



When Jesus was talking to some Pharisees He told them this story:




If someone comes to the sheep pen and doesn't go in by the gate, but climbs the wall, he would be a thief.





The Pharisees wondered, 'What is Jesus trying to tell us?'

I have come to give My sheep, life.










The Pharisees went away and thought about what Jesus said.
