
THE LAME MAN / PETER AND JOHN IN TROUBLE


Peter and John were on their way to the temple to pray. As they got near to the gate called 'Beautiful', they heard a man asking for money.


This man was crippled and could not walk. Friends had brought him there

Peter and John said to the man, 'Look at us!'






Everyone was amazed. A crowd began to gather.
