

Satan said, 'If you are the Son of God, tell this rock to change into bread.'


Jesus said, 'I will not do that. It is written in God's word that a person does not live just by eating bread. He lives by God's word.' The street of the last of But Satan tried again.


He took Jesus to Jerusalem and put Him on a high place of the Temple.

'God won't let you get hurt. He will send angels to keep You from getting hurt.'


Jesus said, 'No, the Bible says: "Do not test the Lord your God.""
