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**LUKE 6:12, 17-19; 7:1-10;**

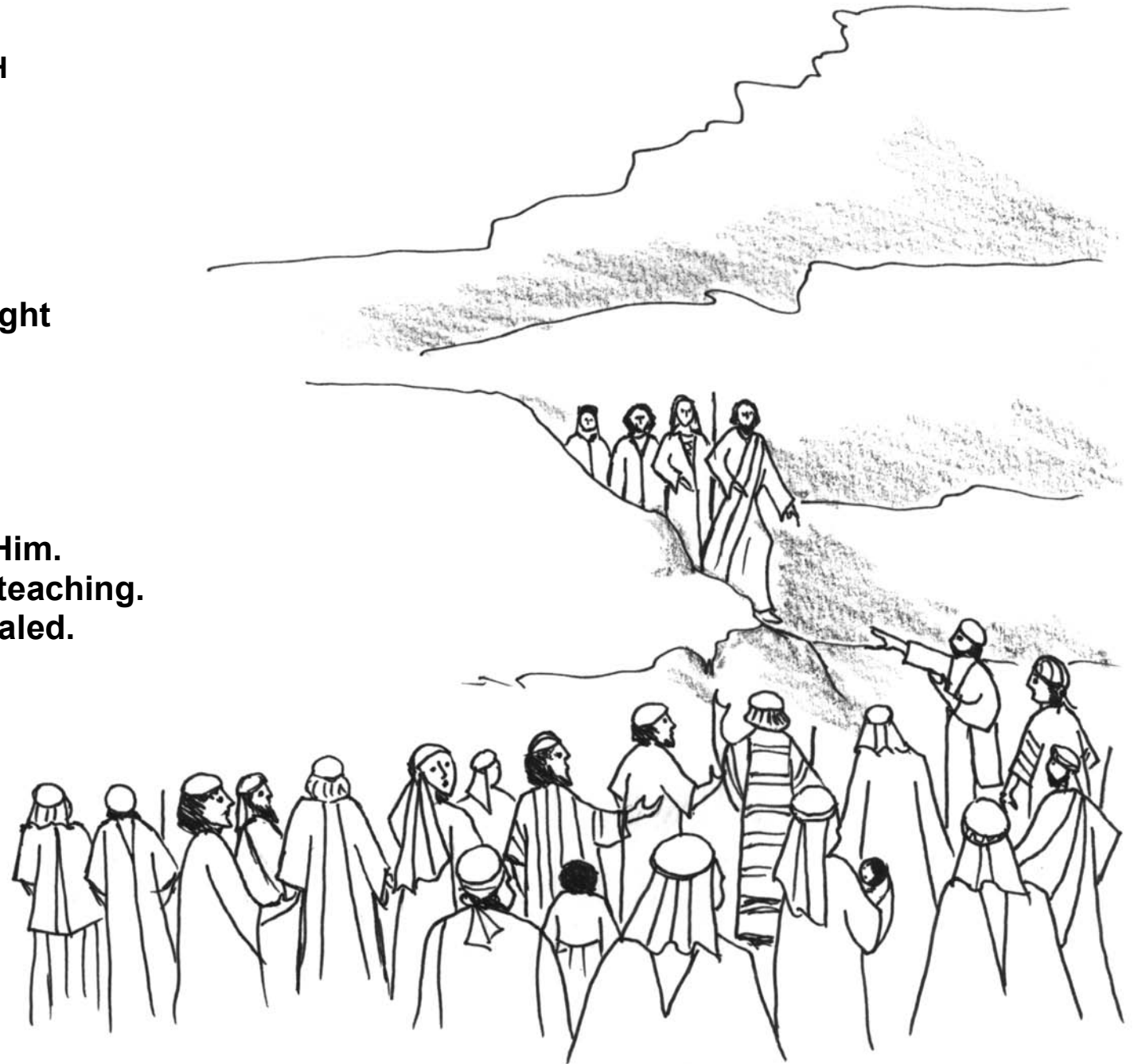
Matthew 8:5-13

saying,**

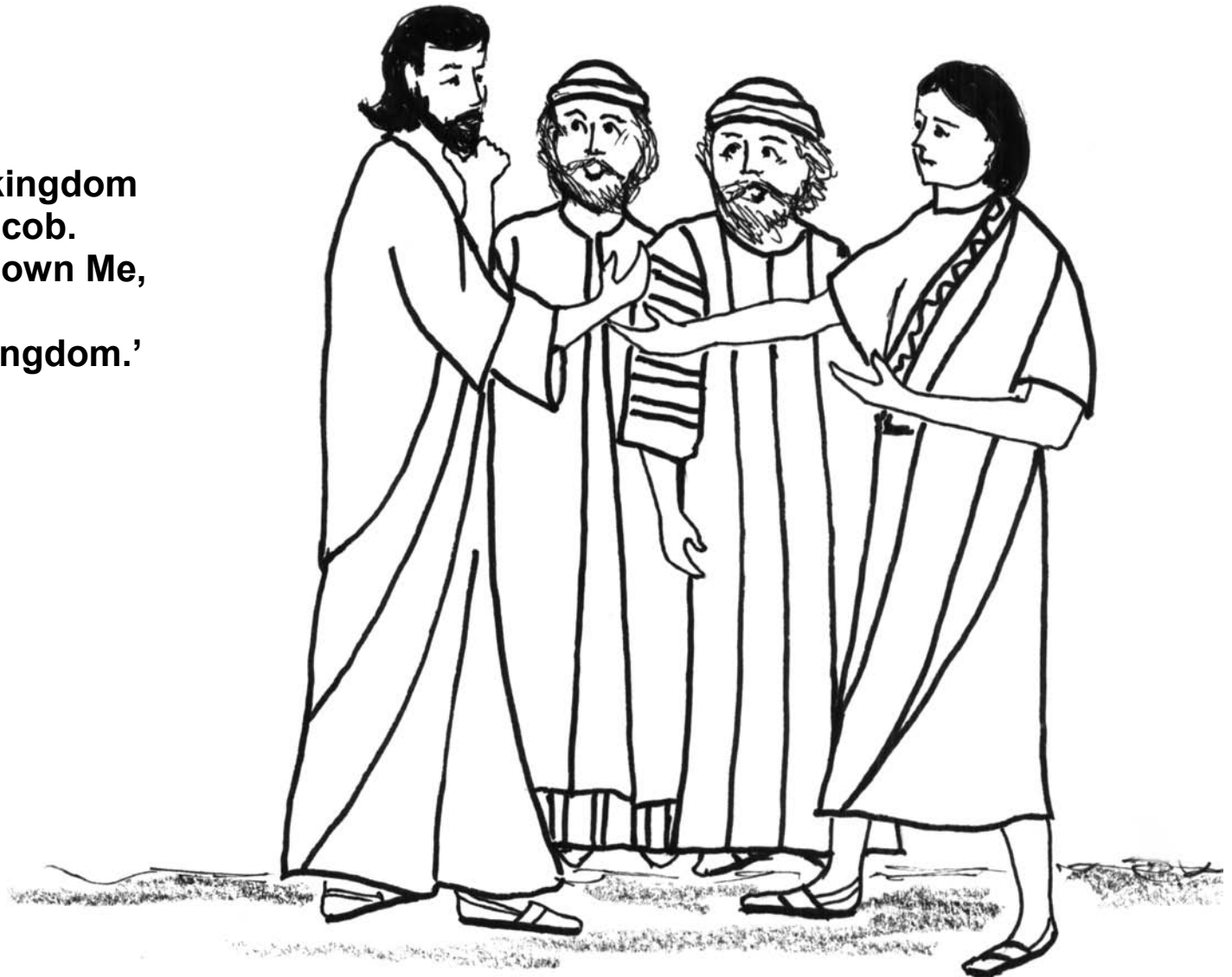
**‘Sir don’t come to me.

Jesus saw a mother who was very sad.**

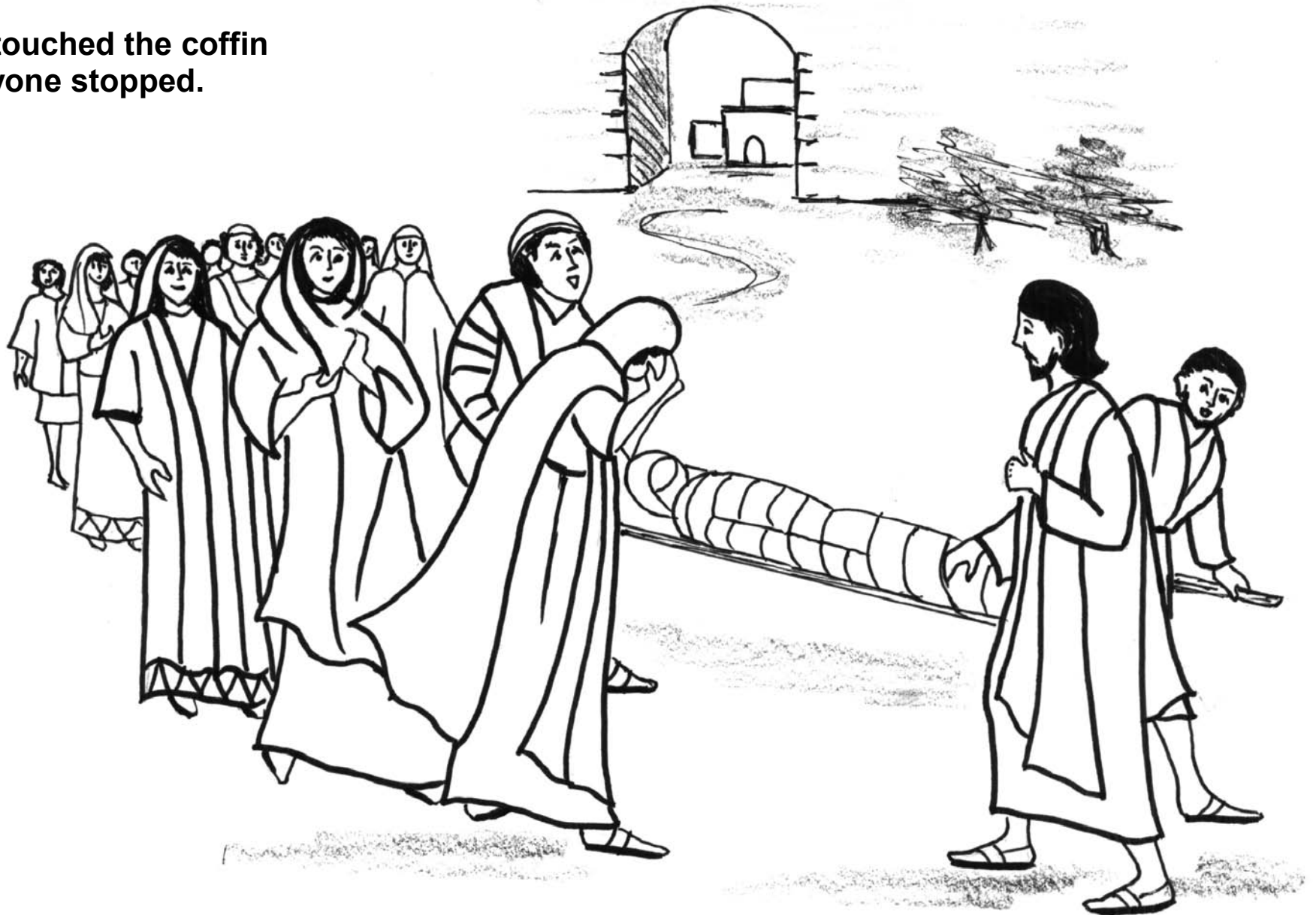
**The mother was crying.

