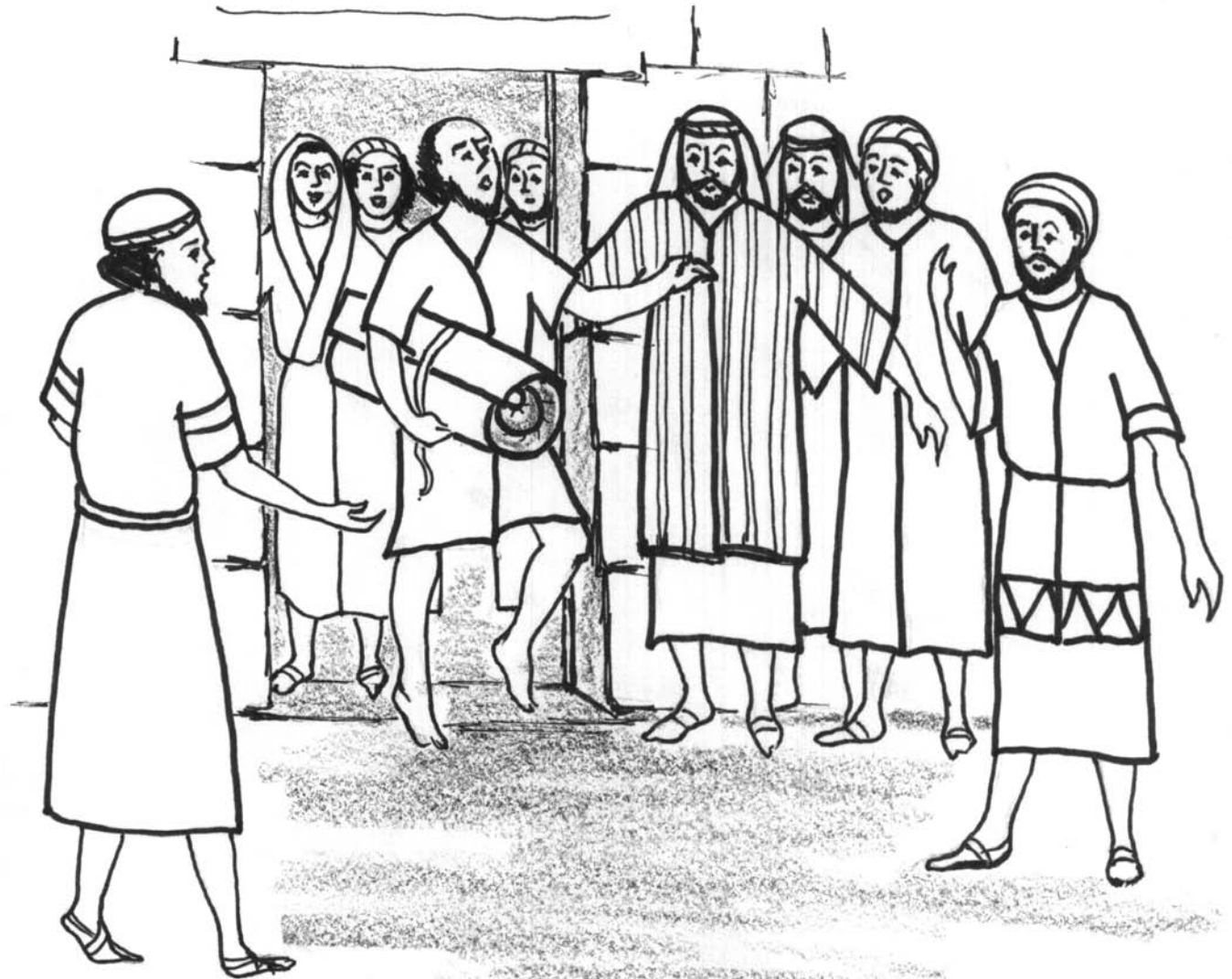


**He then turned to the sick man

