

The Philistines won that battle, and they also captured God's Covenant box.




They took the Covenant box to their temple and put it next to their god, Dagon.

Then there was more trouble. The Philistines became sick.


They said, 'Israel's God is doing this.

The Levites took the Box off the cart, made a fire from the wood of the cart, killed the cows and sacrificed them to the Lord.


Some careless men looked into the Box, and they died. This frightened everyone.