to his mother.**

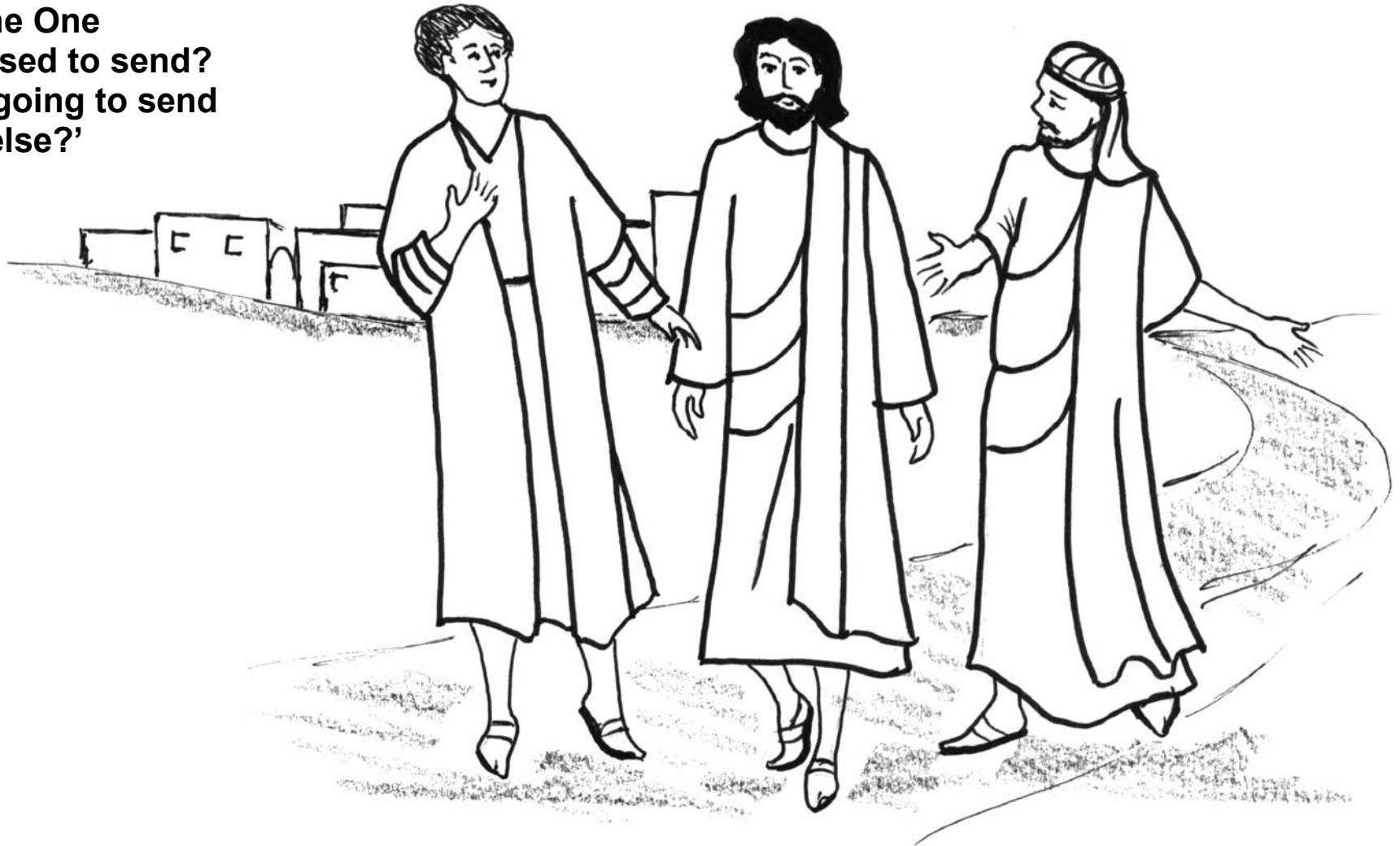
**Everyone was amazed.**

to help His people.'**

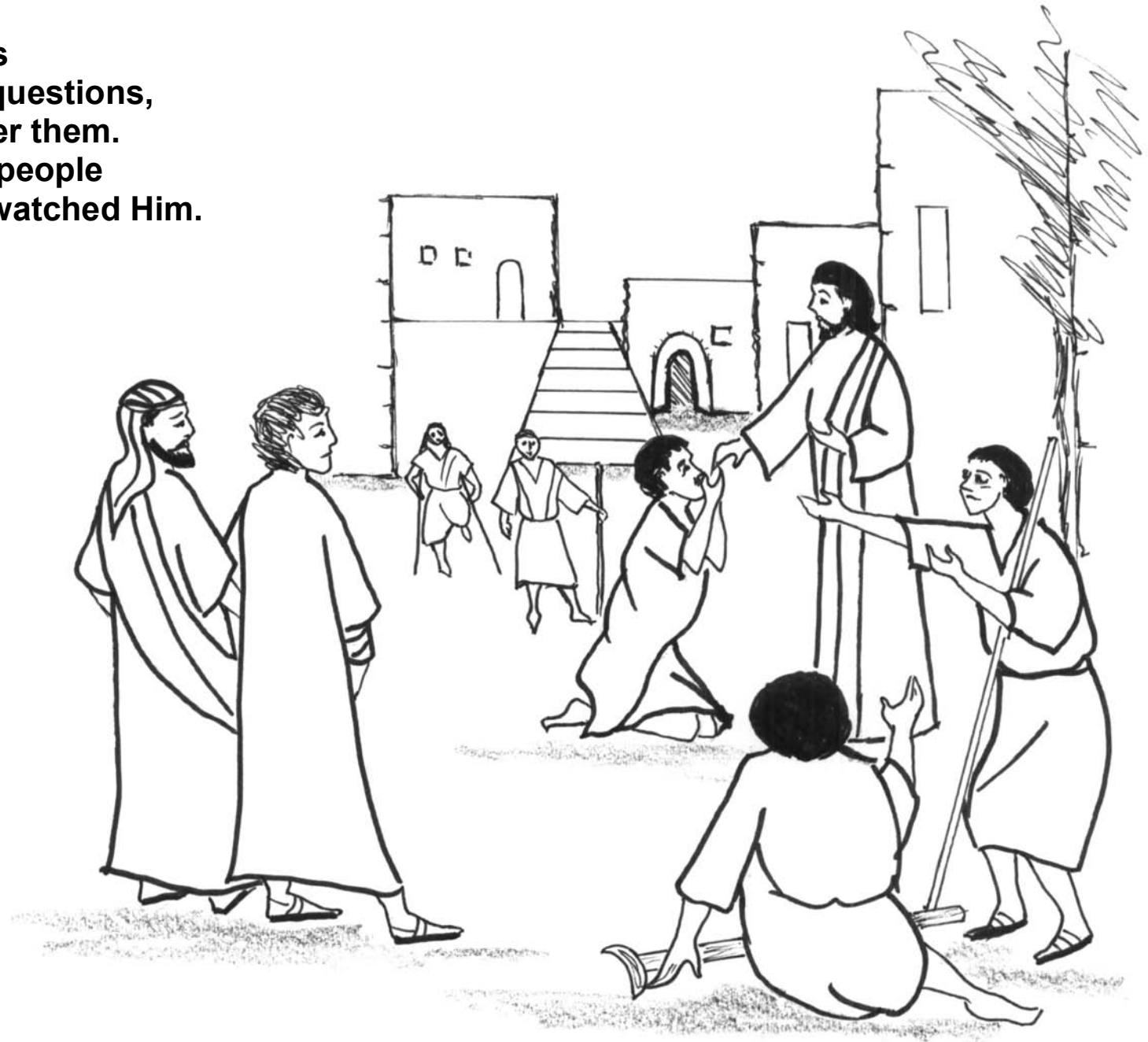


**John the Baptist was in prison

someone else?'**



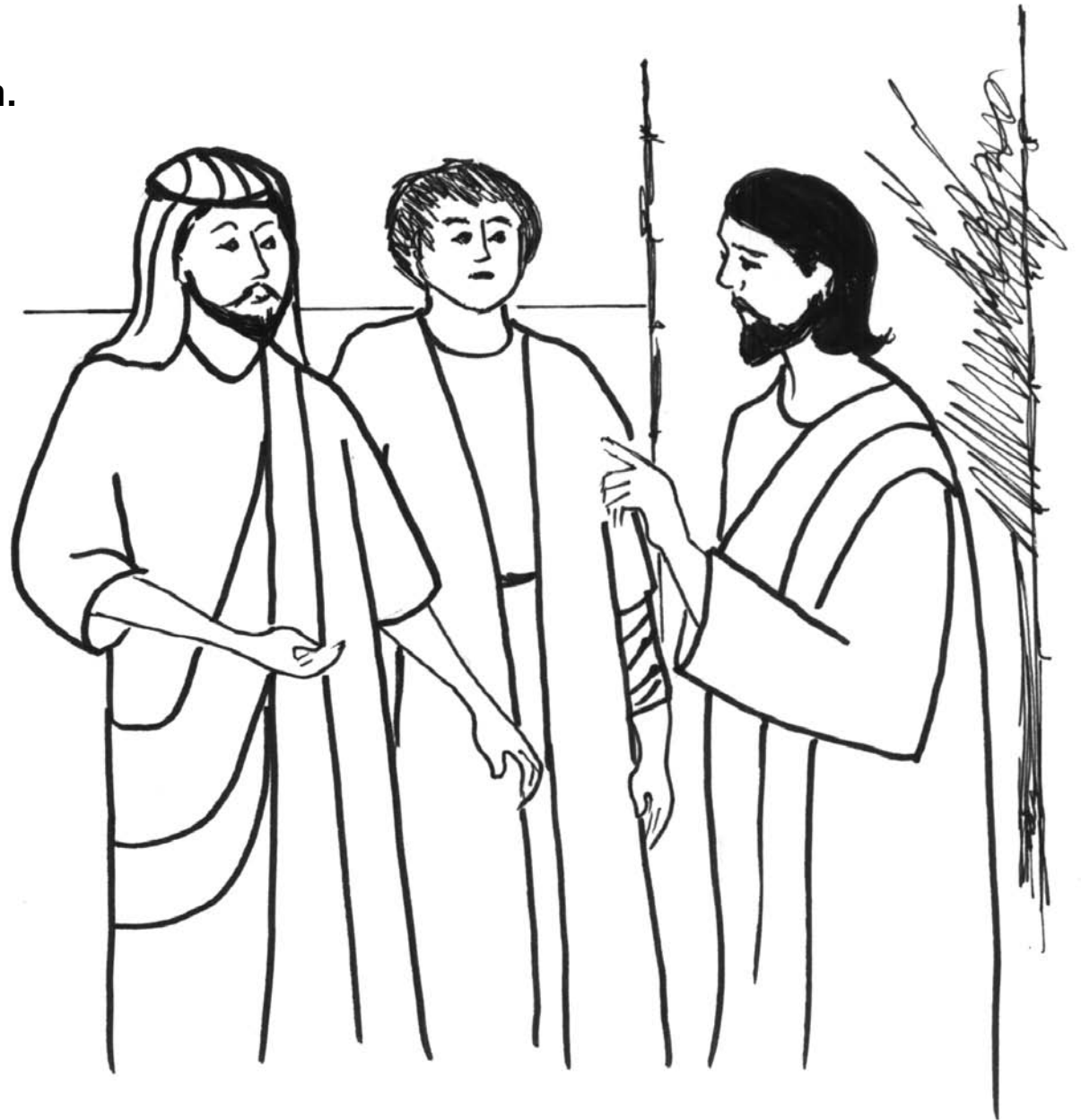
**When John's friends

hear Jesus' good news.'**

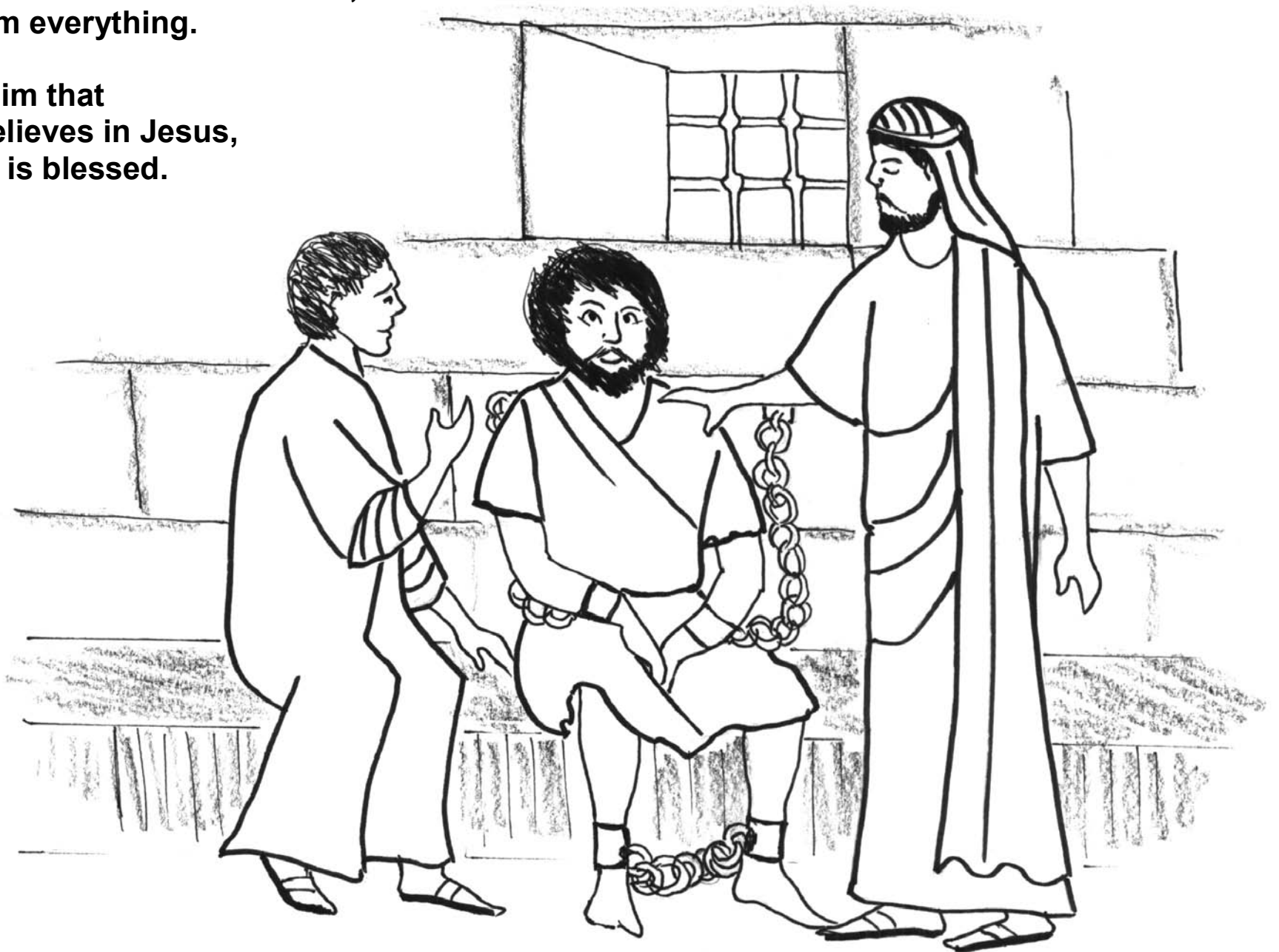
**Jesus was doing what the prophet,

‘Let’s go to the other side of the lake.’**