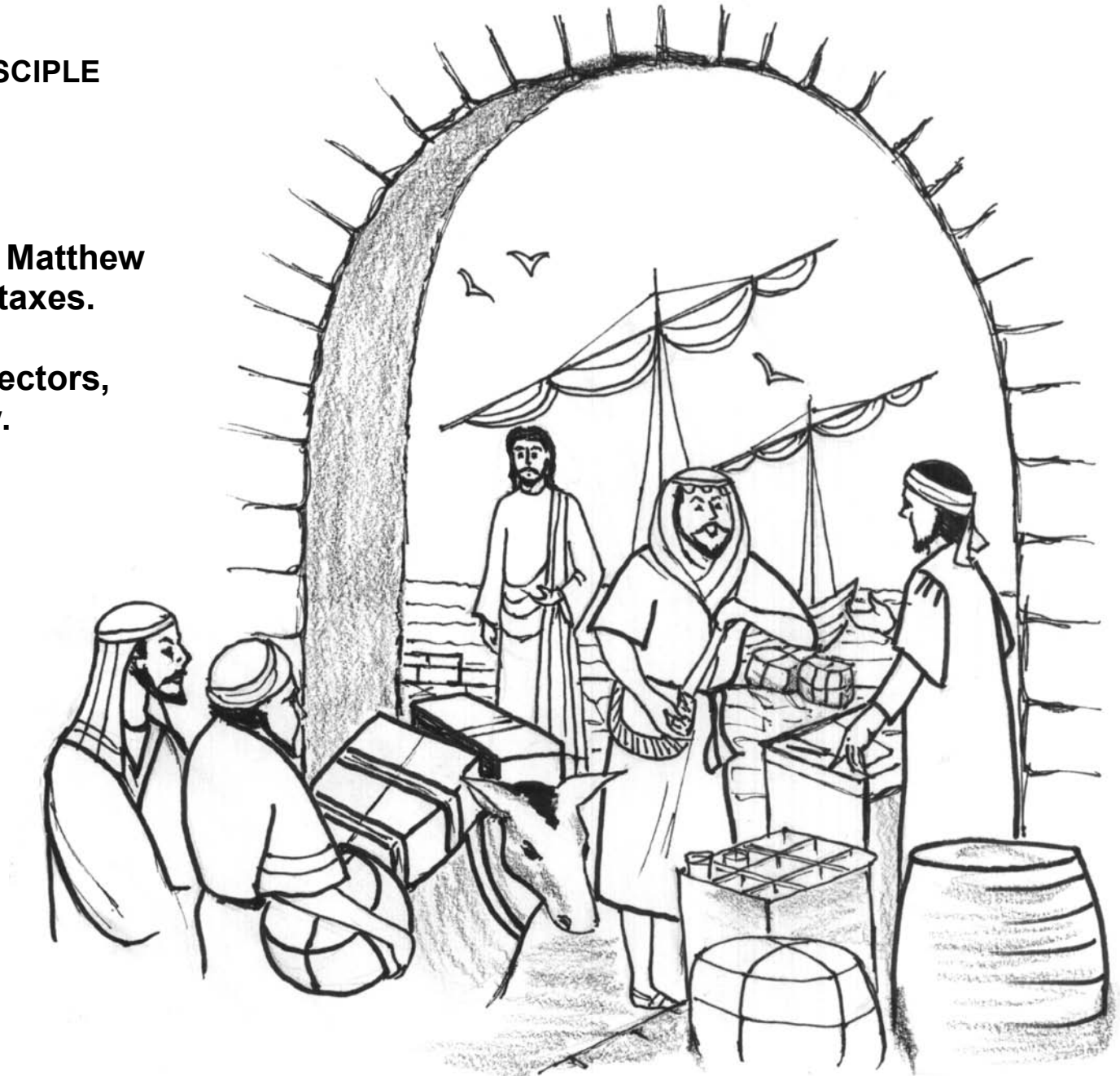
Mark 2:13–17; Luke 5:27–32

and they hated Matthew.**

