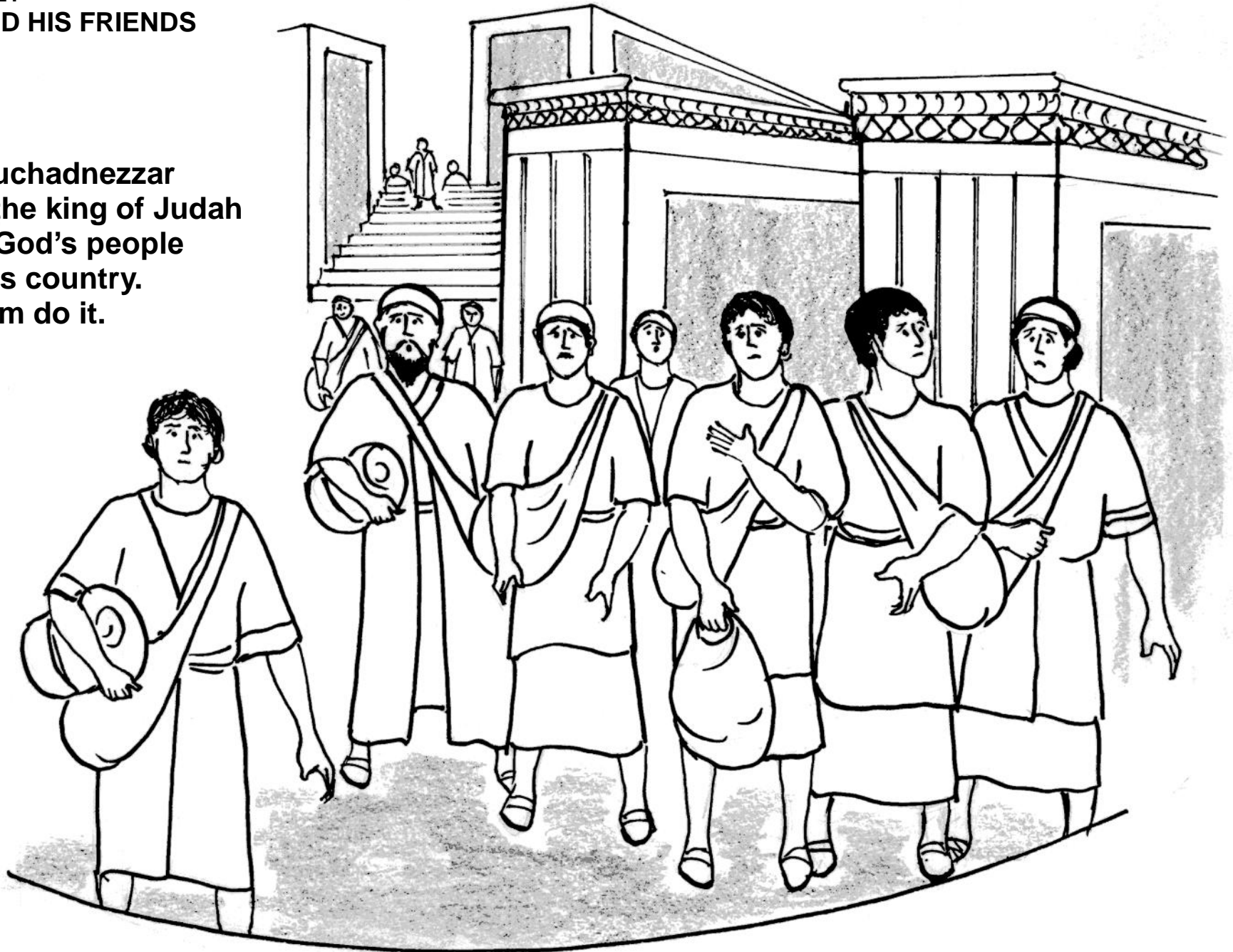

of the king's servants.**