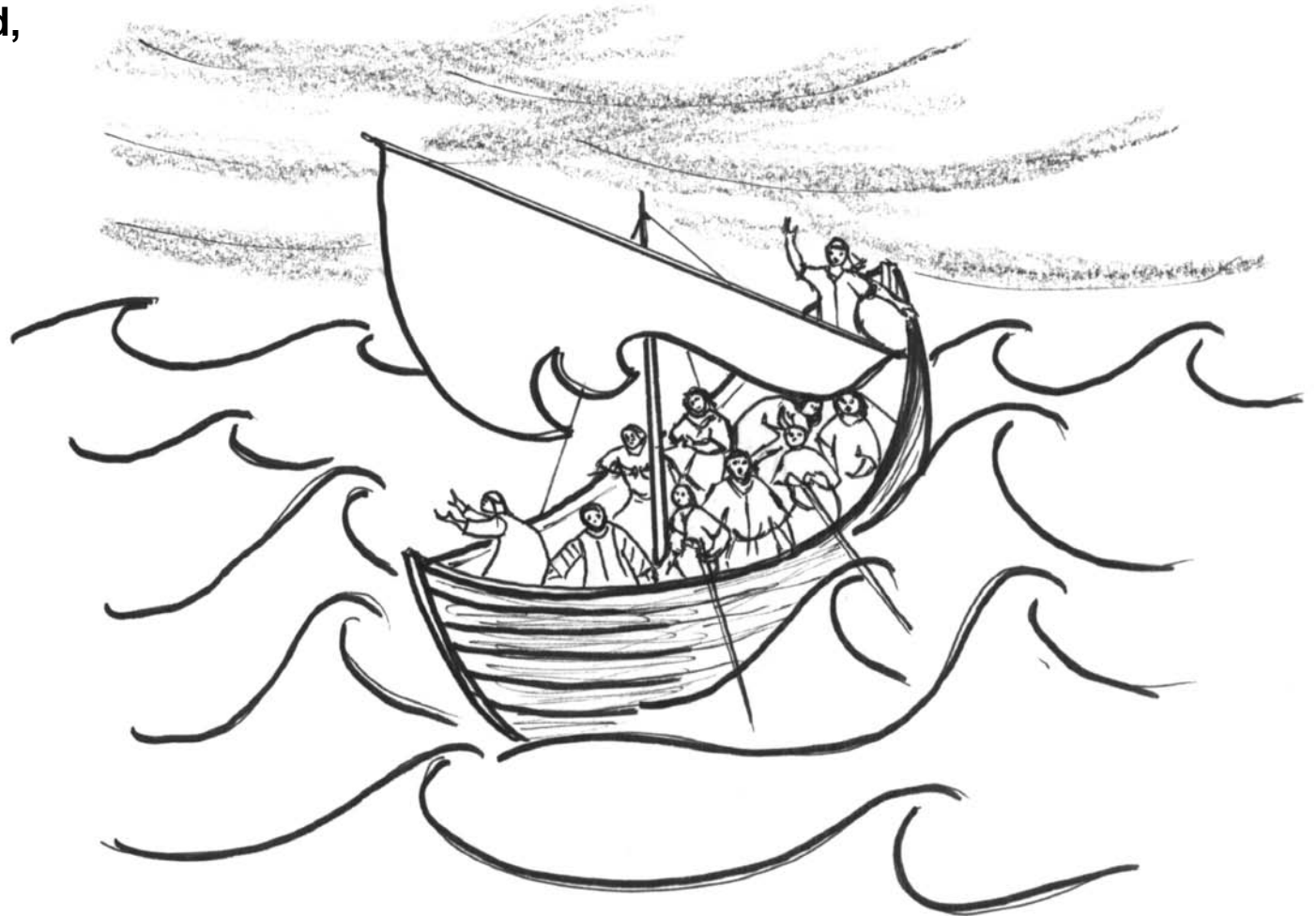
**Jesus was so tired

and they were in danger.**

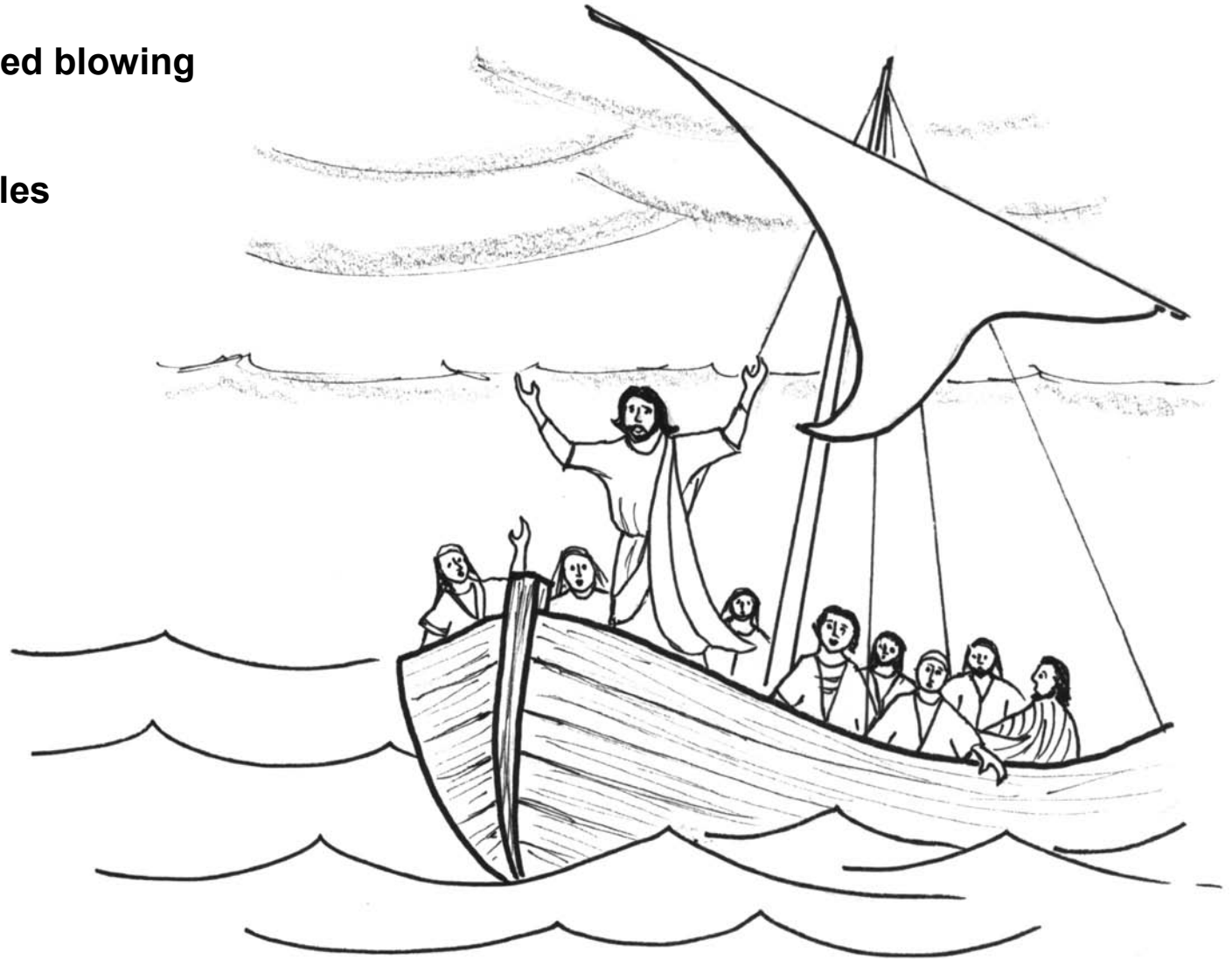
**The disciples

'Where is your faith?'**

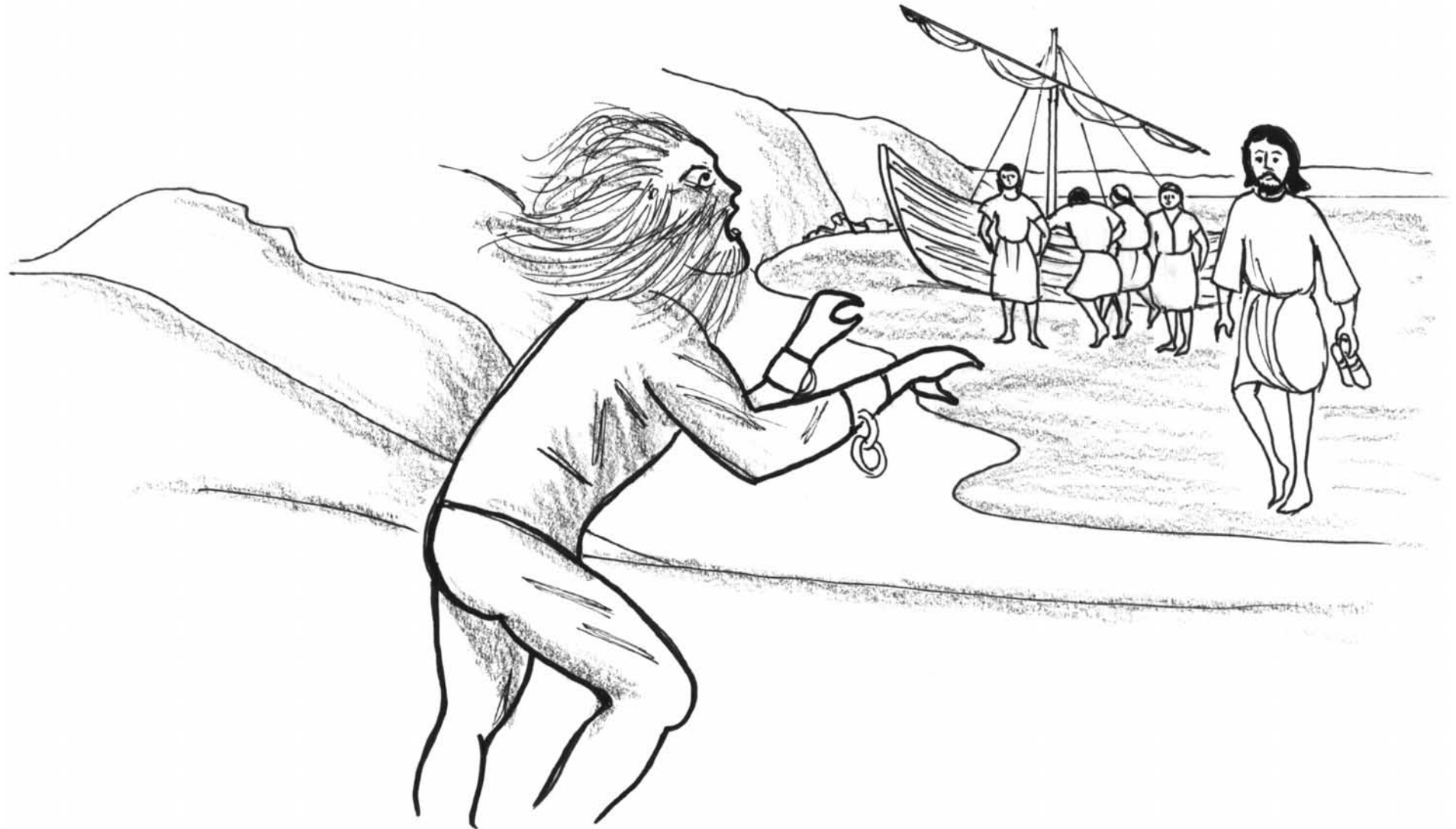


**The disciples were afraid

a madman came running up to Jesus.**

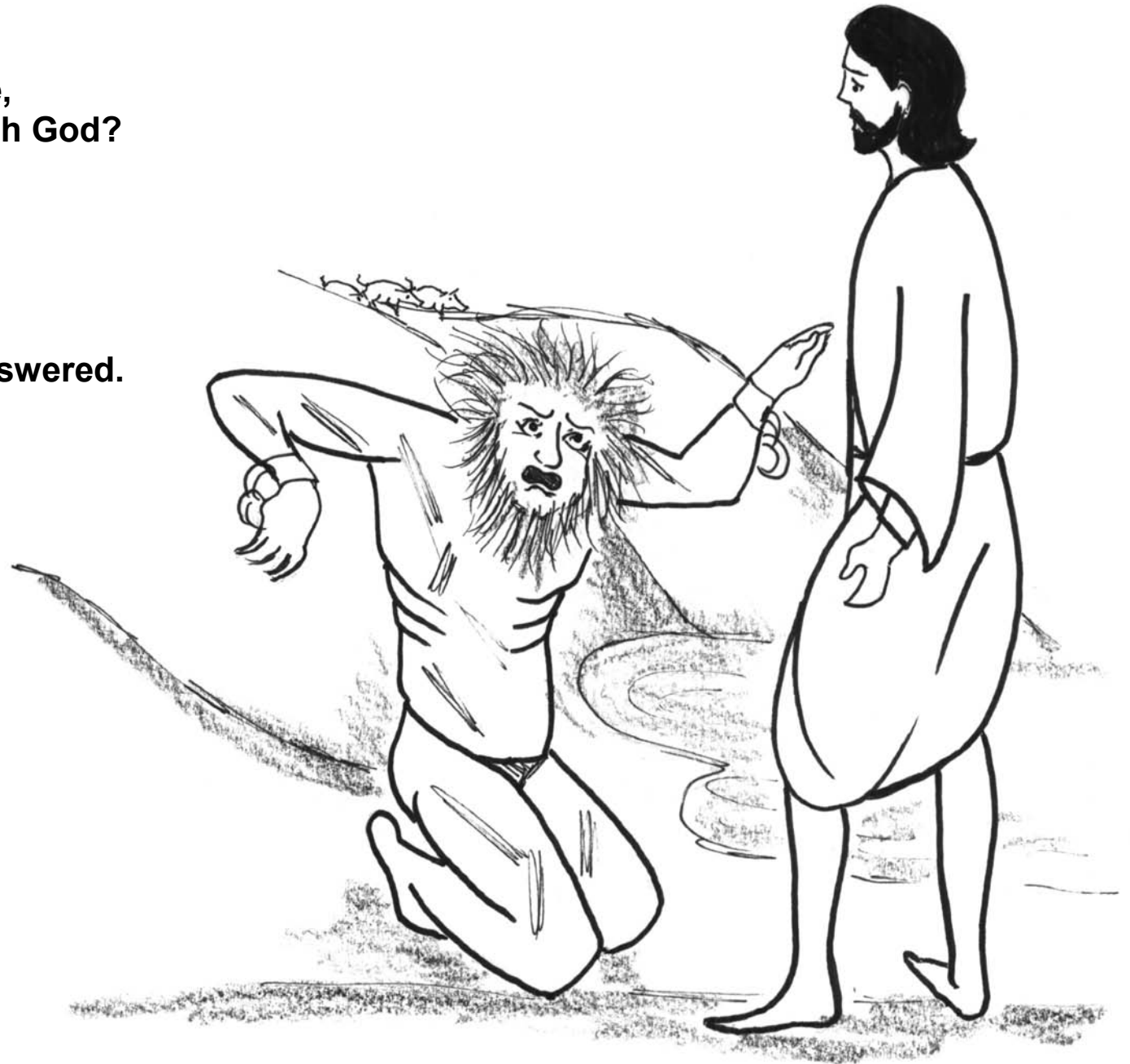
**Evil Spirits lived in this man and made him wild.