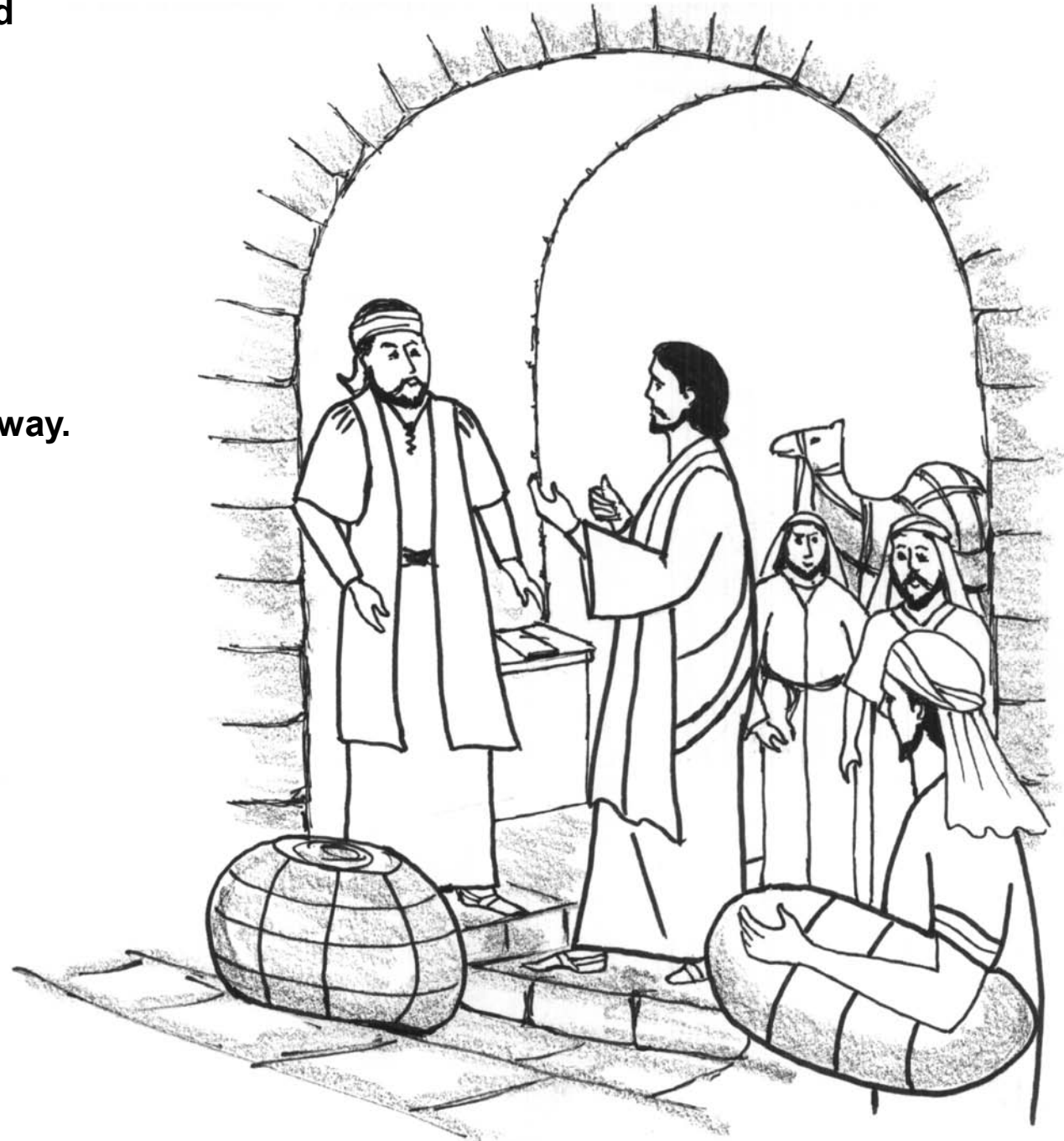


**Sometimes Matthew heard

'Come and follow Me.'**