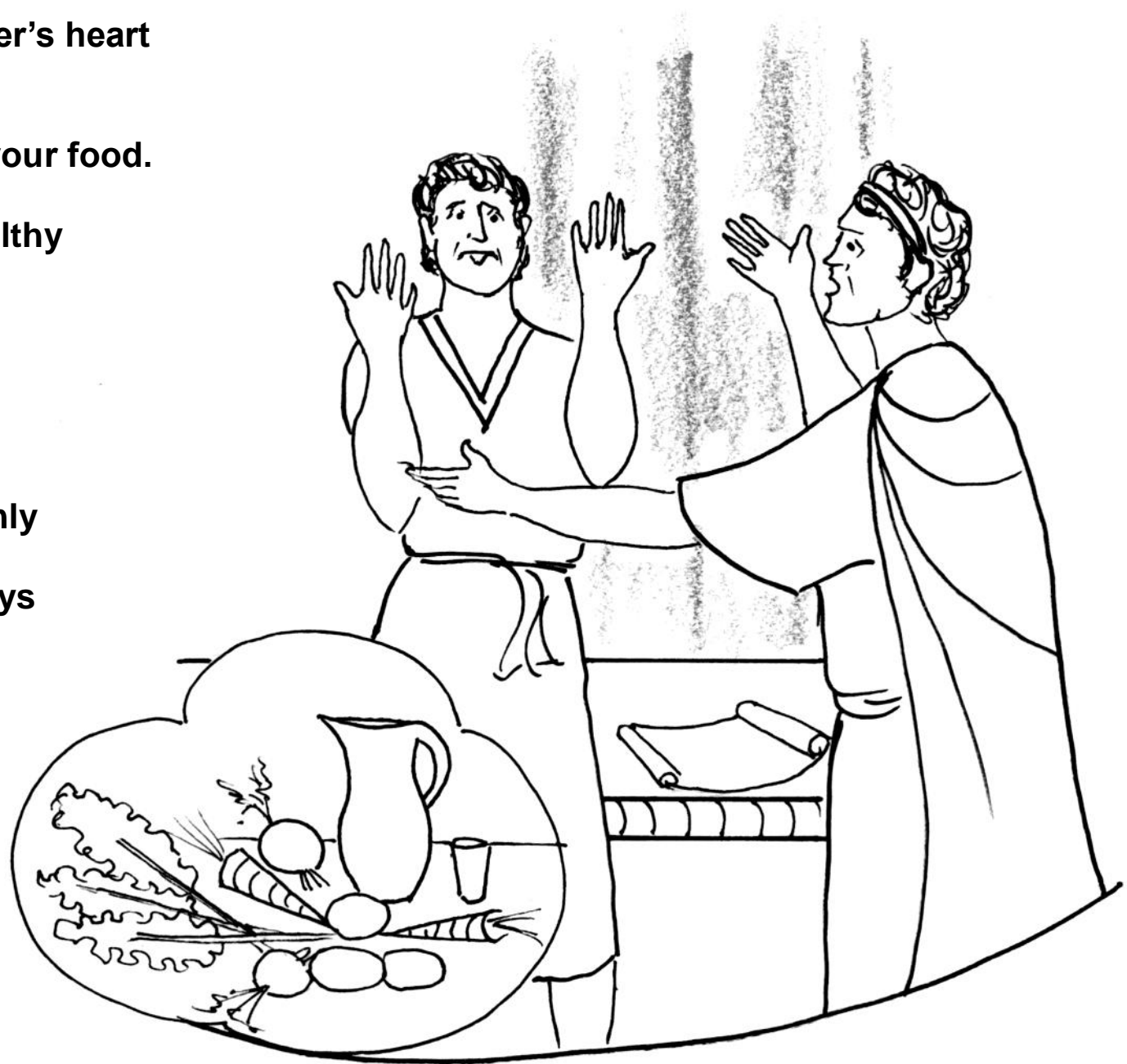
**They were given new names