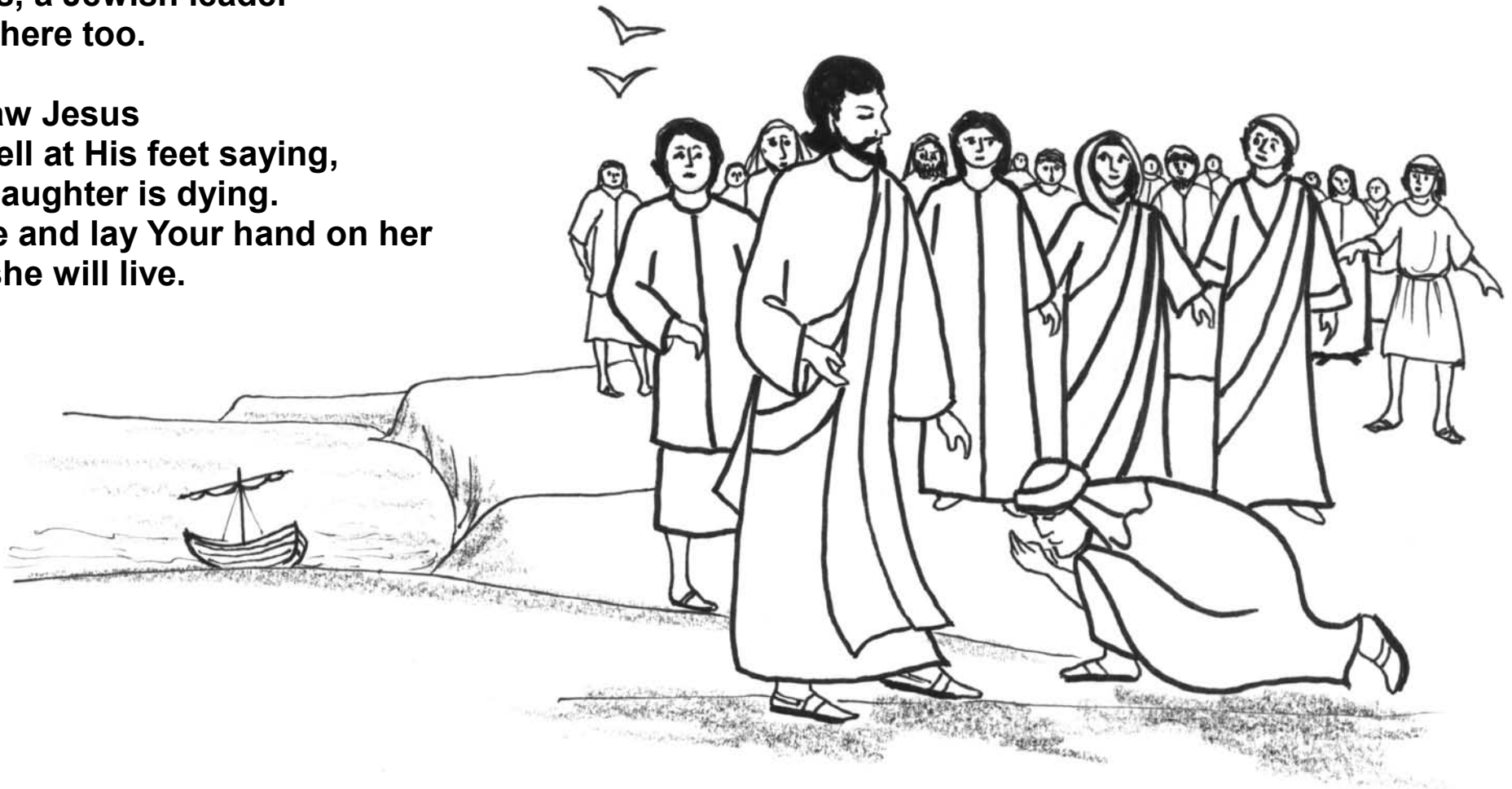
**DAUGHTER OF JAIRUS**

was there too.**

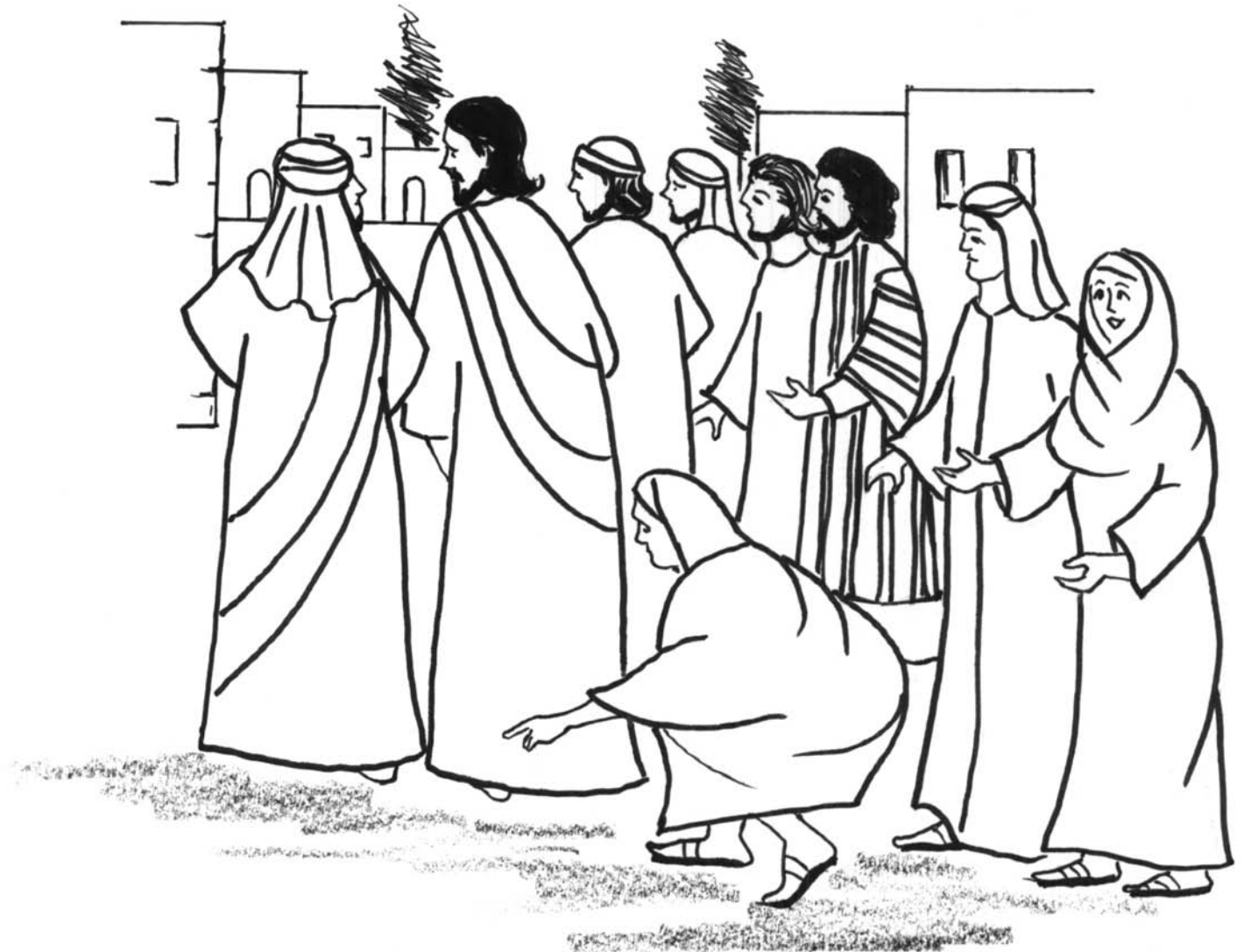
**He saw Jesus

I will be made well.'**

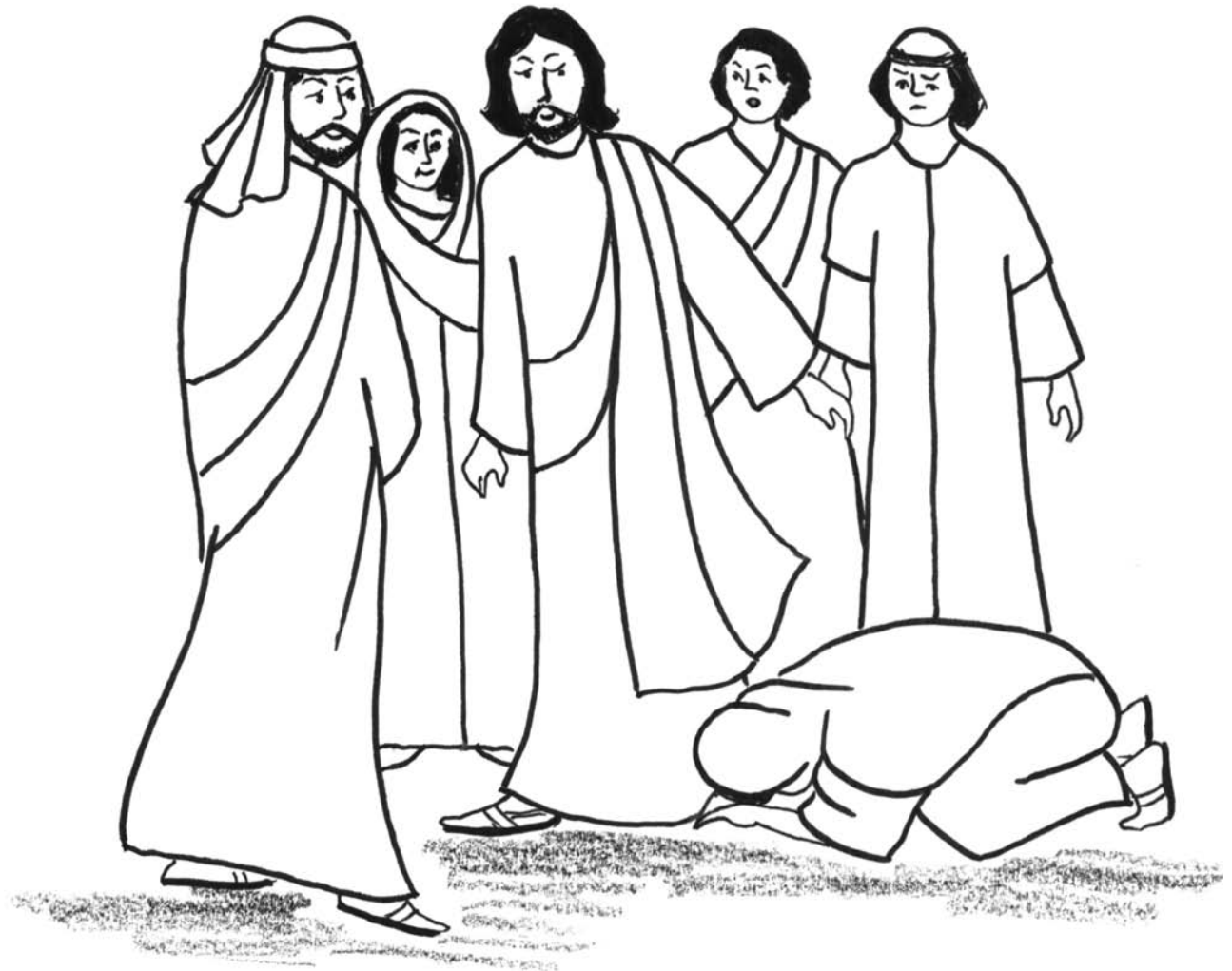


**As she touched Jesus' coat

'Who touched Me.'**

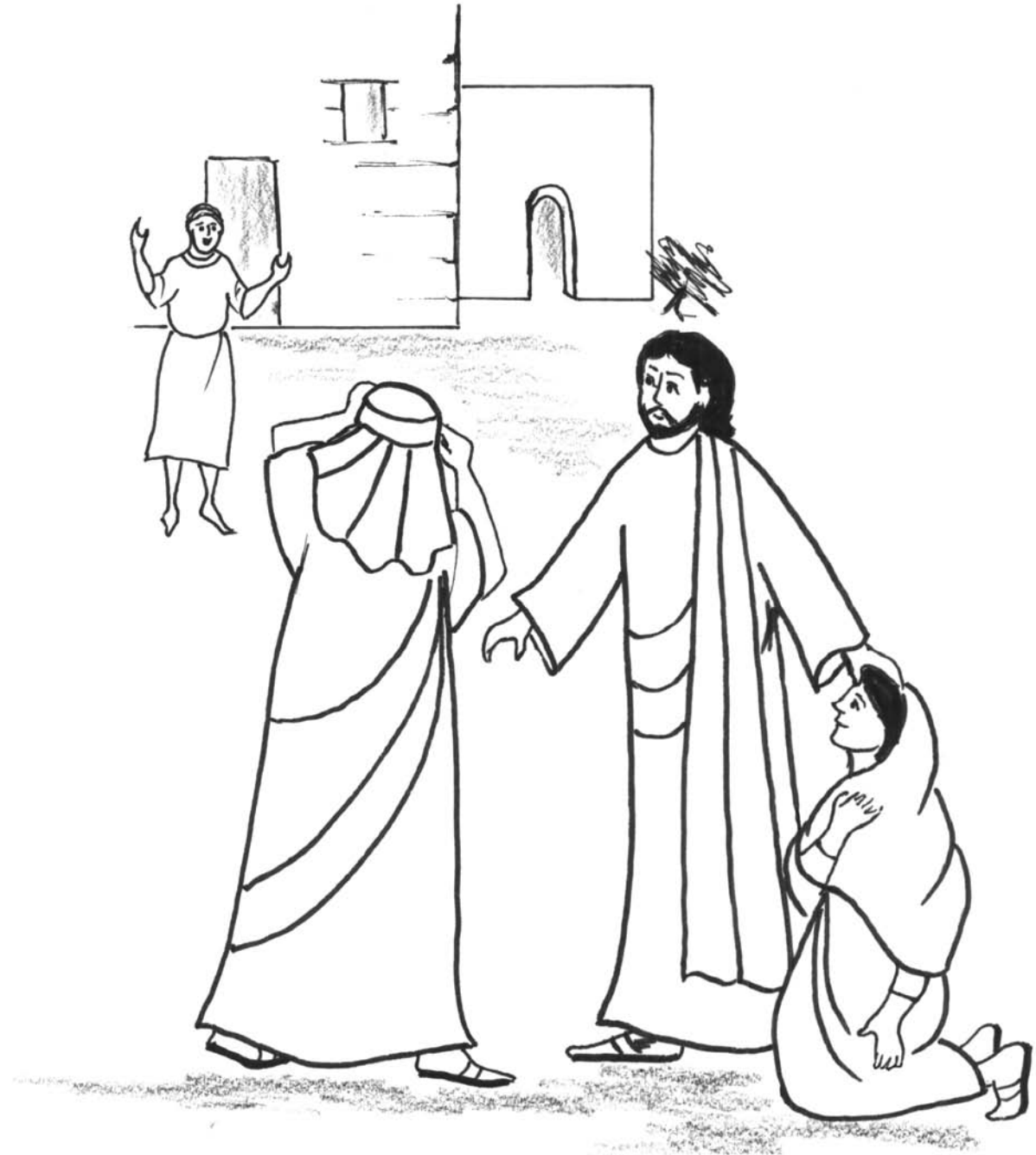
**The lady was frightened

People were there crying.**

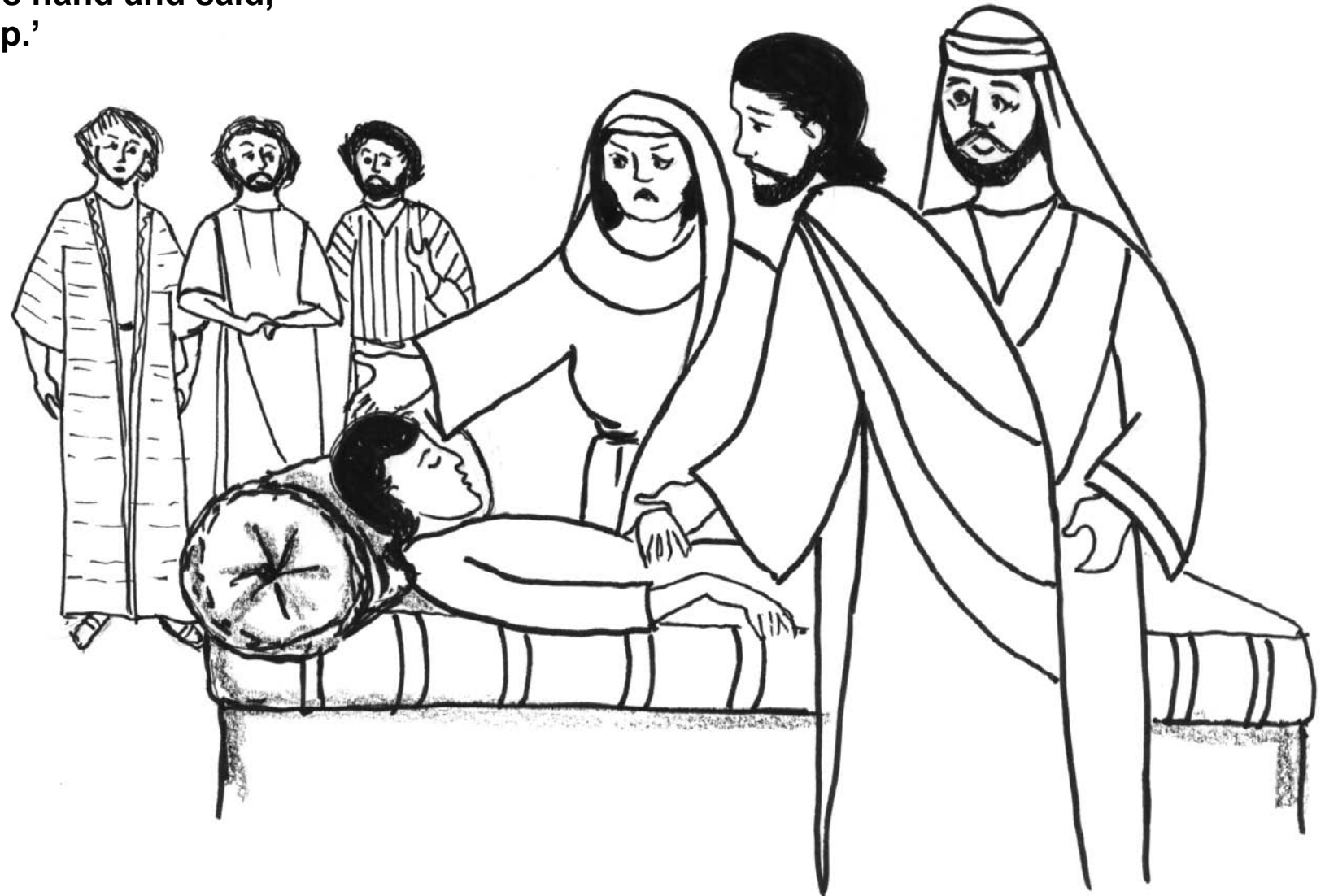
**Jesus said to them,

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**MATTHEW 14:13–23**

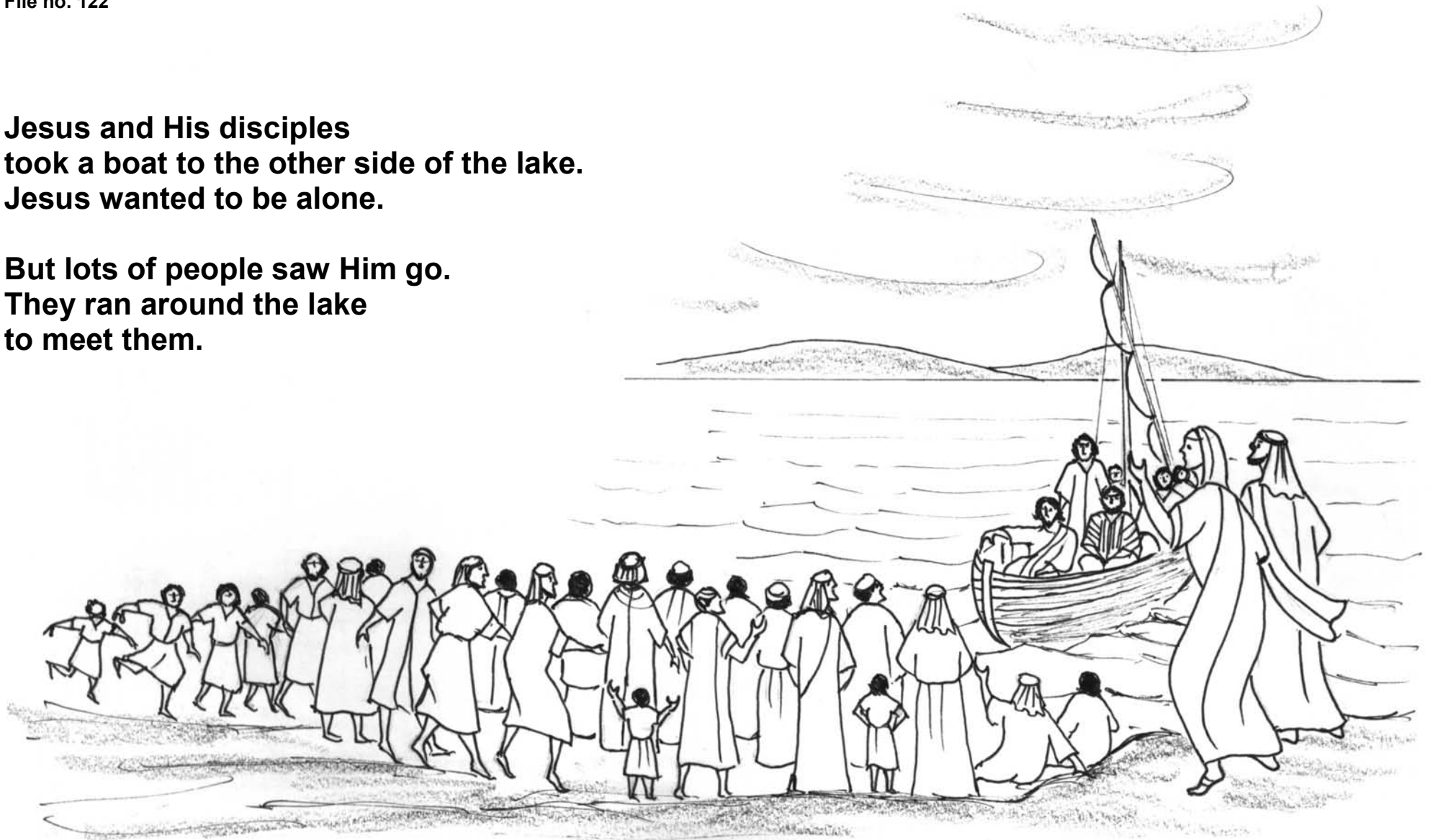

**FEEDING FIVE THOUSAND PEOPLE**

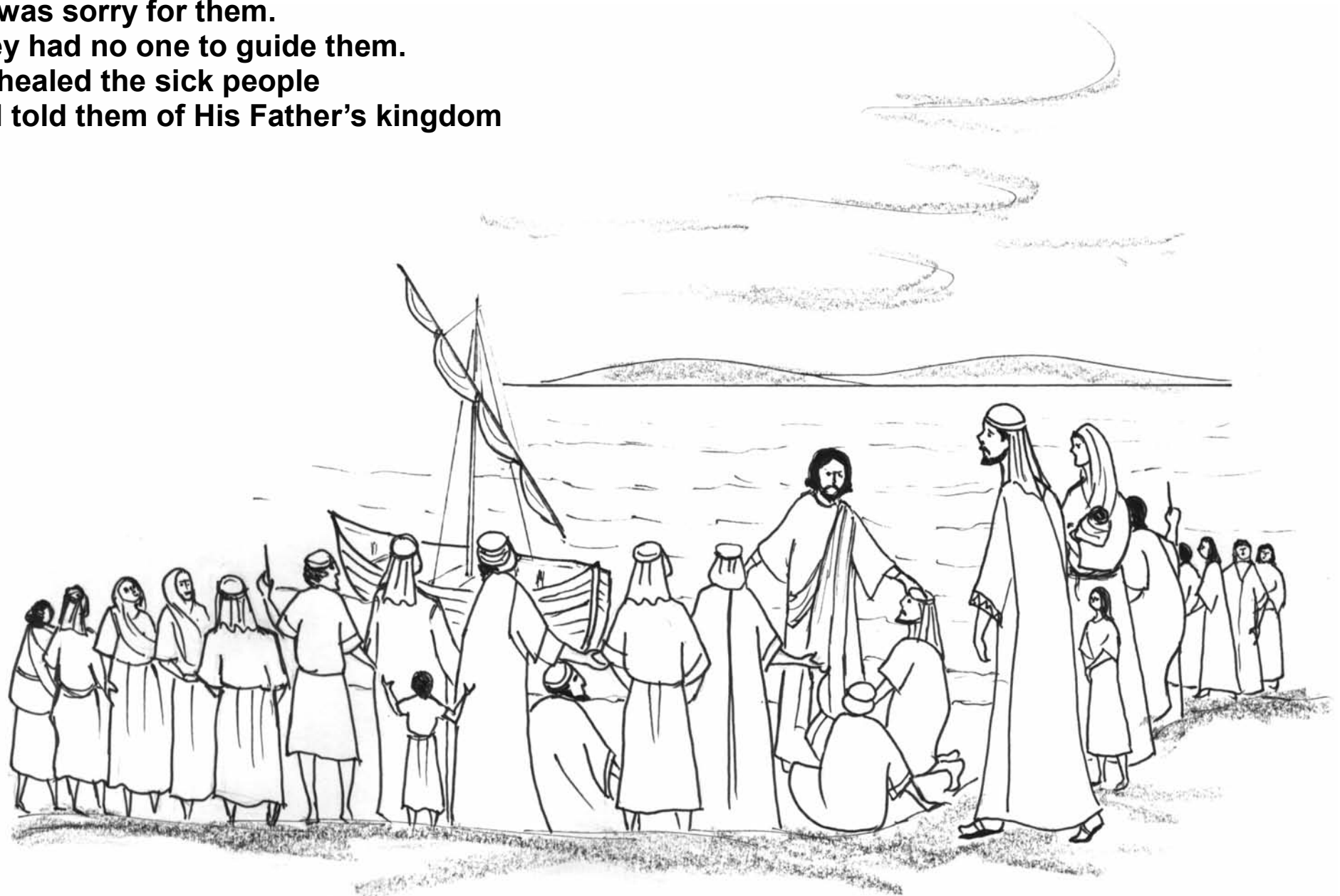

