

When Jesus came into Jerusalem He saw the sick, blind and lame people waiting by a pool.




Jesus spoke to a man who had been lame for thirty-eight years, and said, 'Do you want to be well?'

Straight away the man went to the Jewish teachers and said,


'The man who healed me was Jesus.'