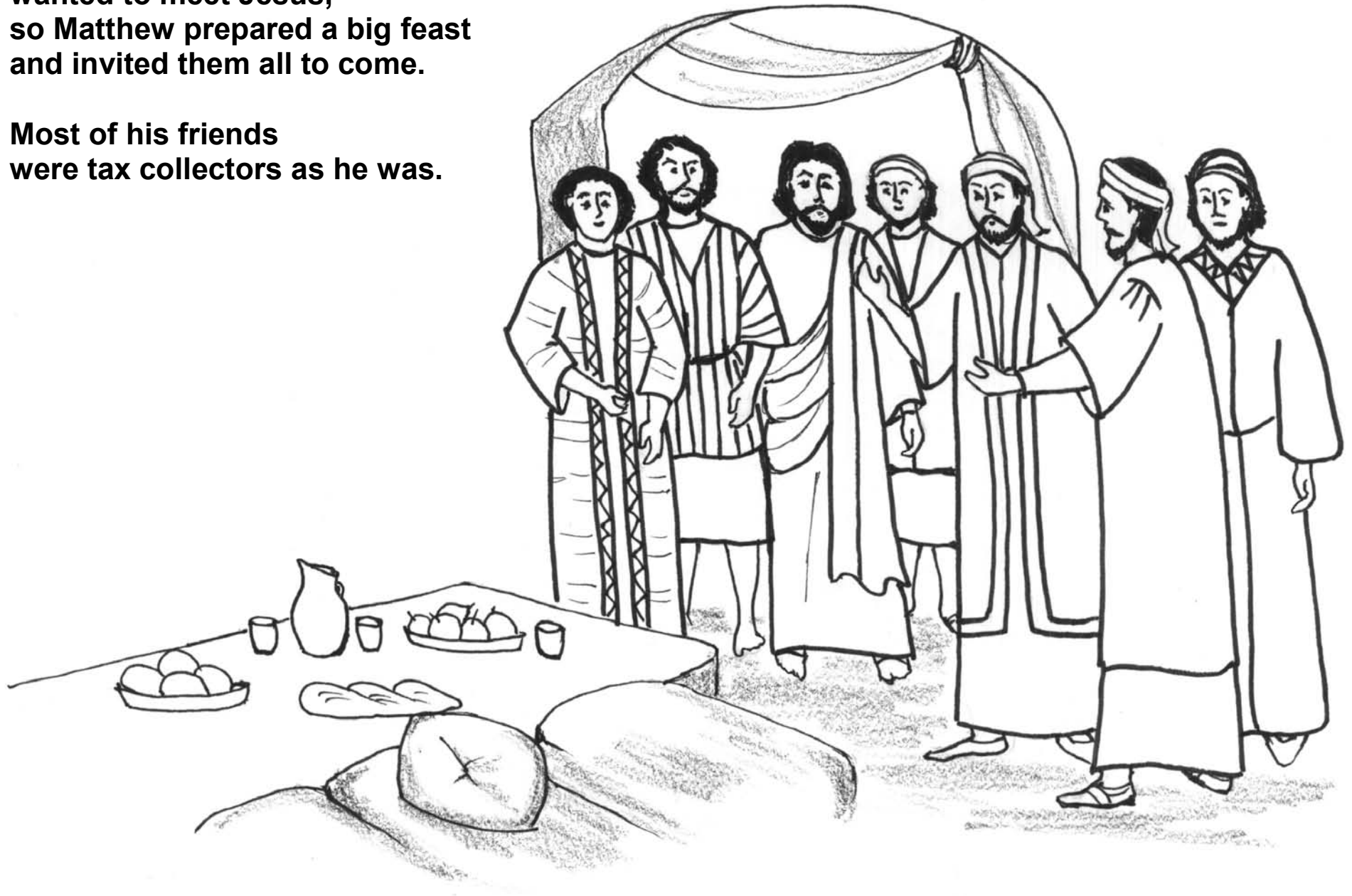
**Matthew got up straight away.