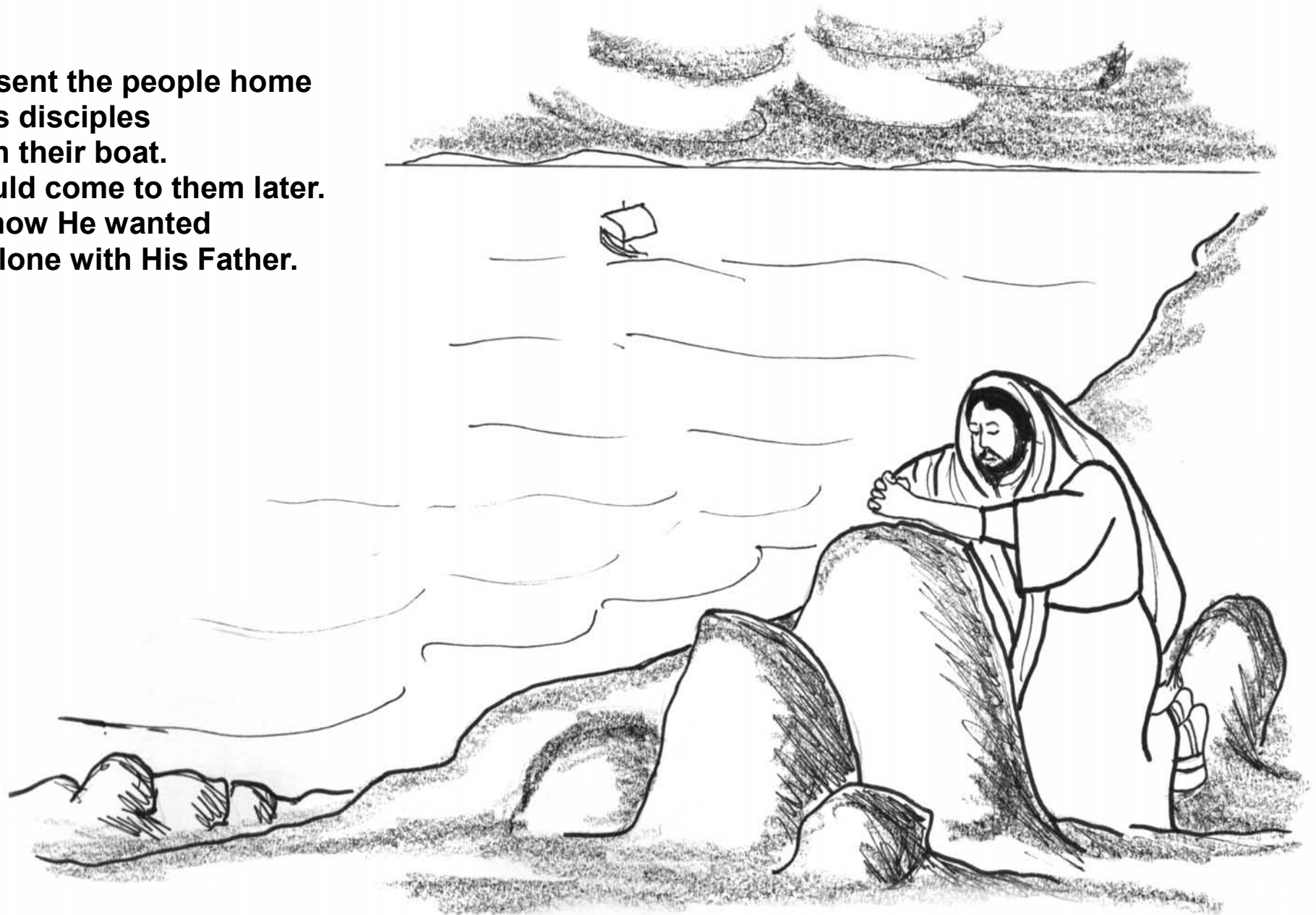
**Do you remember

Jesus their king.**

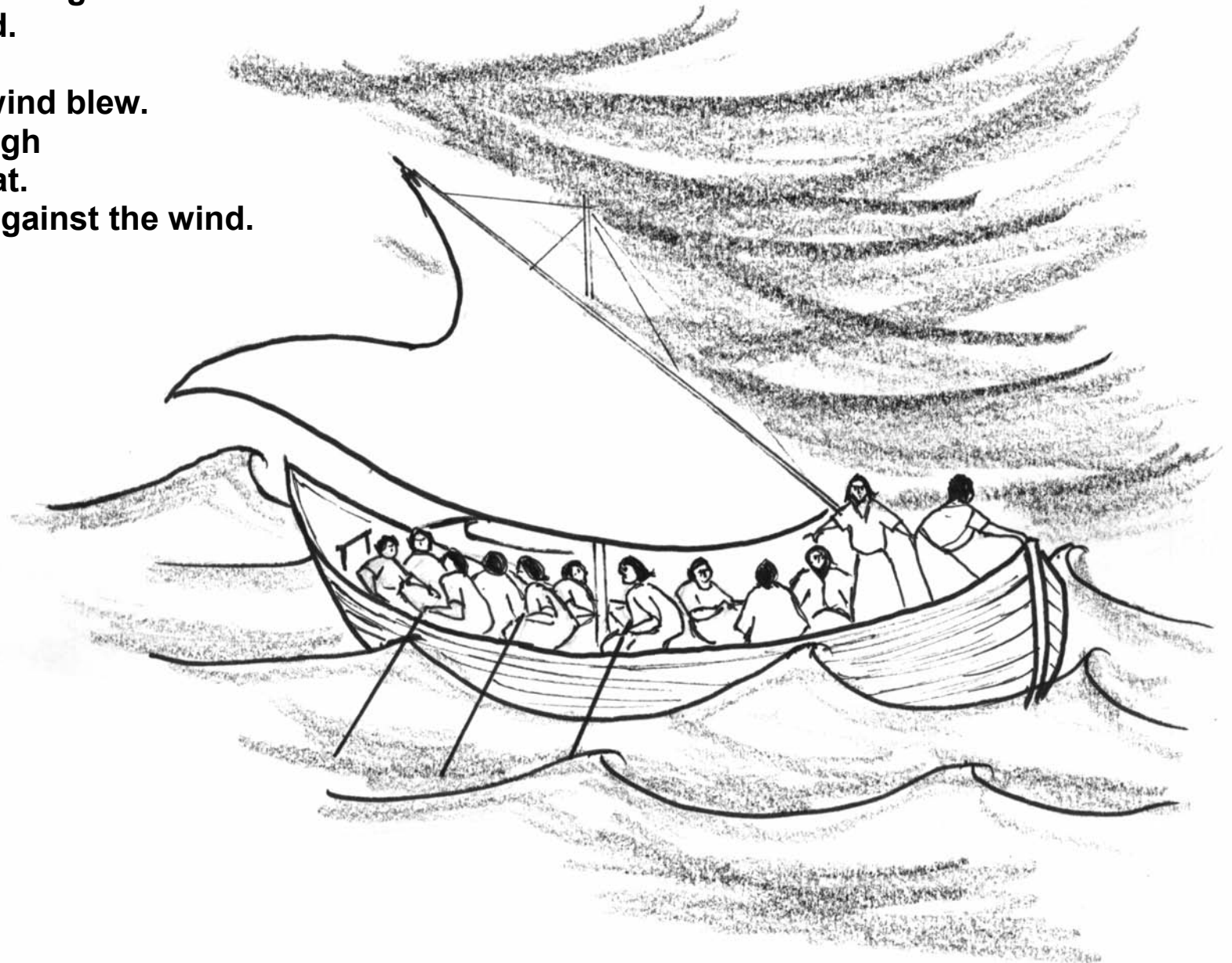
**But Jesus knew

It was hard rowing against the wind.**

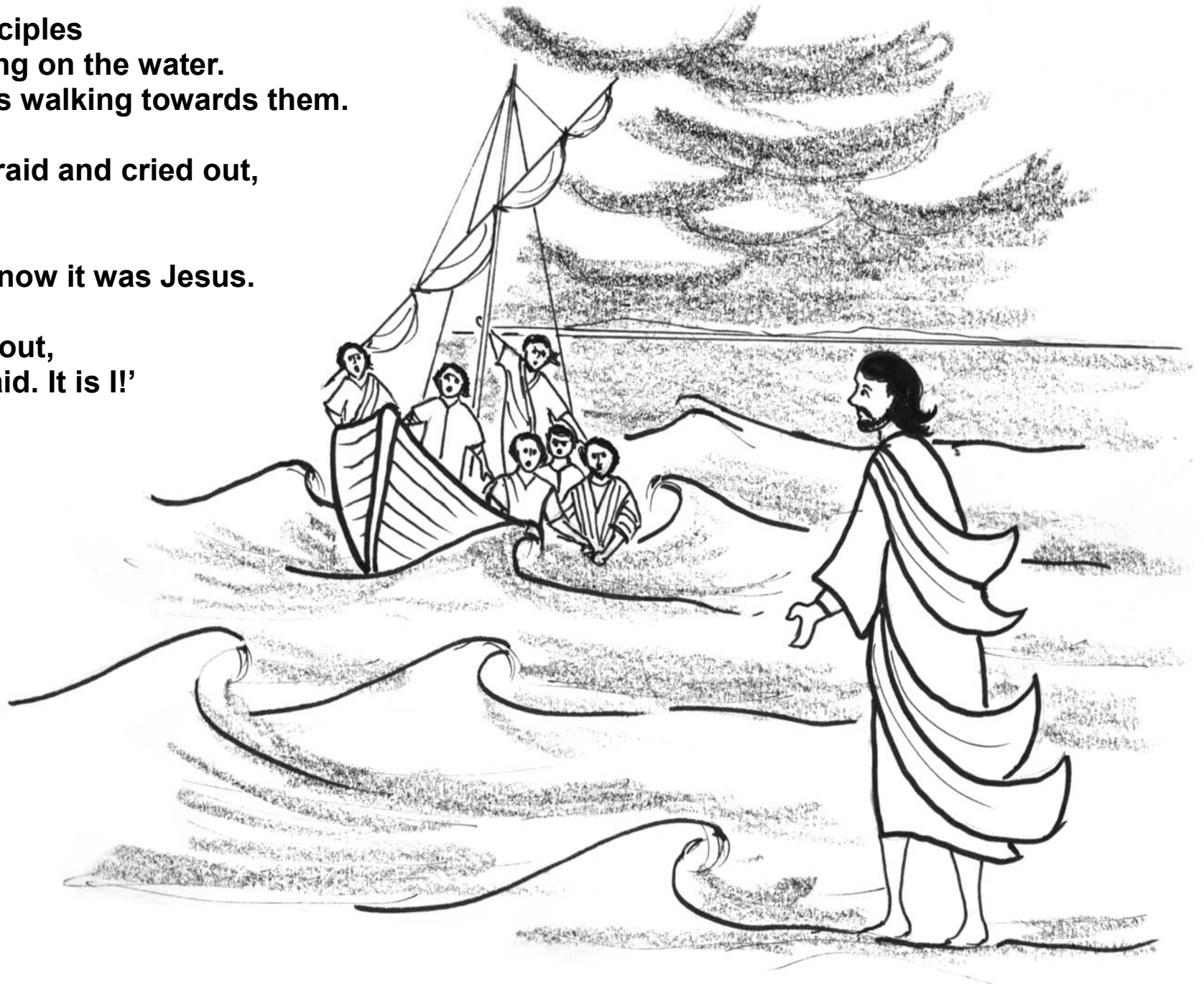


**Then, the disciples

**'Come,' said Jesus.**

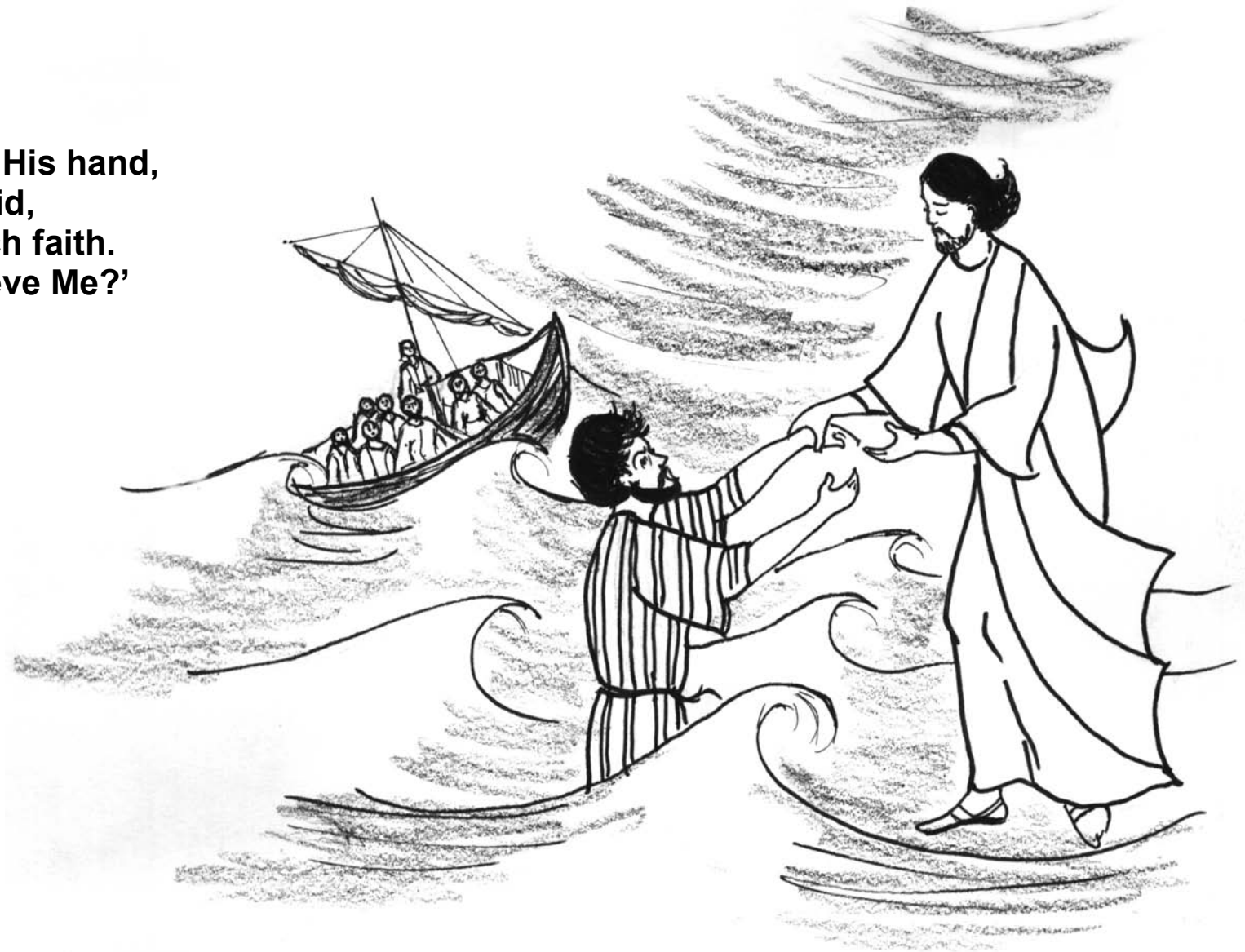
**Peter climbed out of the boat

'Lord, save me!'**

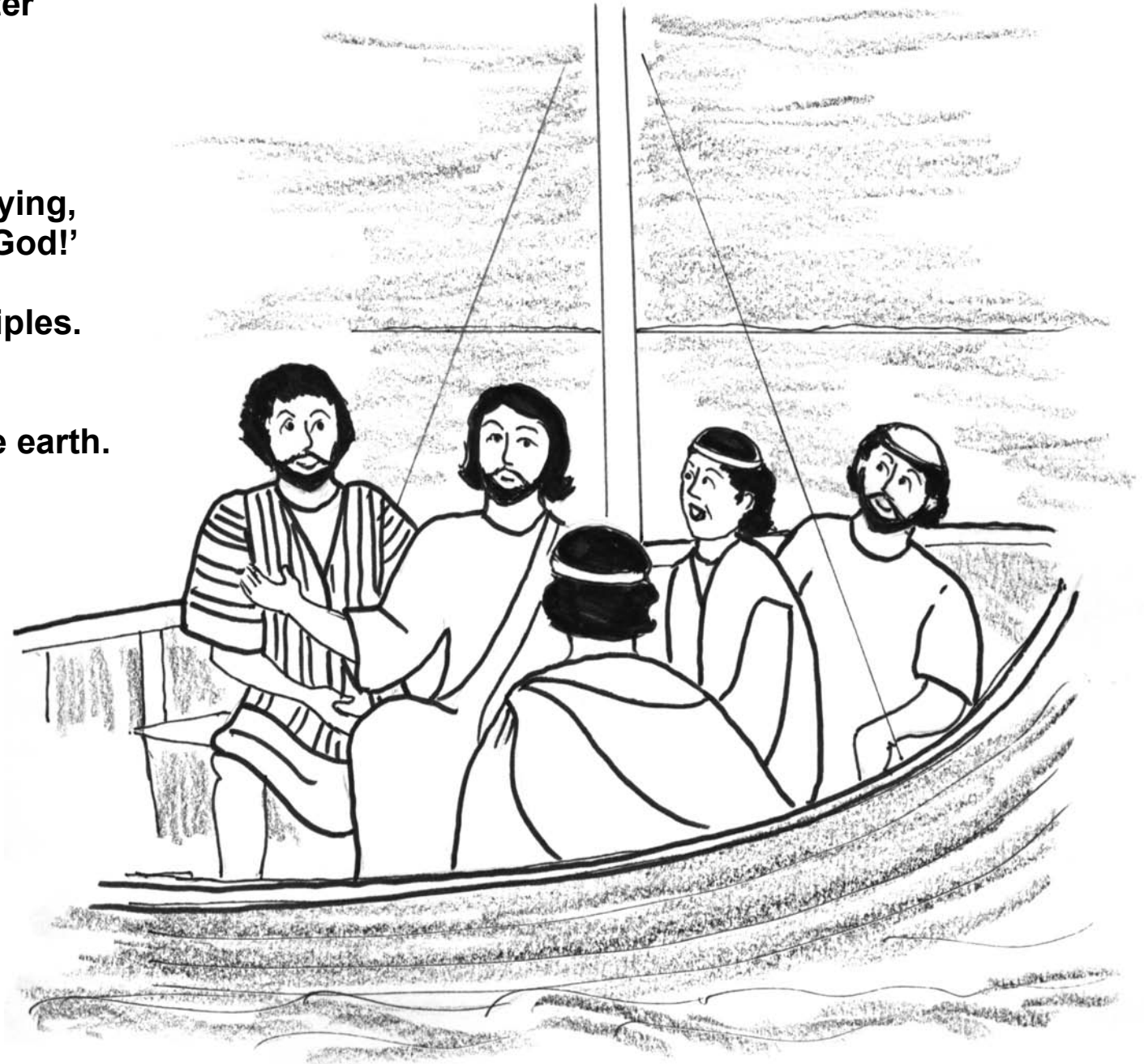
**Jesus stretched out His hand,

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**LUKE 8:4–15**

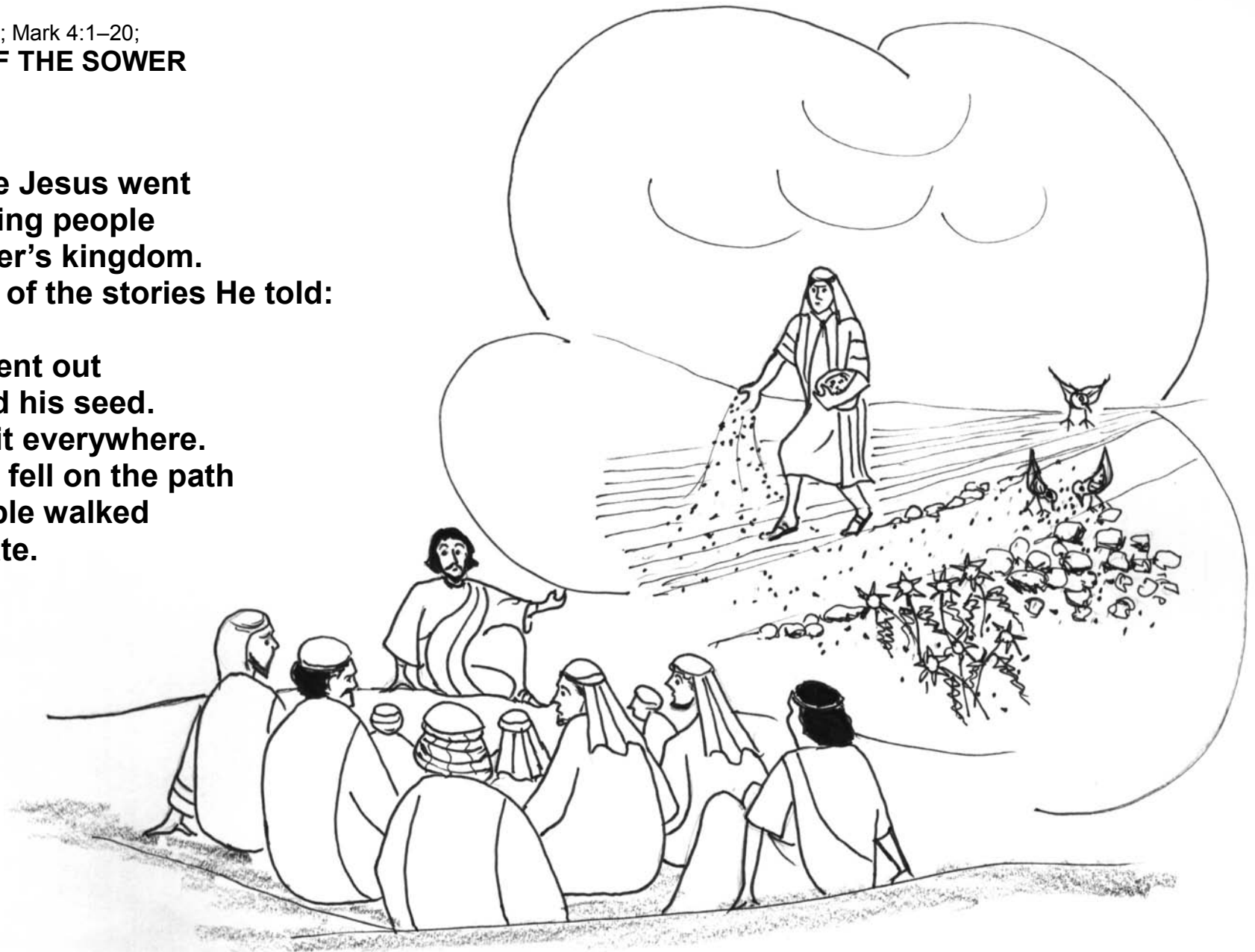
Matthew 13:1–23; Mark 4:1–20;

