A teacher of the law wanted to trick Jesus, so he asked Him, 'Teacher, what must I do to have eternal life?'


Jesus asked him, 'What does the law of God say?'

like you love yourself."


'That's right,'

'But who is my neighbour?' the scribe asked.




A priest came walking by and saw the man lying on the road. He didn't stop.