and invited them all to come.**

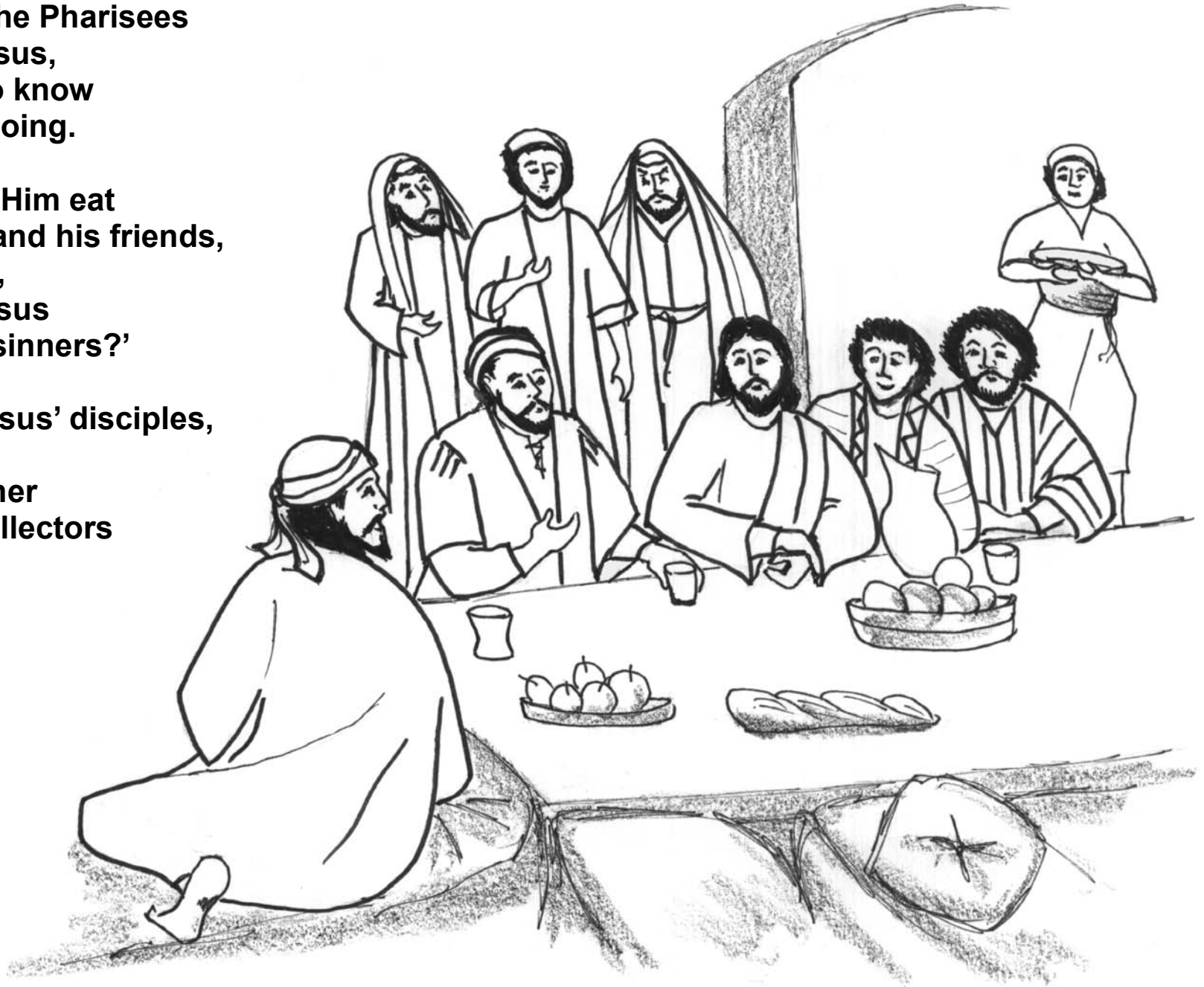
**Most of his friends