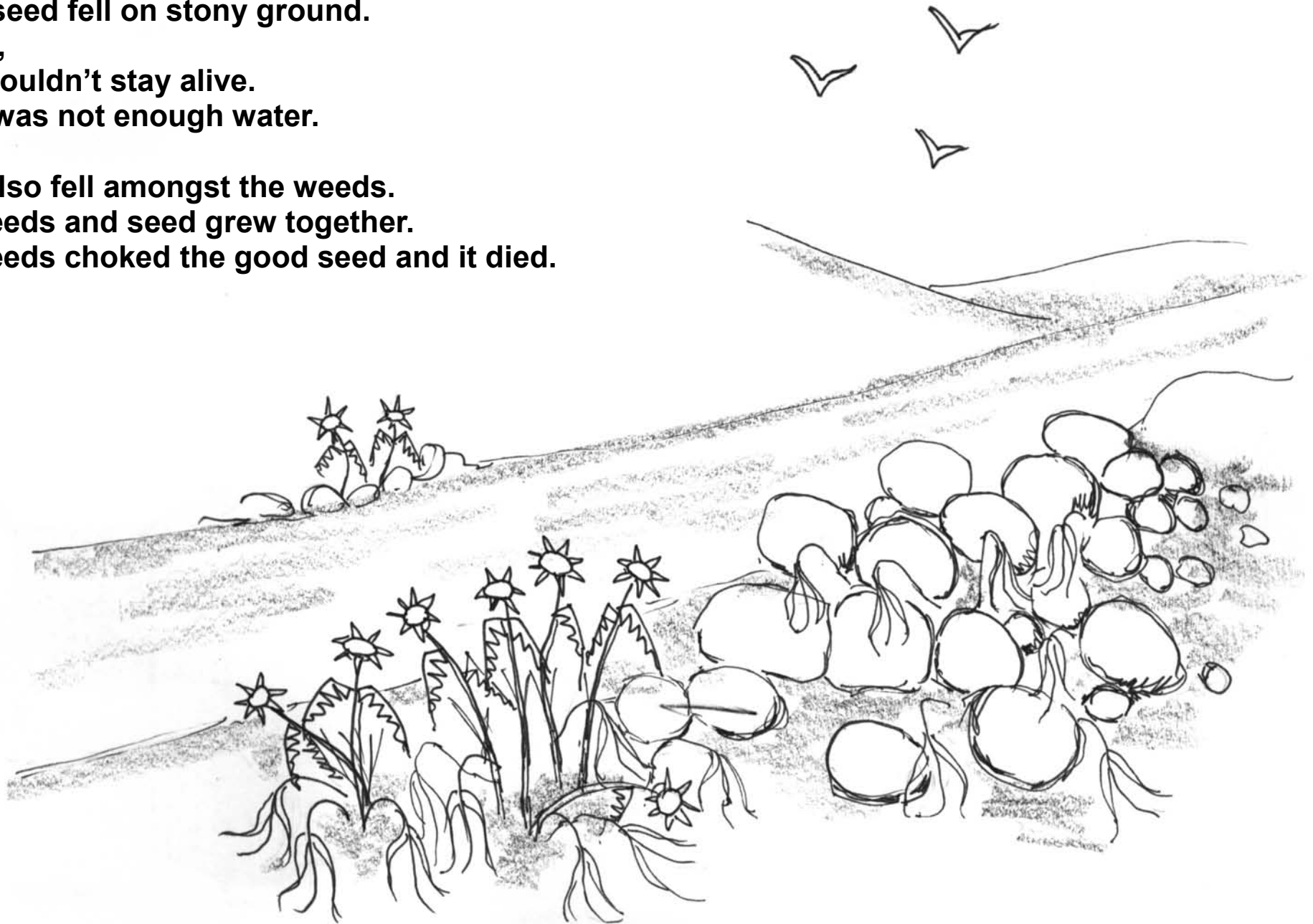
**Everywhere Jesus went

and why do you speak like this?'**

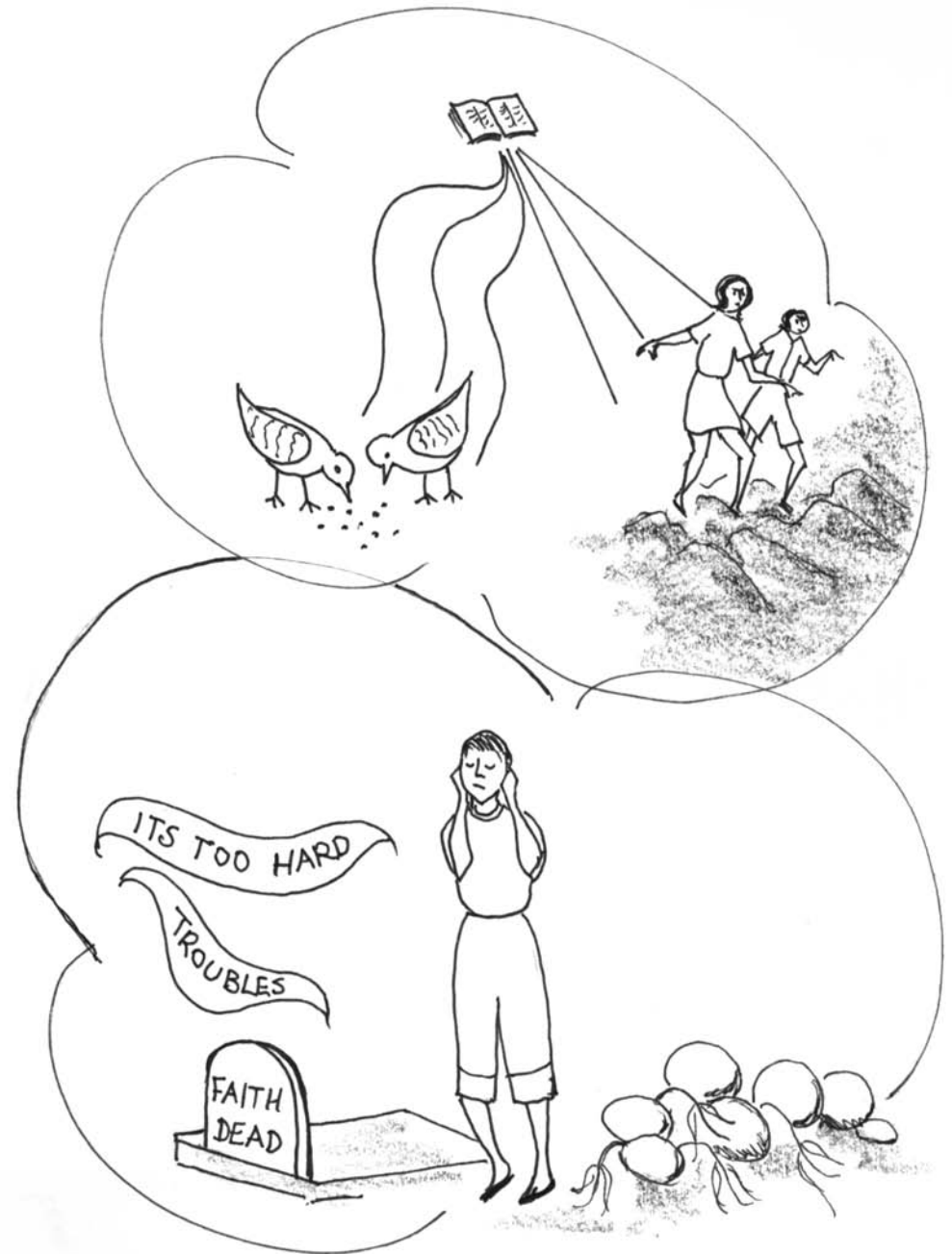
**Jesus said,

is like people who, at first,  
want to hear God’s word.  
But, there is no soil for the  
roots to grow in.  
When the sun is hot  
or life gets tough  
they stop listening to God’s word.  
and their faith dies.**

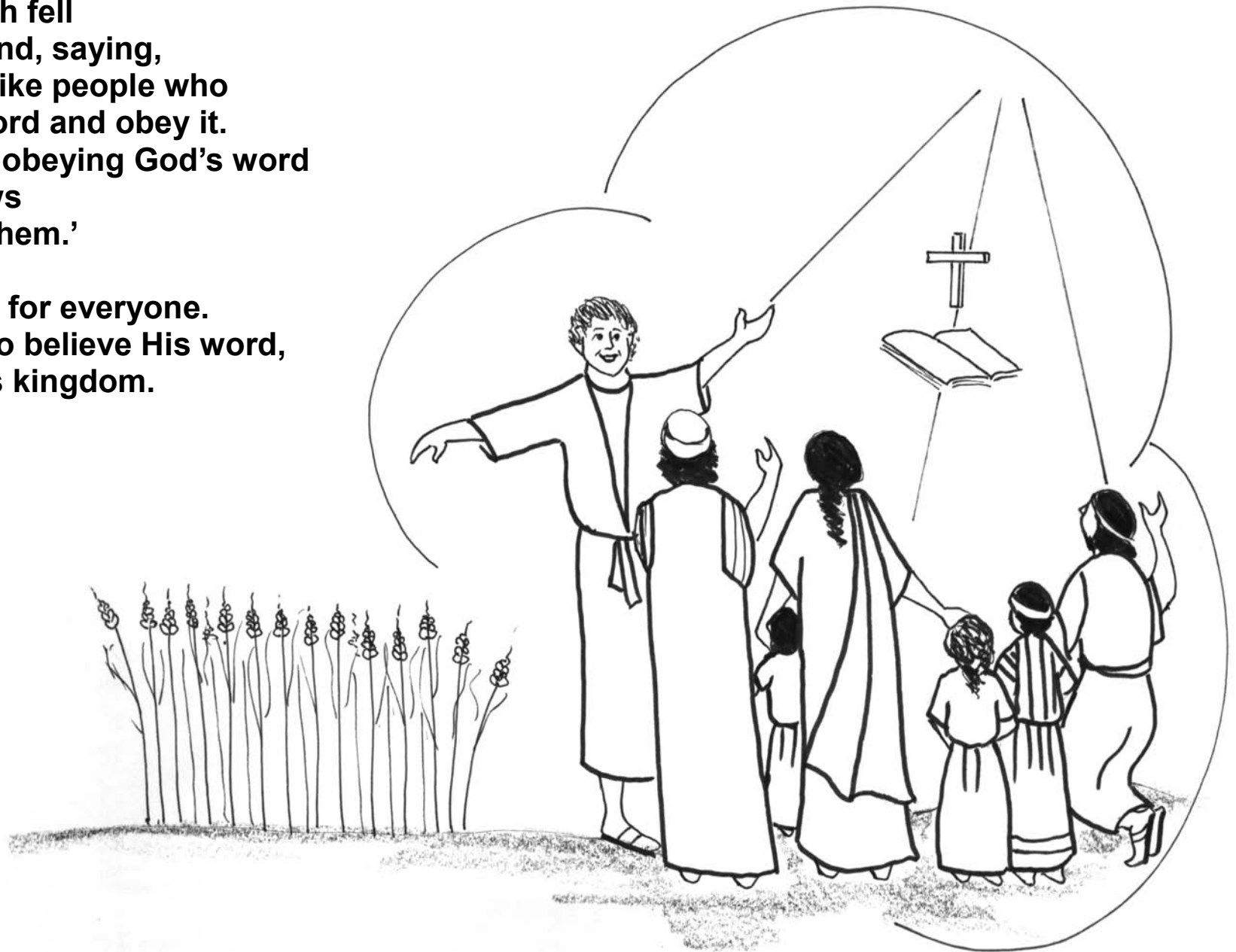


**'The seed that fell among the weeds  
is like people who hear God's word,  
but love other things more.  
Other things become  
more important to them than God.  
Their faith does not last.'**



**Then Jesus spoke about  
the seed which fell  
on good ground, saying,  
'This seed is like people who  
hear God's word and obey it.  
They keep on obeying God's word  
and God grows  
good fruit in them.'**

**God's word is for everyone.  
He wants us to believe His word,  
and live in His kingdom.**

they asked.**

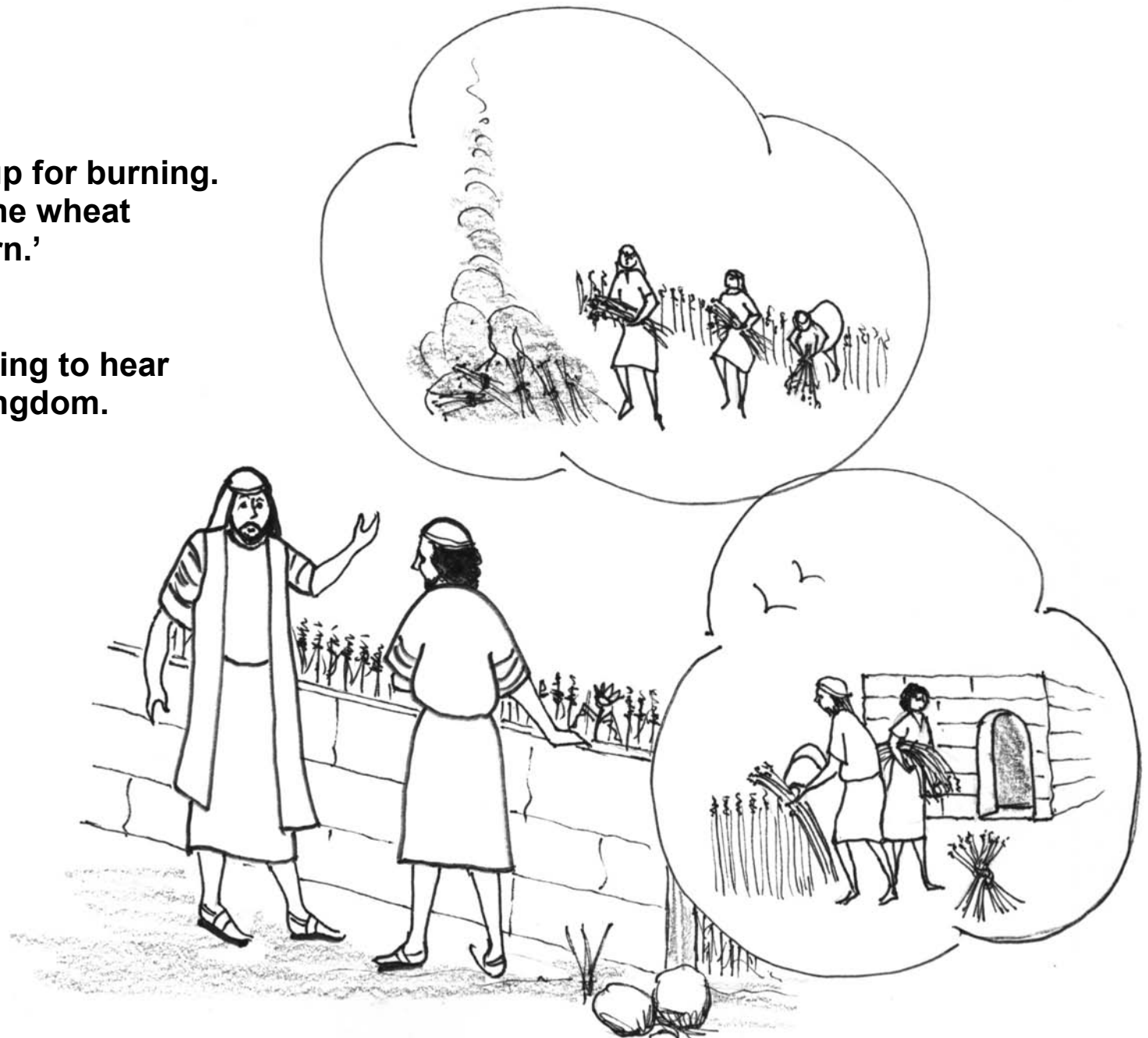
**'No,' said the master.

