



Then Paul said to Barnabas, 'Let us go back to the places where we have been. We will see how the believers are going.'







When they arrived in Lystra Paul met Timothy. He was a man who was loved and respected by the Christians.

Paul asked Timothy to come with them and share in telling the good news of Jesus Christ.


So Paul, Silas and Timothy, travelled together through Galatia, speaking God's word to many people.
