One day when Elisha came there he said to the lady, 'You have done all of this for me. What can I do for you?


The lady said, 'I live safely here with my people and do not need anything.'

A servant carried him home to his mother and he died.




The lady was very sad. She laid her son on Elisha's bed and quickly went to find Elisha.

She said, 'I did not ask for a son. You raised my hopes, but now he is dead.'




Elisha sent his servant immediately to lay his walking stick on the boy's face.