the secrets of God’s kingdom.**

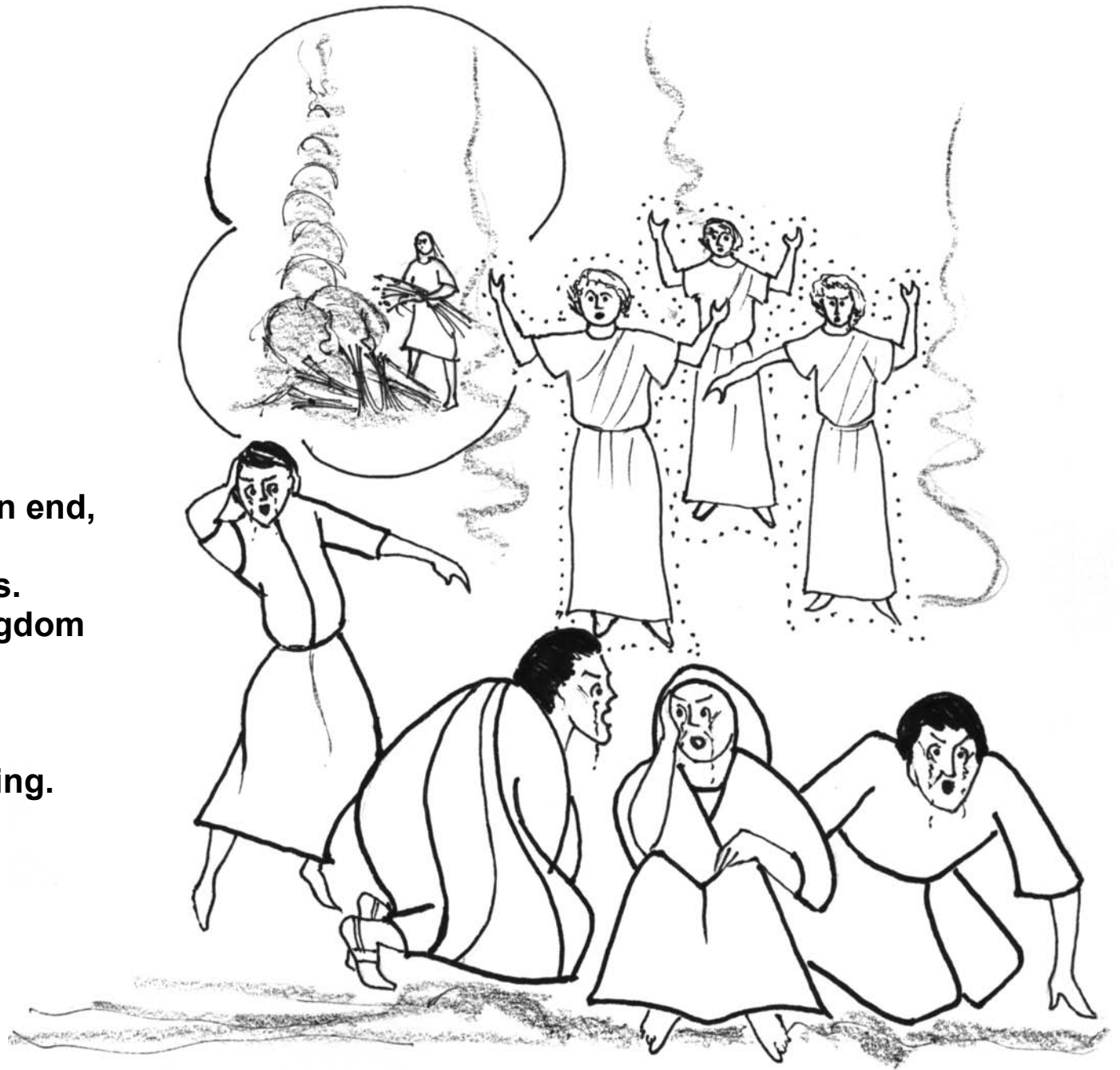


**After telling this story

is the devil.'**

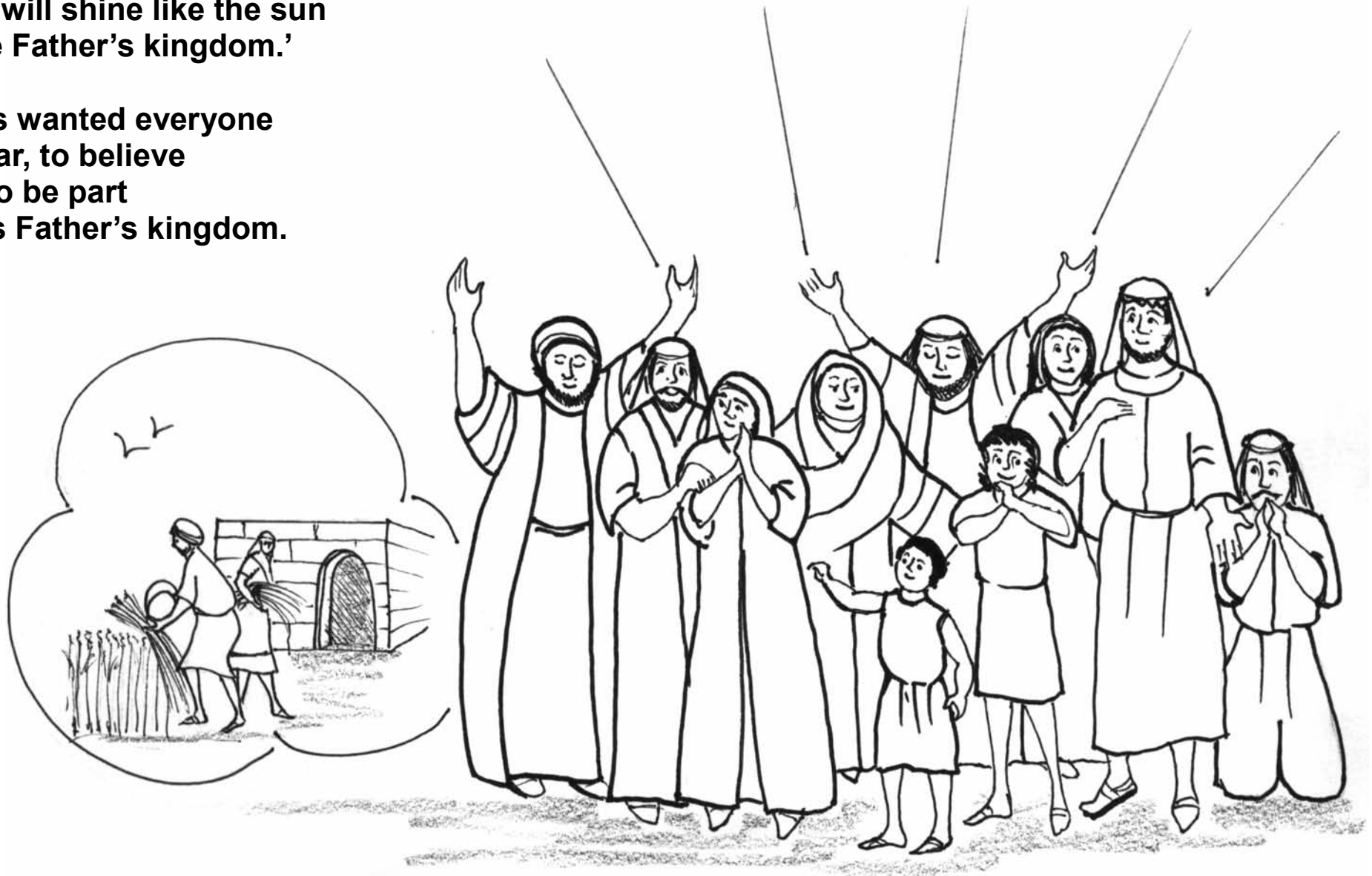


**‘When the world comes to an end,

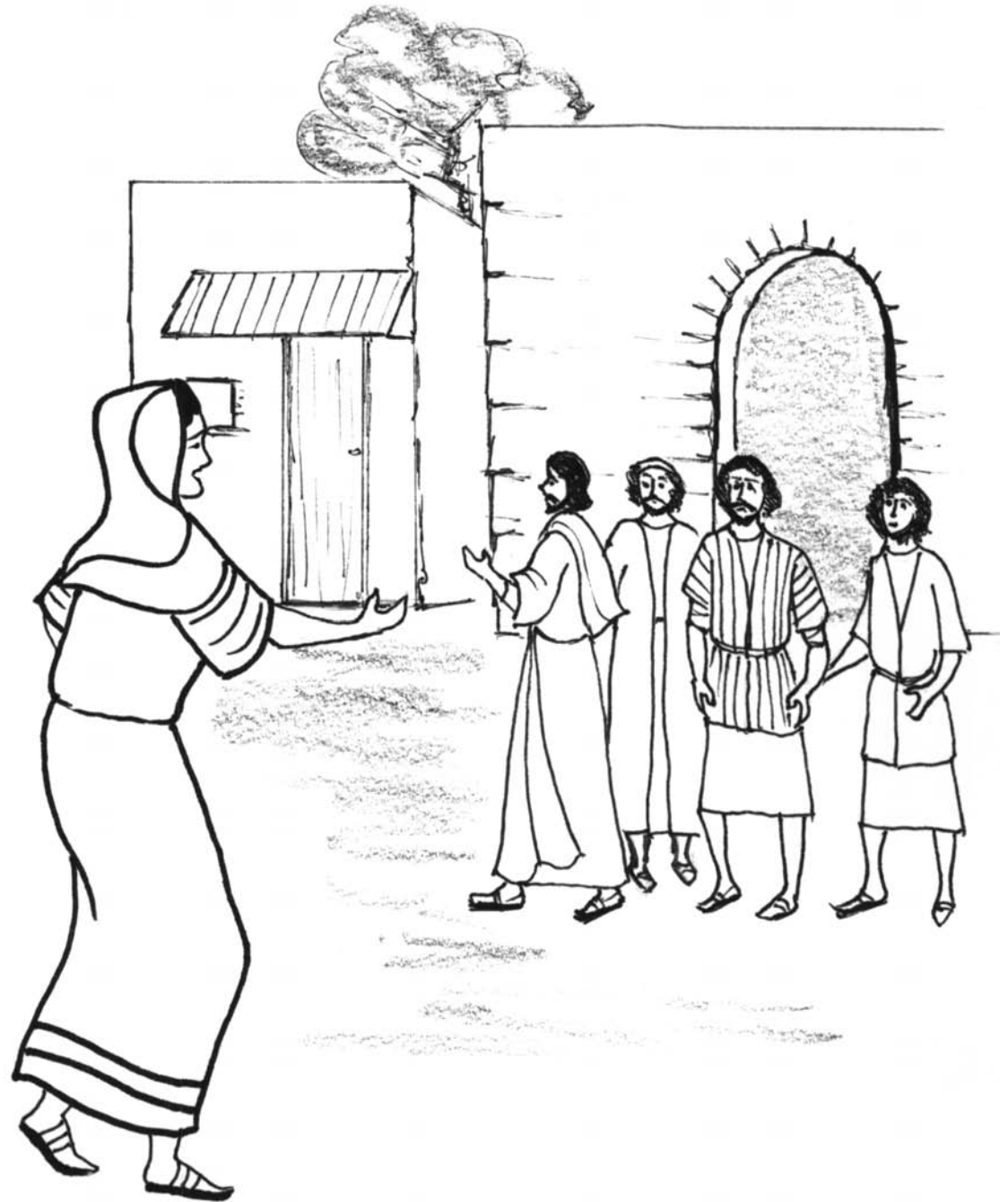
**A GENTILE MOTHER COMES TO JESUS**

what His Father wanted?**

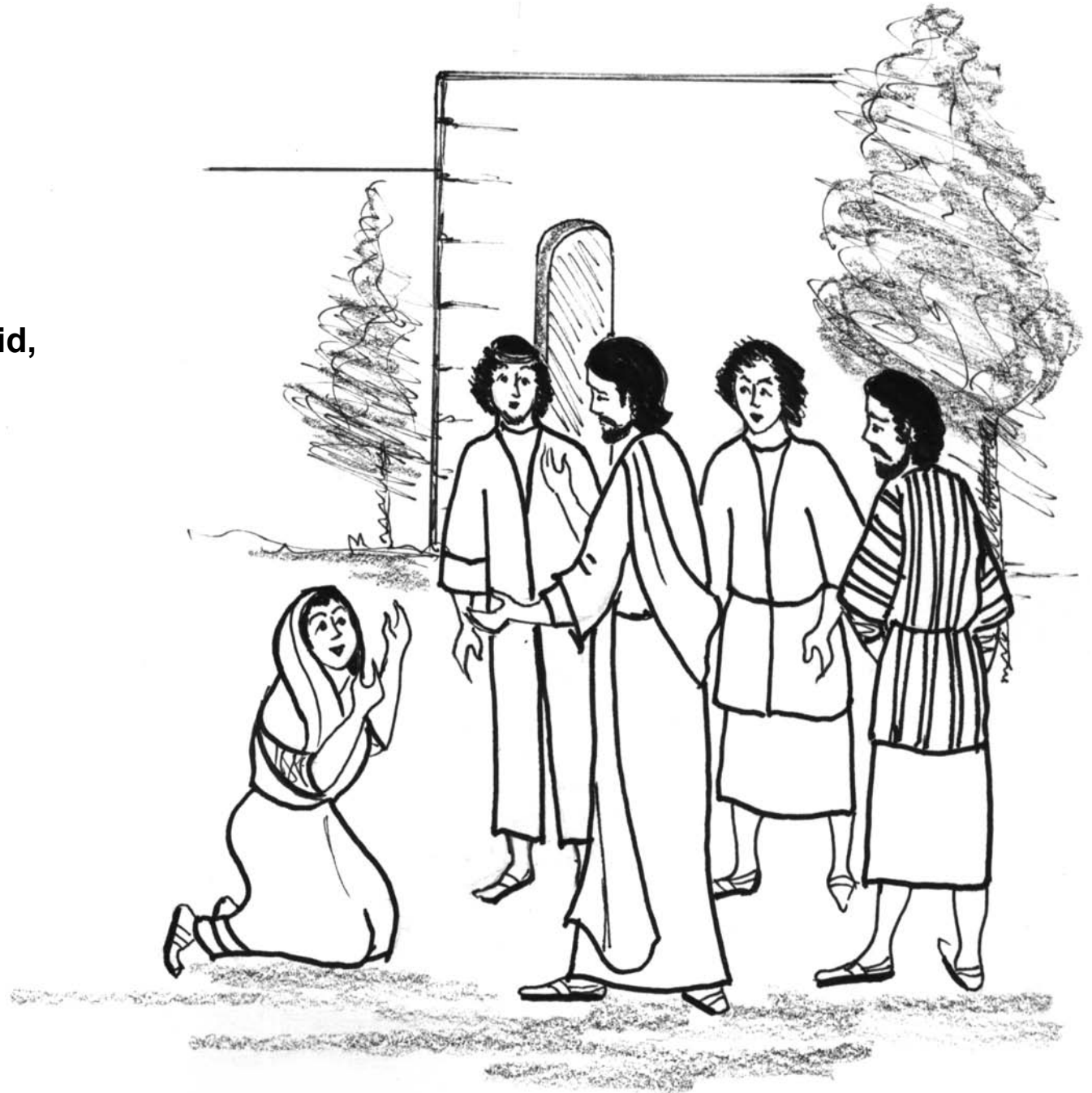


**Then Jesus said ,

asked Jesus.**

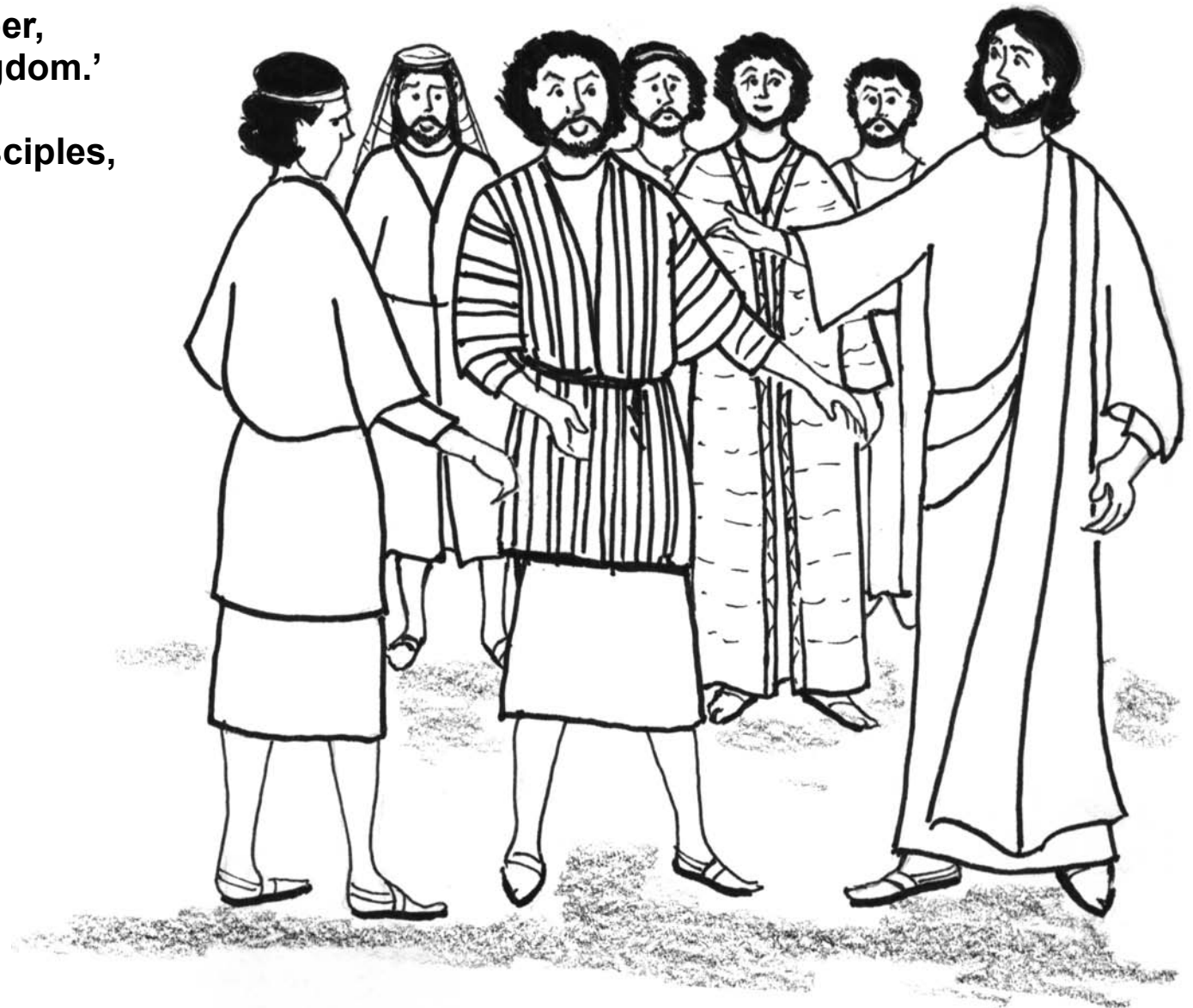
**Peter answered Him saying,

letting people into My kingdom.'**

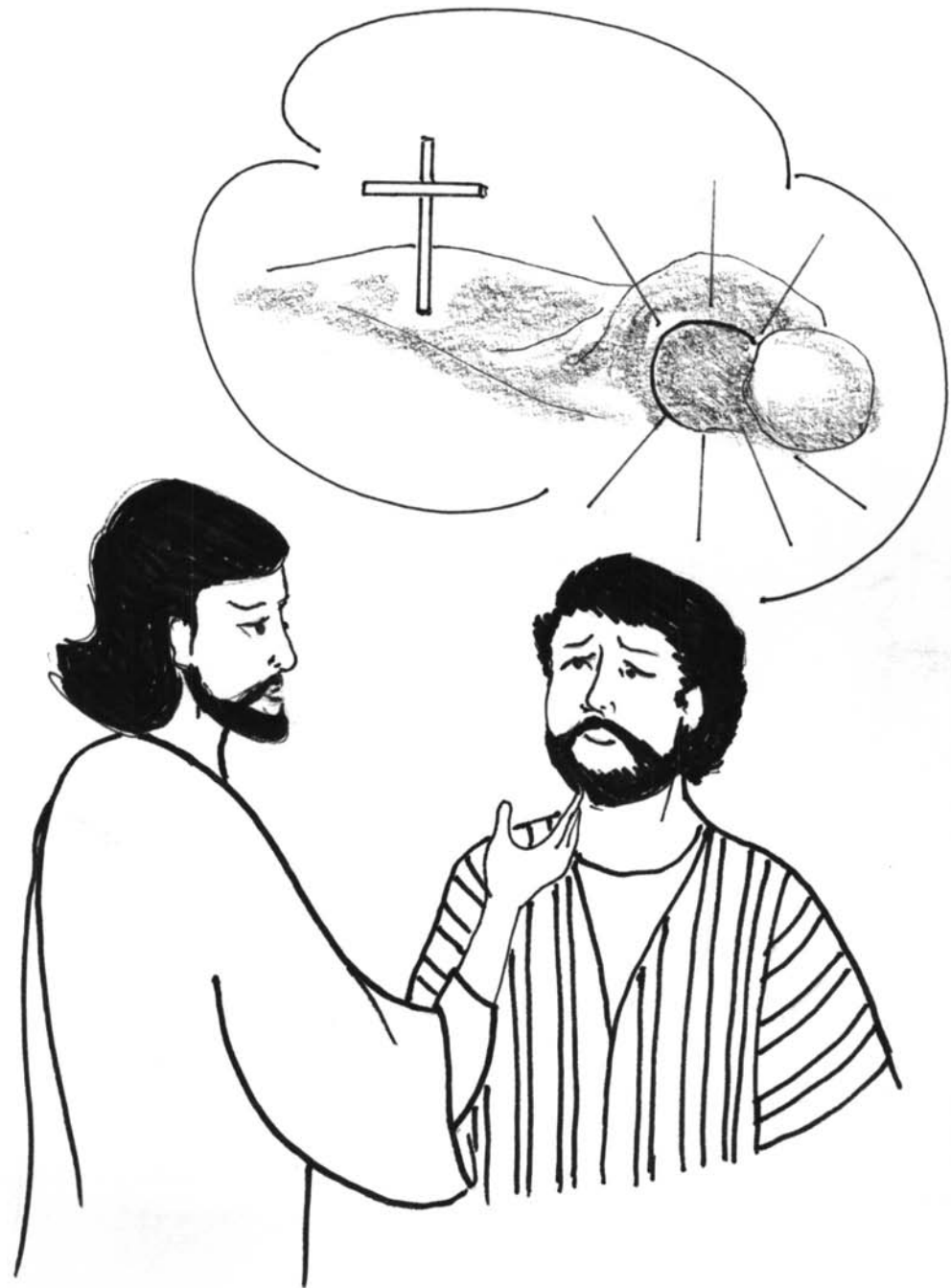
**Then Jesus said to His disciples,

God is the only One who gives life.**

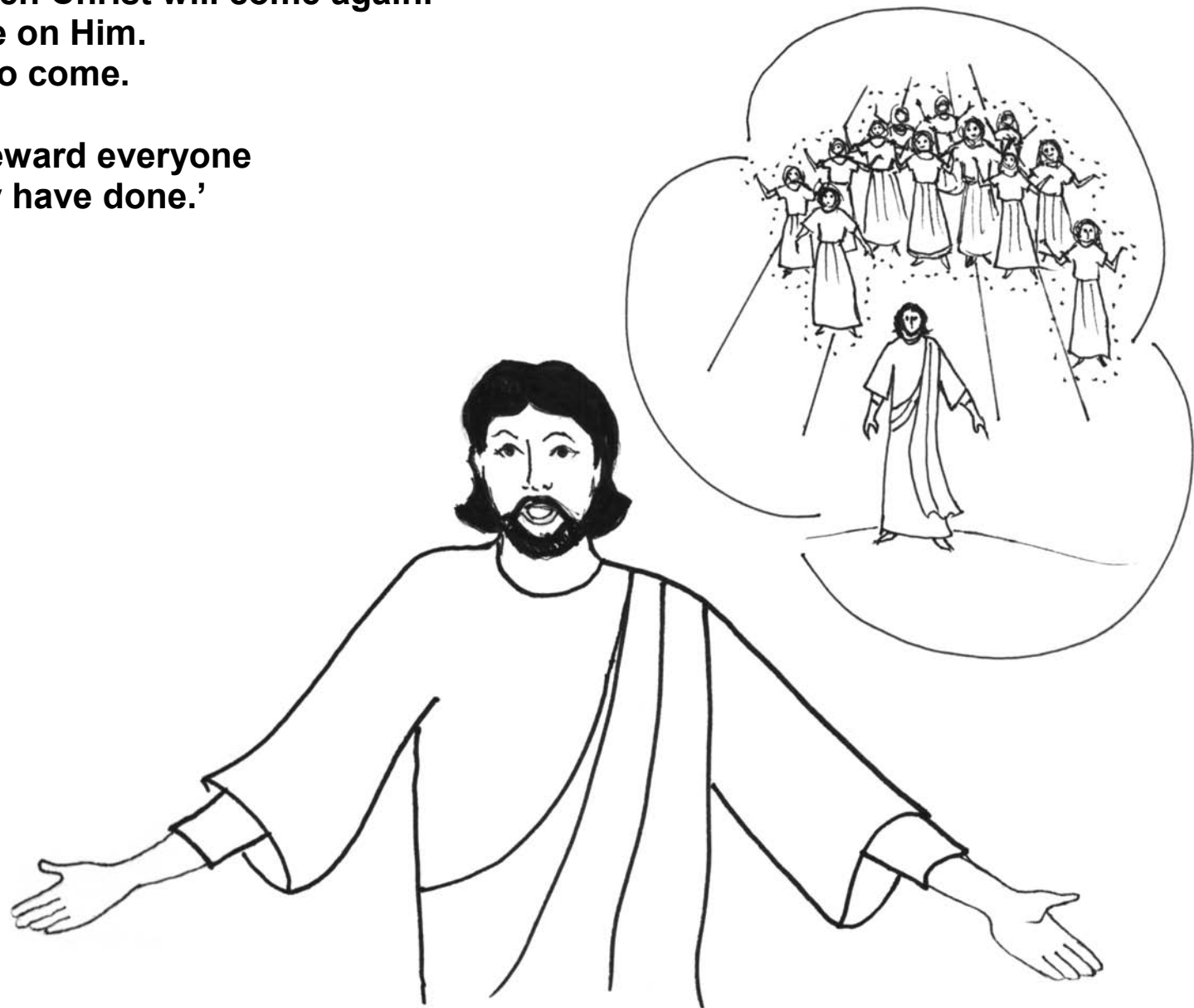
**'If you have everything you want

*(Transfiguration)*

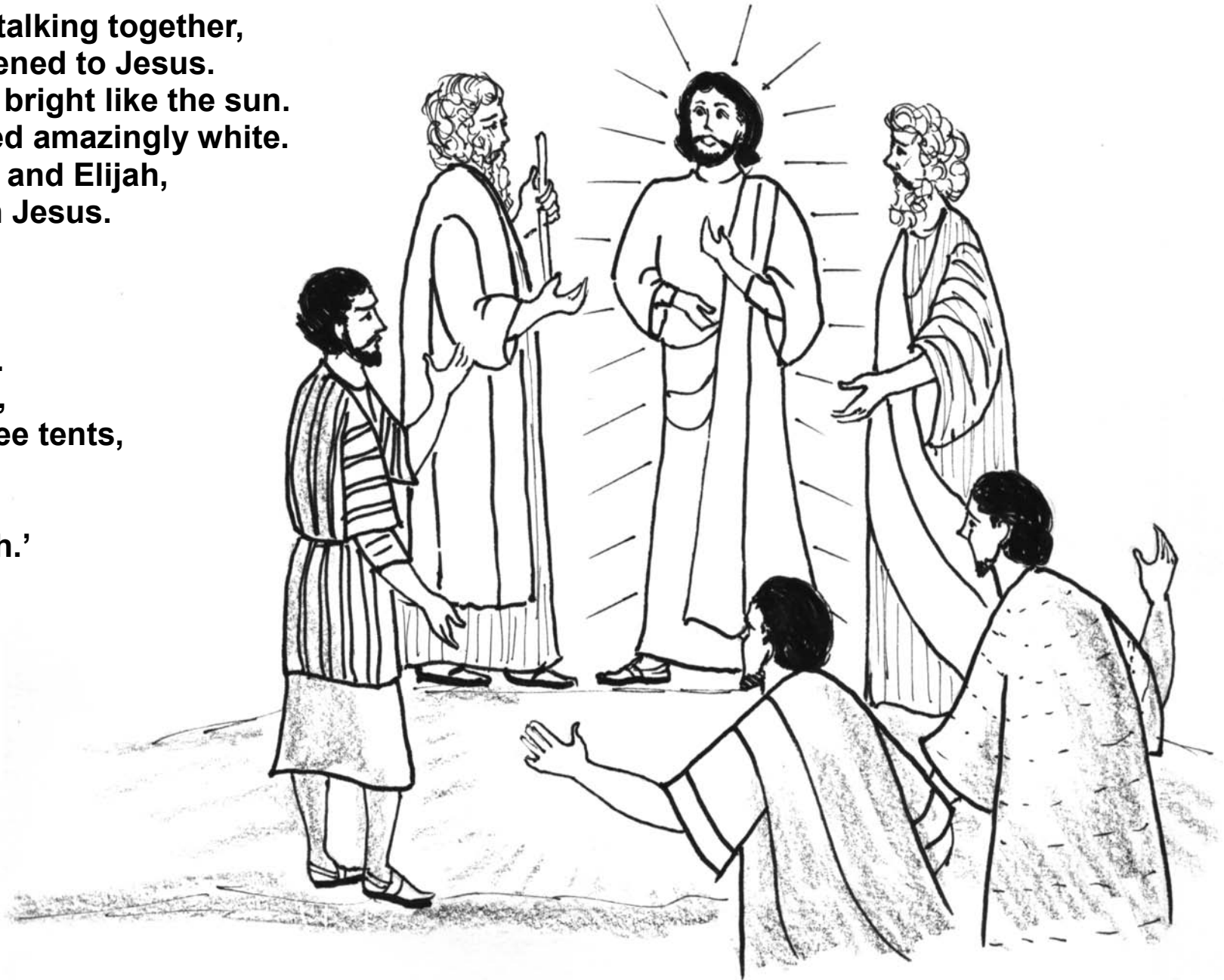

where they could be alone.**



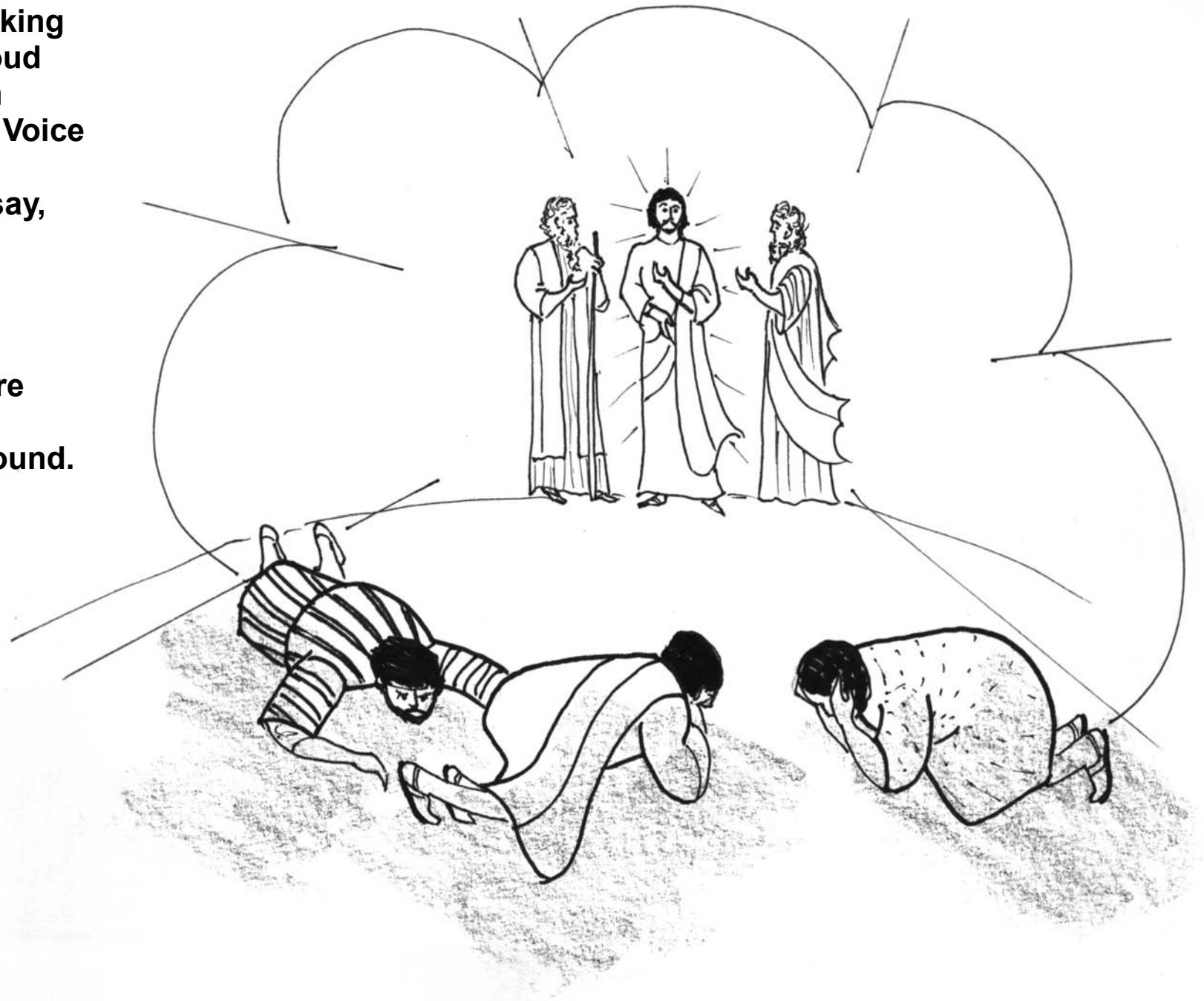
**While they were talking together,

Listen to Him.'**

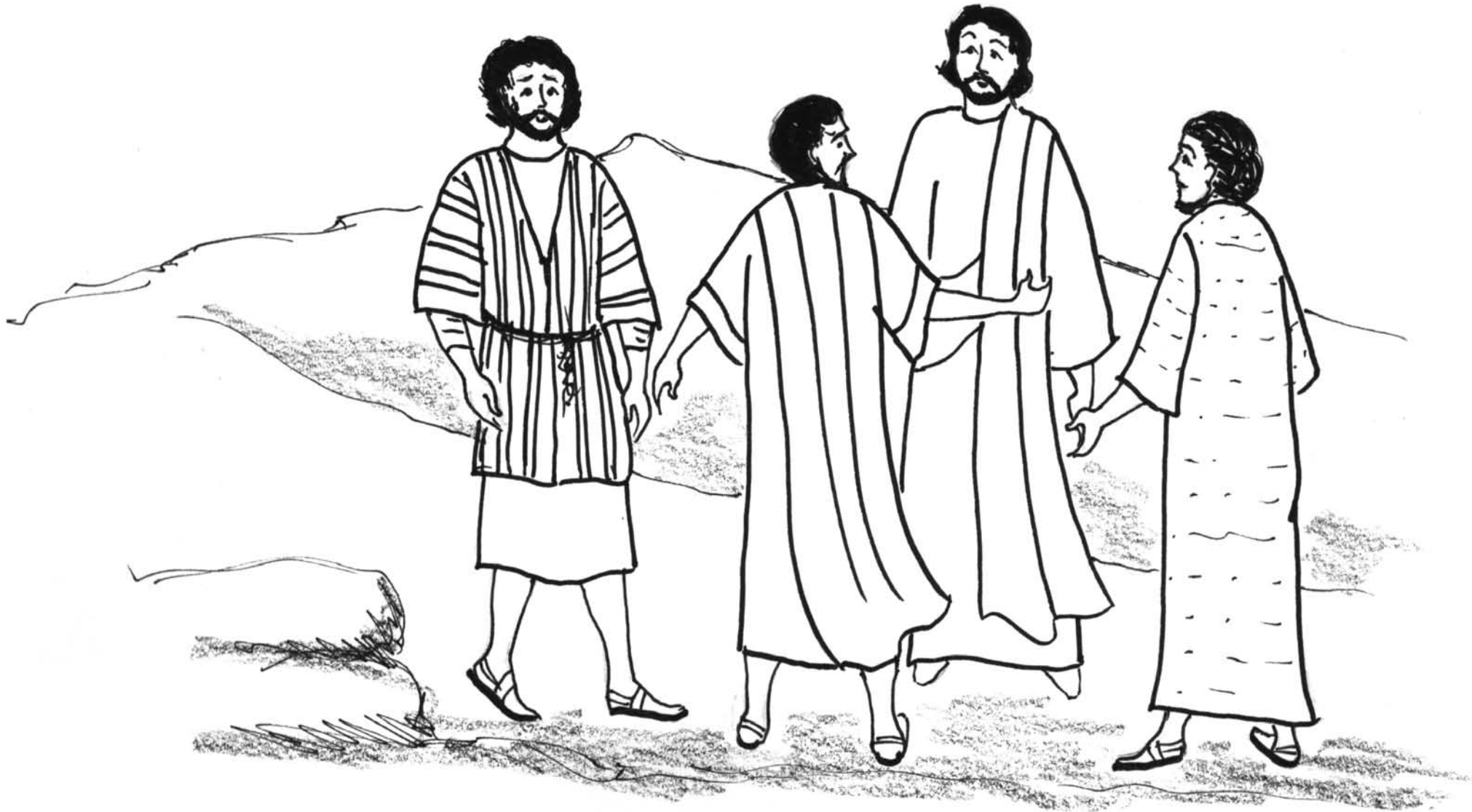
**The disciples were

Moses and Elijah had gone.**

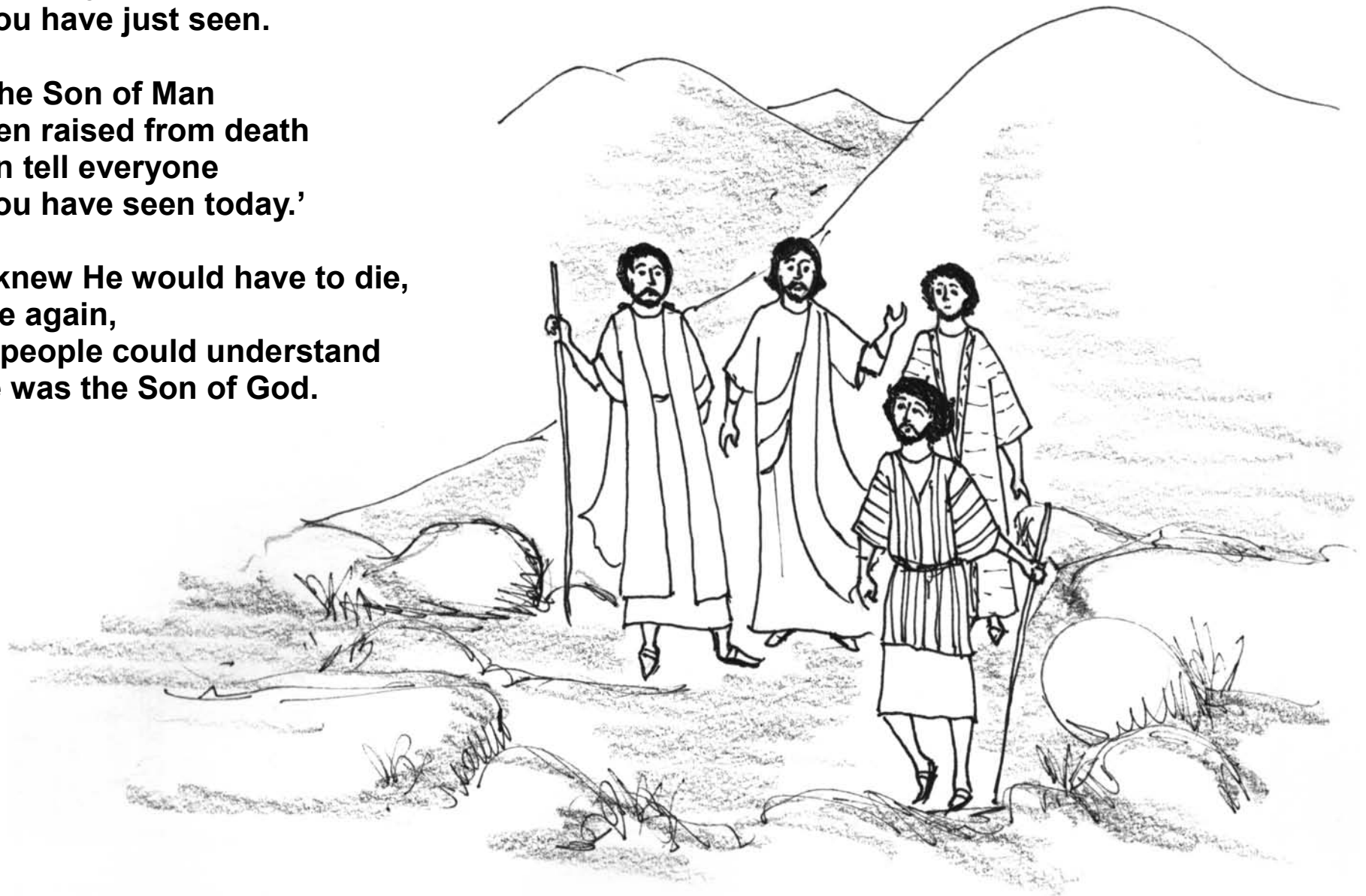




**On their way down the mountain

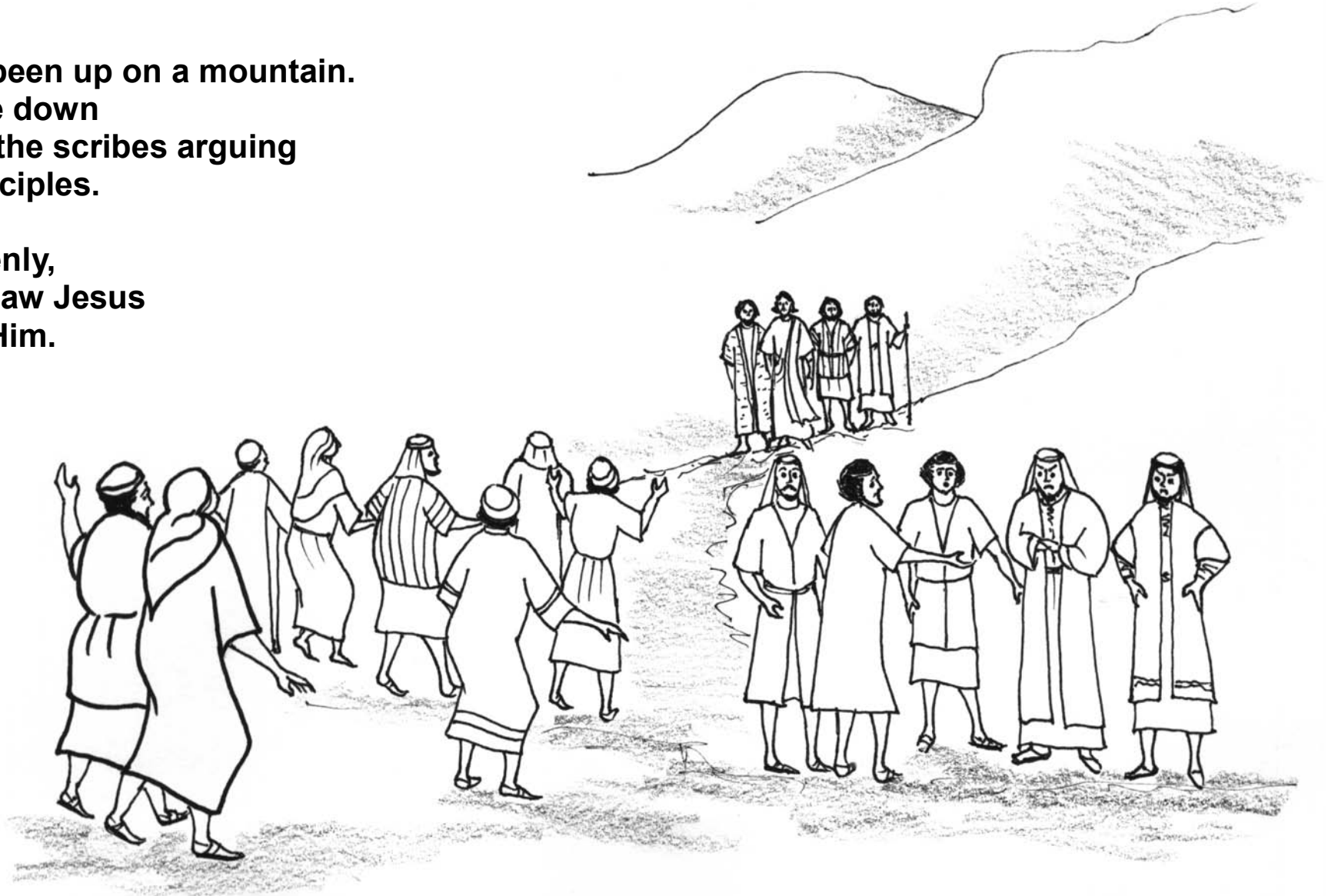
Matthew 17:14–21; Luke 9:37–43
